



**BERNAT SOFTEE BABY  
MY FAVORITE BLUE/WHITE  
BLANKET TO KNIT**

**MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 38 x 43 ins [96.5 x 109 cm].

**MATERIALS**

**Bernat Softee Baby** (140 g/5 oz)

**Main Color (MC)** (Blue) **3 balls**

**Contrast A** (White) **2 balls**

Sizes 4.5 mm (U.S. 7) and 5 mm (U.S. 8) circular knitting needles 36 ins [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

**GAUGE**

20 sts and 23 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] with larger needle in pat.

**STITCH GLOSSARY**

**MK** = P2tog without slipping sts off needle, then K2tog over same sts.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

With MC and smaller needle, cast on 181 sts. **Do not join.** Working back and forth across needle, proceed as follows: Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting that first row is WS.

Change to larger needle and proceed in pat as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). With A, knit.

**2nd row:** P1. (MK) 90 times.

**3rd row:** With MC, knit.

**4th row:** (MK) 90 times. P1.

These 4 rows form pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures approx 42 ins [106.5 cm], ending on a 2nd row of pat.

With MC and smaller needle, knit 5 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS).

**Side Edging:** With MC and smaller needle and with RS of work facing, pick up and knit 209 sts evenly along one side edge. Knit 4 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS).

Rep on opposite side.
