## "Toadstool pair" gift sack

### YARN USAGE

Anchor Stranded Cotton, worked with 3 strands.

### STITCH TECHNIQUE

Cross stitch and backstitch worked over 2 fabric threads each way.

### FABRIC

About 20 x 53 cm 25# evenweave fabric in natural white (cut two rectangles each 20 x 26.5 cm, each including a 2 cm seam allowance).

### NOTIONS

Matching sewing thread, 4 waggie eyes and 1.50 m red satin ribbon with white spots (15 mm wide).

### ALL YOU NEED TO DO

Neaten the raw edges of the fabric with zigzag stitch. Embroider the motif centrally onto the front piece about 4.5 cm up from the bottom edge (use only 2 strands for the backstitch). Now place both rectangles together with right sides facing and stitch the side and bottom seams. Turn in about 8 cm at the top edge and stitch a 1.5 cm wide channel 5 cm from the top edge. Open up the side seams at the ends of the channel, thread the satin ribbon through and tie bows. Finally, glue on the waggie eyes.

## "Circles" gift sack

### YARN USAGE

Anchor Stranded Cotton, worked with 3 strands.

### STITCH TECHNIQUE

Cross stitch and backstitch worked over 2 fabric threads each way.

### FABRIC

About 20 x 53 cm 25# evenweave fabric in natural linen shade (cut two rectangles each 20 x 26.5 cm, each including a 2 cm seam allowance).

### NOTIONS

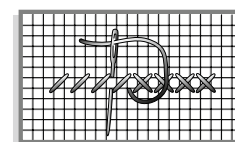
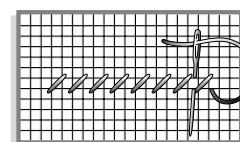
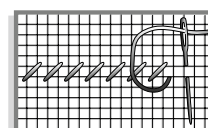
Matching sewing thread, 1 pack 3 mm wax beads, 1.50 m dark red 10 mm wide satin ribbon.

### ALL YOU NEED TO DO

Neaten the raw edges of the fabric with zigzag stitch. Embroider the motif centrally onto the front piece about 4.5 cm up from the bottom edge (use only 2 strands for the backstitch). Now place both rectangles together with right sides facing and stitch the side and bottom seams. Turn in about 8 cm at the top edge and stitch a 1.5 cm wide channel 5 cm from the top edge. Open up the side seams at the ends of the channel, thread the satin ribbon through and tie bows.

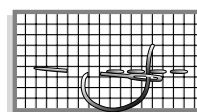
### CROSS STITCH

Cross stitch is worked in two stages – first work the lower stitch (from left to right) and then work the upper stitch (from right to left).



### BACKSTITCH

Backstitch is worked from right to left.



### TIP

Always work cross stitch with a Tapestry needle! Always work the cross stitch first and only then work the backstitch or straight stitch. Each square on the chart represents one cross stitch.

### WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

All our threads are produced in accordance with Oeko-tex standards. PH values are tested and all our colors dye lots adhere to Global fastness standards. However, it is important to follow our thread washing instructions. Particularly with dark colors, excess dye can remain on the thread. To minimize any potential bleeding of excess dyestuff it is important to wash the products in THE HOTTEST TEMPERATURE possible, in accordance with the specifications of the fabrics, and use a large amount of water. Please make sure that you also follow the fabric washing instructions. As a precaution, you can also use decolorating sheets that you can find in any supermarket.
