



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (Approx) 7" x 70"
[18 x 178 cm].

GAUGE

17 stitches (sts) and 32 rows = 4"
[10 cm] in garter stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

With A, cast on 2 stitches (sts).

1st row: (Right side – RS). Knit into front and back of first stitch (Kfb). Knit 1 stitch (K1). 3 stitches (sts) total.

2nd and alternate (alt) rows: Knit.

3rd row: Kfb. K2. 4 sts total.

5th row: Kfb. Knit to end of row.

6th row: Knit.

Repeat (Rep) last 2 rows until there are 30 sts. Break A. Join B. Place marker (PM) at end of last row.

With B, work in garter st (knit every row) until work from marked row measures 50" [127 cm], ending on a Wrong side (WS) row. Break B. Join C.

Next row: With C, knit first 2 stitches together (K2tog). Knit to end of row.

Next row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows until 2 sts remain (rem). Cast off rem 2 sts.

MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m)

Contrast A Robins Egg (9780) **1 ball**

Contrast B Pagoda (0014) **1 ball**

Contrast C Super Duper Yellow (9612) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Stitch marker.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Approx = Approximately

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch

by knitting into front and back of next stitch

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remain(ing)

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side
