MATERIALS

Bernat® Softee® Chunky™ (Solids: 3.5 oz/100 g; 108 yds/99 m;

Ombres: 2.8 oz/80 g; 77 yds/70 m)

Contrast A Gray Heather (28046)
 Contrast B Soft Taupe (28011)
 Contrast C Stillness Ombre (29117)
 6 balls
 7 balls

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximate(ly)St(s) = Stitch(es)Beg = Begin(ning)Tog = Together

KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 48" x 60" [122 x 152 cm].

GAUGE

10 sts and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Squares (Make 7 each with A and B. Make 6 with C).

Cast on 30 stitches (sts). Work in garter stitch (st) (knit every row) until Square from beginning (beg) measures approximately (approx) 12" [30.5 cm]. Cast off.

FINISHING Sew Squares together (tog) into 4 Strips, with 5 Squares in each Strip, arranging Squares with garter ridges running horizontally and vertically (see diagram). Sew Strips tog.
