## GAUGES

15 sts and 20 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st.
24 sts and 40 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in Double stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Start knitting!
- When joining additional O'Gos, join the opposite (light/dark) end of the new O'Go as the previous O'Go to ensure ombre effect flows well (as shown in photo).
- Body is knit in the round in one piece to armholes.


## BODY

Beg with dark end of O'Go, cast on 216 (240-264-288-336-384) sts. Join in rnd, being careful not to twist sts and PM for beg of rnd.
1st rnd: *K1. SI1Pwyif. Rep from * around.
2nd rnd: *SI1Pwyib. P1. Rep from * around.

Rep last 2 rnds for Double stocking st for 3 " $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## Proceed as follows:

1st rnd: (Dec rnd). *K1. (K2tog) twice. K1. K2tog. Rep from * around. 135 (150-165-180-210240) sts.

2nd rnd: Knit, dec 1 (0-1-$0-0-0$ ) st(s) at beg of rnd. 134 (150-164-180-210-240) sts.

Knit in rnds until work from beg measures 14 (14-15-15-16-16)" [35.5 (35.5-38-38-40.5-40.5) cm].

Divide for Front and Back: 1st rnd: [Cast off 7 (9-10-12-2027) sts. K60 (66-72-78-84-92) (including st after cast off)] twice.

Slip last 60 (66-72-78-84-92) sts onto a long st holder for BACK.

Work on rem 60 (66-72-78-8492) sts for FRONT in rows as follows: 1st row: (RS). SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 58 (64-70-76-82-90) sts.
2nd row: Sl1Pwyif. P2tog. Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1. 56 (62-68-74-80-88) sts.

## Shape Left Front V-neck:

 1st row: (RS). Sl1Pwyib. ssk. K22 (25-28-31-34-38). K2tog. K1. Turn. Leave rem sts on a st holder for Right Front.Cont on these 26 (29-32-35-3842) sts for Left Front as follows:

2nd row: SI1Pwyif. Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1. 25 (28-31-34-37-41) sts.
3rd row: SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 23 (26-29-32-35-39) sts.
Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 1 (2-2-2-2-4) time(s) more. 20 (20-23-26-2927) sts.

Next row: (WS). SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 18 (18-21-24-27-25) sts.

Rep last 2 rows 1 (0-0-0-0-0) time(s) more. 16 (18-21-24-27-25) sts.

Next row: (WS). SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to end of row. 15 (17-20-23-2624) sts.

Next row: Sl1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 13 (15-18-21-24-22) sts.
Rep last 4 rows 0 (1-1-2-2-1) time(s) more. 13 (12-15-15-18-19) sts.

Next row: (WS). SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: Sl1Pwyib. Knit to end of row.
Next row: Sl1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: SI1Pwyib. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 11 (11-14-14-1718) sts.

Rep last 4 rows 3 (2-3-2-3-4) time(s) more. 9 (9-11-12-14-14) sts.

Cont even in stocking st (maintaining SI1Pwyif/SI1Pwyib as established) until armhole measures $61 / 2$ (7-71/2-8-81/2-9)" [16.5 (18-19-20.5-21.5-23) cm], ending on a purl row. Cast off knitwise.

Shape Right Front V-Neck: Slip 28 (31-34-37-40-44) sts from Right Front st holder onto working needle and join yarn.
Note: When joining yarn find the best match of shade to ensure ombre effect flows well.

1st row: (RS). SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 26 (29-32-35-38-42) sts.
2nd row: SI1Pwyif. P2tog. Purl to end of row. 25 (28-31-34-37-41)
3rd row: SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 23 (26-29-32-3539) sts.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 1 (2-2-2-2-4) time(s) more. 20 (20-23-26-2927) sts.

Next row: (WS). SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: Sl1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 18 (18-21-24-2725) sts.

Rep last 2 rows 1 ( $0-0-0-0-0$ ) time(s) more. 16 (18-21-24-27-25) sts.

Next row: (WS). SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: SI1Pwyib. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 15 (17-20-23-2624) sts.

Next row: SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: Sl1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 13 (15-18-21-2422) sts.

Rep last 4 rows 0 (1-1-2-2-1) time(s) more. 13 (12-15-15-18-19) sts.

Next row: (WS). SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: Sl1Pwyib. Knit to end of row.
Next row: Sl1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Next row: Sl1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to end of row. 11 (11-14-14-17-18) sts.
Rep last 4 rows 3 (2-3-2-3-4) time(s) more. 9 (9-11-12-14-14) sts.

Cont even (maintaining SI1Pwyif/ SIIPwyib as established) until armhole measures $61 / 2(7-71 / 2-8$ -8½-9)" [16.5 (18-19-20.5-21.5-23) cm ], ending on a purl row. Cast off knitwise.

## BACK

Note: When joining yarn find the best match of shade to ensure ombre effect flows well.

With RS facing, join yarn to rem 60 (66-72-78-84-92) sts for Back.
1st row: (RS). SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 58 (64-70-76-82-90) sts.
2nd row: SI1Pwyif. P2tog. Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. K1. 56 (62-68-74-80-88) sts.
Rep last 2 rows 2 (3-3-3-3-5) times more. 48 (50-56-62-68-68) sts.

Next row: (RS). SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 46 (48-54-60-66-66) sts.
Next row: SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows 4 (5-5-7-7-5) times more. 38 (38-44-46-52-56) sts.

Cont even (maintaining SI1Pwyif/ SI1Pwyib as established) until Back measures 4 rows shorter than Front, ending on a purl row.

Back neck shaping: 1st row: (RS).
SI1Pwyib. K8 (8-10-11-13-13). K2tog. K1. Turn. Leave rem sts on a spare needle. 11 (11-13-14-1616) sts.

2nd row: SI1Pwyif. P2tog. Purl to end of row. 10 (10-12-13-15-15) sts. 3rd row: SI1Pwyib. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 9 (9-11-12-14-14) sts.
4th row: SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Cast off knitwise.
With RS facing, join yarn to rem sts and cast off next 14 (14-16-16-1822) sts.

1st row: SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to end of row. 11 (11-13-14-16-16) sts.
2nd row: SI1Pwyif. Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1. 10 (10-12-13-15-15) sts.
3rd row: SI1Pwyib. ssk. Knit to end of row. 9 (9-11-12-14-14) sts.
4th row: SI1Pwyif. Purl to end of row.
Cast off knitwise.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.
