MATERIALS

Bernat[®] Softee[®] Baby[™] (5 oz/140 g; 362 yds/331 m)	
Contrast A Petunia (54001)	1 ball
Contrast C Buttercup (54002)	1 ball
Contrast E Pumpkin (54005)	1 ball

Bernat® Softee® Baby Stripes™ (4.2 oz/120 g; 287 yds/262 m)Contrast B Fireball Stripe (53017)2 ballsContrast D Sunny Side Up Stripe (53007)2 balls

Size U.S. 6 (4 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Approx = Approximately Pat = Pattern **St(s)** = Stitch(es) **WS** = Wrong side

KNIT I SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

MEASUREMENT

Approx 40" [101.5 cm] square.

GAUGE

20 sts and 40 rows in Garter St.

INSTRUCTIONS Stripe Pat

With A: 48 rows. With B: 10 rows. With A: 10 rows. With B: 10 rows. With A: 10 rows. With B: 48 rows. With C: 10 rows. With B: 10 rows. With C: 10 rows. With B: 10 rows. With C: 48 rows. With D: 10 rows. With C: 10 rows. With D: 10 rows. With C: 10 rows. With D: 48 rows. With E: 10 rows. With D: 10 rows. With E: 10 rows. With D: 10 rows. With E: 48 rows. These 400 rows complete Stripe Pat.

Cast on 200 stitches (sts). Do **not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Knit 400 rows of Stripe Pat (garter st). Cast off knitwise (WS).
