MATERIALS

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Blushing Coral (01033) 5 balls

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Tog = Tog

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 18 x 60" [45.5 x 152.5 cm].

GAUGE

12 dc and $6\frac{1}{2}$ rows = 4° [10 cm] in • pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ multishade yarn braid, separate each color link and wind into 5 separate balls.



- Due to a finite amount of yarn in each shade, pattern gauge must be matched to ensure successful results.
- Ch-3 at beg of rows counts as dc throughout.

Right Side

With A, ch 42.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each ch to last ch. [(1 dc. Ch 1) 4 times. 1 dc] all in last ch. Working across opposite side of foundation ch, 1 dc in each ch to last 6 ch. Turn. Leave rem 6 ch unworked.

2nd row: (WS). Ch 3. 1 dc in each dc to first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in first ch-1 sp. [(1 dc. Ch 1) twice. 1 dc] in next dc – corner made. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: (RS). Ch 3. 1 dc in each dc **6th row:** (RS). As 5th row. Fasten to first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in first ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each of next 5 dc. With RS facing, join C with sl st to 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Corner in next first dc of 6th row. dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in 7th to 9th rows: With C, as 4th to each dc to end of row. Fasten off. 6th rows. Do not turn.

With RS facing, join B with sl st to first dc of Row 3.

4th row: (RS). With B, ch 8. 1 dc to 6th rows. in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). 1 dc in each of next 4 ch. Working in back loops only, 1 dc in first dc of 12th row. next dc (same st as joining sl st). 1 dc in each dc to first ch-1 sp. 1 dc to 6th rows. in first ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. Fasten off. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next Left Side ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc Work as given for Right Side, to last 6 dc. **Turn.** Leave rem 6 dc unworked.

5th row: (WS). Ch 3. Working in both loops, 1 dc in each dc to first ch-1 sp. 1 dc in first ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. Corner in next dc. 1 dc in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.

With RS facing, join D with sl st to first dc of 9th row.

10th to 12th rows: With D, as 4th

With RS facing, join E with sl st to

13th to 15th rows: With E, as 4th

in next ch-1 sp. 1 dc in each dc noting RS and WS will be reversed, and working 4th, 7th, 10th and 13th rows in front loops only.

FINISHING

Sew Right and Left Sides tog between corners.
