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BERNAT DIAMOND IN THE ROUGH KNIT BLANKET | KNIT



MATERIALS

Bernat[®] Blanket[™] (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m) Light Teal (10734) **5 balls or 1010 yds/920 m**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or** size needed to obtain gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximate(ly) Beg = Begin(ning) Center dec = Slip next 2 stitches onto right-hand needle as if to K2tog. Knit next stitch, then pass slipped stitches over knit stitch – 2 stitches are decreased with center stitch on top Cont = Continue(ity) K = Knit K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together P = Purl
Pat = Pattern
Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side
Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise
one at a time. Pass them back
onto left-hand needle, then knit
through back loops together.
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yo = Yarn over

KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

MEASUREMENTS Approx 51 x 62" [129.5 x 157.5 cm].

GAUGE

8 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 133 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Knit 7 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Proceed in pat as follows: Note: See chart on page 2. **1st row:** K5. *K2tog. K3. yo. K1. yo. K3. ssk. K5. Rep from * to end of row. **2nd row:** K2. *P7. K3. P6. Rep from * to last 3 sts. P1. K2. 3rd row: K4. *K2tog. K3. yo. K3. yo. K3. ssk. K3. Rep from * to last st. K1. **4th row:** K2. *P6. K5. P5. Rep from * to last 3 sts. P1. K2. 5th row: K3. *K2tog. K3. yo. K5. yo. K3. ssk. K1. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2. 6th row: K2. *P5. K7. P4. Rep from * to last 3 sts. P1. K2.

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7th row: K2. K2tog. K3. *yo. K7. yo. K3. Center dec. K3. Rep from * to last 14 sts. yo. K7. yo. K3. ssk. K2. **8th row:** As 6th row.

9th and 10th rows: Rep 7th and 8th rows.

11th row: As 7th row.

12th row: K2. Purl to last 2 sts. K2. **13th row:** K3. *yo. K3. ssk. K5. K2tog. K3. yo. K1. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

14th row: K4. *P13. K3. Rep from * to last st. K1.

15th row: K4. *yo. K3. ssk. K3. K2tog. K3. yo. K3. Rep from * to last st. K1.

16th row: K5. *P11. K5. Rep from * to end of row.

17th row: K5. *yo. K3. ssk. K1. K2tog. K3. yo. K5. Rep from * to end of row.

18th row: K6. *P9. K7. Rep from * to last 15 sts. P9. K6.

19th row: K6. *yo. K3. Center dec. K3. yo. K7. Rep from * to last 15 sts. yo. K3. Center dec. K3. yo. K6. **20th row:** As 18th row.

21st and 22nd rows: As 19th and 20th rows.


23rd row: As 19th row.24th row: K2. Purl to last 2 sts. K2.These 24 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 61" [155 cm], ending on a 12th or 24th row of pat. Knit 5 rows (garter st).

Cast off knitwise (WS).

Tassels (make 4)

Cut a piece of cardboard 6" [15 cm] wide. Wind yarn around cardboard 40 times. Break yarn, leaving a long end and thread end through a needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops ³/₄" [2 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Attach 1 Tassel securely to each corner of Blanket.




