



MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)
 Vintage White (10006) or Pale Gray (10046)
 or Coal (10040) **2 balls or 440 yds/402 m**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
 Stitch marker. 20" [51 cm] square pillow form.

 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 20" [51 cm] square.

GAUGE:

7 sc and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Pillow Front

Note: Tr sts worked on WS will push towards RS of work to form bobbles.

Ch 36.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 35 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in next st. *1 tr in next st. 1 sc in next st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

4th and 5th rows: Rep 2nd and 3rd rows.

6th row: As 2nd row.

7th to 17th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn. Rep 2nd to 17th rows once more, then rep 2nd to 7th rows once. Fasten off.

Fringe Strips (make 2)

Ch 36.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 35 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. *Sl st in next sc. Draw up a loop 10" [25.5 cm] long. Twist loop 25 times. Sl st in same st, allowing twisted loop to coil around itself. Rep from * to end of row. Fasten off.

Pillow Back (make 2 pieces alike)

Ribbing: Ch 5.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 4 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg (when slightly stretched) measures 20" [51 cm]. **Do not** fasten off.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: Turn work sideways. Ch 1. Work 35 sc along side of ribbing. Turn. Place marker at end of row.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from marker measures 11" [28 cm]. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew Fringe Strips to Front of Pillow, below 1st and 2nd textured areas, as shown in photo.

Overlap Back pieces to match Front, with ribbed sections in center to create opening to insert pillow form. Sew outer edge seams.
