## 3 O'Gos

Size U.S. 10 ( 6 mm ) circular knitting needle 36 " [ 91.5 cm ] long or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle. Stitch marker. Crochet hook for applying fringe.

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## ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit
Inc = Increase(ing)
M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of

Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side loop point, excluding fringe.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 90" [228.5 cm] at longest point x 25 " $[63.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ at widest


## GAUGE

15 sts and 26 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in garter stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Start knitting!
- Increases (inc) are made on every RS row. To help keep track of this, you may find it helpful to place a st marker on RS of work.
- Shawl is worked from bottom up
- When necessary, join new O'Go's dark end to dark end to continue ombre effect.

Working from lightest end of O'Go, cast on 138 stitches (sts). Do not join. Working back and forth across needle, proceed as follows:
1st row: (Wrong Side - WS). Knit. 2nd row: (Right Side - RS). Knit 1 (K1). Make 1 (M1 - see abbreviation). Knit to last st. M1. K1.
Repeat (Rep) last 2 rows, inc 1 st at each end of every RS row to 300 sts, ending on a WS row.
Cast off loosely.

## FINISHING

Cut lengths of yarn 30" [76 cm] long. Taking 3 strands together (tog), fold in half and knot into fringe evenly across 2 shorter sides of Shawl. Trim fringe evenly.
