## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\oplus}$ Blanket $^{\text {Tm }}$ ( $10.3 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220 \mathrm{yds} / 201 \mathrm{~m}$ ) or ( $5.3 \mathrm{oz} / 150 \mathrm{~g} ; 108 \mathrm{yds} / 98 \mathrm{~m}$ )

Contrast A Olive (10241) or Green (86242)
Contrast B Red or Cranberry (00705)
Contrast C Vintage White (10006) or (00006) $260 \mathrm{yds} / 235 \mathrm{~m}$ or 2 (3) balls $260 \mathrm{yds} / 235 \mathrm{~m}$ or 2 (3) balls
Contrast D Sand (10014) or (00014)
$230 \mathrm{yds} / 210 \mathrm{~m}$ or 2 (3) balls

## U.S. $/ 13$ ( $m \mathrm{~m}$ ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Begin(ning)
$\mathbf{C h}=$ Chain(s)
Cont = Continue(ity)
Dc = Double crochet

Dtr $=$ (Yoh) 3 times. Draw up a loop in indicated stitch. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times.
Pat $=$ Pattern

Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep = Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
Sl st = Slip stitch
St(s) = Stitch(es) Yoh = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 43" x 55" [109 x 139.5 cm ].

## GAUGE

6 dc and 3 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- Afghan is worked sideways.
- Always beg each row with RS facing.
- Do not turn at end of row.
- Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc throughout.


## Stripe Pat

With A, work 1 row.
With B, work 1 row.
With C, work 1 row.
With D, work 1 row.
These 4 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, ch 87.
1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Fasten off. 85 dc .
2nd row: (RS). Join B to top of first ch 3. Ch 3. Working in back loops, 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.
3rd row: (RS). Join $C$ to top of ch 3. Ch 3. Working in back loops, 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 1 dtr in rem front loop of next st 2 rows below. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next

4 dc .1 dtr in rem front loop of next st 2 rows below. Rep from * to end of row. Fasten off.
4th row: (RS). Join D to top of ch 3. Ch 1 (does not count as st). 1 dtr in rem front loop of first st 2 rows below. Working in back loops, 1 dc in each of next 4 sts. *1 dtr in rem front loop of next st 2 rows below. 1 dc in each of next 4 sts.
Rep from * to end of row. Fasten off.
5th row: (RS). Join A to first dtr. Ch 3. *1 dtr in rem front loop of next st 2 rows below. Working in back loops, 1 dc in each of next 4 sts. Rep from * to last 4 sts. 1 dtr in rem front loop of next st 2 rows below. 1 dc in each of last 3 dc . Fasten off.
6th row: (RS). Join B to top of first ch 3. Ch 3. Working in back loops, 1 dc in next dtr. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dtr}$ in rem front loop of next st 2 rows below. 1 dc in each of next 4 sts. Rep from * to last 3 sts. 1 dtr in rem front loop of next st 2 rows below. 1 dc in each of last 2 dc . Fasten off.
7th row: (RS). Join C to top of first ch 3. Ch 3. Working in back loops, 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. *1 dtr in rem front loop of next st 2 rows below. 1 dc in each of next 4 sts. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 dtr in rem front loop of next st 2 rows below. 1 dc in last dc. Fasten off. First 7 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.
Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep 3rd to 7th rows for Step Ladder Pat until work from beg measures 43" [109 cm]. Fasten off.
