YARN USAGE

Anchor Stranded Cotton, worked with 4 strands.

STITCH TECHNIQUE

Cross stitch and backstitch worked over 2 fabric threads each way.

FARRIC

 49×110 cm (back) and 49×86 cm (front) 20# linen fabric in natural linen shade. Stitch front and back together to make a long band.

NOTIONS

Matching sewing thread, 2 m red 25 mm wide ribbon (4 x 50 cm), 3 decorative hearts by Rayher.

ALL YOU NEED TO DO


Neaten the raw edges of the fabric with zigzag stitch. Embroider the motif centrally on the back piece, beginning with the point of the large heart about 44 cm up from the bottom edge. Make a double hem along the long edges and sew into a point at each short end. Sew on the ribbons where indicated (B) and attach the decorative hearts at the corners.


TIP: SEWING POINTED ENDS


Fold the band in half lengthways with right sides together, i.e. the front facing the front, and stitch together 2 cm away from the short raw edges. Smooth out the seam allowances, unfold the band and make a small point at the end. Then turn the pointed corner through and pull the point out carefully. Finally, steam-press the band from the back and sew across the top of the pointed sections.

CROSS STITCH

Cross stitch is worked in two stages – first work the lower stitch (from left to right) and then work the upper stitch (from right to left).








BACKSTITCH

Backstitch is worked from right to left.



TIP

Always work cross stitch with a Tapestry needle! Always work the cross stitch first and only then work the backstitch or straight stitch. Each square on the chart represents one cross stitch.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

All our threads are produced in accordance with Oeko-tex standards. PH values are tested and all our colors dye lots adhere to Global fastness standards. However, it is important to follow our thread washing instructions. Particularly with dark colors, excess dye can remain on the thread. To minimize any potential bleeding of excess dyestuff it is important to wash the products in THE HOTTEST TEMPERATURE possible, in accordance with the specifications of the fabrics, and use a large amount of water. Please make sure that you also follow the fabric washing instructions. As a precaution, you can also use decolorating sheets that you can find in any supermarket.
