



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)

**Beg** = Begin(ing)

**Ch** = Chain(s)

**Cont** = Continue

**Dc** = Double crochet

**Dc2tog** = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

**Dec** = Decrease(ing)

**Inc** = Increase(ing)

**Rem** = Remain(ing)

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx. 60" [152.5 cm] wide x 15" [38 cm] deep.

## GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Note:** Shawl is worked side to side. Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.

Ch 4.

**1st row:** (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 2 dc). Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 3. 2 dc in next dc. Turn. 3 dc.

**3rd row:** Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn. 4 dc.

**4th row:** Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn. 5 dc.

**5th row:** Ch 3. 1 dc in first dc. 1 dc each dc to end of row. Turn. 6 dc.

**6th row:** Ch 3. 1 dc in each dc to last dc. 2 dc in last dc. Turn. 7 dc. Rep last 2 rows, inc 1 dc every row at same edge, until work measures approx. 30" [76 cm] along straight side edge.

**Beg dec: 1st row:** Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in each dc to last 2 dc. Dc2tog. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 2. Yoh and draw up a loop in next st. (Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice – beg dc2tog made. 1 dc in each dc to end of row. Turn.



## MATERIALS

**Caron® Cakes™** (7.1 oz/200 g; 383 yds/350 m)  
Jellyroll (17012) **1 ball**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

Rep last 2 rows, dec 1 st every row at same edge until there are 2 dc.

**Next row:** Beg dc2tog. Fasten off.

### **Tassels** (make 2)

Cut a piece of cardboard 8" [20.5 cm] wide. Wind yarn around cardboard 30 times. Break yarn, leaving a long end, and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops  $\frac{3}{4}$ " [2 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim end evenly.

Sew 1 Tassel to each point of Kerchief.
