YARN USAGE

Anchor Stranded Cotton, worked with 3 strands.

STITCH TECHNIQUE

Cross stitch and backstitch worked over 2 fabric threads each way.

FABRIC

About 15 x 15 cm 25# evenweave fabric in natural linen shade.

NOTIONS

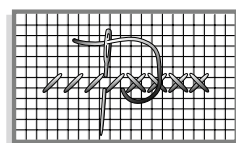
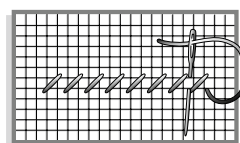
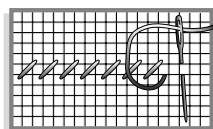
35.5 x 50 cm dark red felt, cut as follows: twice 25 x 25 cm for the two heart shapes, 1 gusset strip (8 x 40 cm) to go between the hearts and 1 strip (2.5 x 40 cm) for the handle, matching Coats sewing thread, 20 x 20 cm iron-on bonding material, 1 star-shaped decorative button.

ALL YOU NEED TO DO

Neaten the raw edges of the fabric with zigzag stitch. Embroider the motif centrally onto the evenweave fabric. Transfer two heart motifs onto the felt and cut out. For the front, also transfer and cut out the inner heart shape. Secure the embroidery behind the opening using iron-on bonding material. Making the seam allowances on the outside, stitch the two hearts and the gusset strip together close to the edge. Finally, stitch on the handle and sew on the button as desired to decorate the front of the handle..

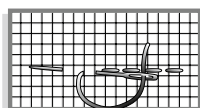
CROSS STITCH

Cross stitch is worked in two stages – first work the lower stitch (from left to right) and then work the upper stitch (from right to left).



BACKSTITCH

Backstitch is worked from right to left.



TIP

Always work cross stitch with a Tapestry needle! Always work the cross stitch first and only then work the backstitch or straight stitch. Each square on the chart represents one cross stitch.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

All our threads are produced in accordance with Oeko-tex standards. PH values are tested and all our colors dye lots adhere to Global fastness standards. However, it is important to follow our thread washing instructions. Particularly with dark colors, excess dye can remain on the thread. To minimize any potential bleeding of excess dyestuff it is important to wash the products in THE HOTTEST TEMPERATURE possible, in accordance with the specifications of the fabrics, and use a large amount of water. Please make sure that you also follow the fabric washing instructions. As a precaution, you can also use decolorating sheets that you can find in any supermarket.
