### SIZES

#### To fit chest measurement

- 2** 21" [53.5 cm]
- 4** 23" [58.5 cm]
- 6** 25" [63.5 cm]
- 8** 26½" [67.5 cm]
- 10** 28" [71 cm]

#### Finished chest

- 2** 26" [66 cm]
- 4** 28" [71 cm]
- 6** 30" [76 cm]
- 8** 32" [81.5 cm]
- 10** 34" [86.5 cm]

### ABBREVIATIONS:

- Beg** = Beginning
- Cont** = Continue(ity)
- Dec** = Decrease(ing)
- Inc** = Increase(ing)
- K** = Knit
- K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together
- P** = Purl
- P2tog** = Purl next 2 stitches together
- P2togtbl** = Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops
- Rem** = Remaining
- Rep** = Repeat
- RS** = Right side
- Ssk** = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together
- St(s)** = Stitch(es)
- WS** = Wrong side

### GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needles.

### INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

### BACK

\*\*With smaller needles cast on Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for **2** (2-2-2½-2½)" [**5** (5-5-6-6) cm],  
**1st row:** (RS). \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.  
**2nd row:** \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. P2.  
**58** (62-66-70-74) sts.  
**1** (1-3-3-3) st(s) evenly across last row. **59** (63-69-73-77) sts.

### MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (Solids: 6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)	<b>2</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>4</b>	<b>4</b>	<b>balls</b>

Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 4 st holders.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures **9 (10-11-11½-12½)**" [**23 (25.5-28-30-32.5)** cm], ending on a purl row.

**Shape raglans:** Cast off **2 (2-2-3-3)** sts beg next 2 rows. **55 (59-65-69-71)** sts.

**Sizes 2, 4, 6 and 8 only:** **Next row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**Next row:** P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.

**All sizes:** **1st row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**2nd row:** Purl.\*\*

Rep last 2 rows **14 (15-17-18-21)** times more. Leave rem **21 (23-25-25-27)** sts on a st holder.

## FRONT

Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Back.

Rep last 2 rows **6 (7-8-9-12)** times more. **37 (39-43-45-45)** sts.

**Shape neck:** **1st row:** (RS). K2. ssk. **K9 (9-11-11-13)** (neck edge). **Turn.**

**2nd row:** Purl.

**3rd row:** K2. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

Rep last 2 rows **3 (3-4-4-5)** times more. 4 sts rem.

**Next row:** P4.

**Next row:** ssk. K2tog.

**Next row:** P2.

**Next row:** ssk. Fasten off.

With RS facing, slip next **11 (13-13-15-11)** sts onto a st holder.

**1st row:** (RS). Rejoin yarn to rem sts. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**2nd row:** Purl.

**3rd row:** ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

Rep last 2 rows **3 (3-4-4-5)** times more. 4 sts rem.

**Next row:** P4.

**Next row:** ssk. K2tog.

**Next row:** P2.

**Next row:** K2tog. Fasten off.

## SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on **34 (34-38-38-42)** sts.

Work **2 (2-2-2½-2½)**" [**5 (5-5-6-6)** cm] in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back, ending on a 2nd row and inc **3 (3-3-3-1)** st(s) evenly across last row. **37 (37-41-41-43)** sts.

Change to larger needles and work 6 rows in stocking st.

Inc 1 st each end of next row and following **6th (4th-4th-4th-4th)** rows until there are **45 (43-47-55-55)** sts.

**Sizes 4, 6, 8 and 10 only:** Inc 1 st each end of next row and following 6th rows until there are **(49-55-59-63)** sts.

**All sizes:** Cont even until work from beg measures **7½ (9½-10½-11½-12½)**" [**19 (24-26.5-29-32)** cm], ending on a purl row.

**Shape raglans:** Cast off **2 (2-2-3-3)** sts beg next 2 rows. **41 (45-51-53-57)** sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**2nd row:** P2. P2tog. Purl to last 4 sts. P2togtbl. P2.

**3rd row:** As 1st row.

**4th row:** Purl.

Rep last 4 rows **0 (1-2-1-1)** time(s) more. **35 (33-33-41-45)** sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Knit to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**2nd row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **13 (12-12-15-17)** times more. Leave rem **7 (7-7-9-9)** sts on a st holder.

## FINISHING

Sew raglan seams leaving left back raglan seam open.

**Collar:** With RS facing and smaller needles, **K7 (7-7-9-9)** from Left Sleeve st holder, dec 1 st at center. Pick up and knit **13 (13-14-14-16)** sts down Left Front neck edge. **K11 (13-13-15-11)** from Front st holder. Pick up and knit **13 (13-14-14-16)** sts up Right Front neck edge. **K7 (7-7-9-9)** from Right Sleeve st holder, dec 1 st at center. **K21 (23-25-25-27)** from Back st holder, dec **0 (0-0-2-0)** sts evenly across. **70 (74-78-82-86)** sts.

Beg on a 2nd row, work 7 rows in (K2. P2) ribbing as given for Back. Change to larger needles and cont in ribbing until Collar measures **5 (5½-6-6-7)**" [**12.5 (14.5-15-15-18)** cm], ending on a WS row. Cast off loosely in ribbing. Sew left back raglan and Collar seam, reversing seam for turnback.

Sew side and sleeve seams.
