



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

ABBREVIATIONS

K = Knit

Inc = Increase(ing)

M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop

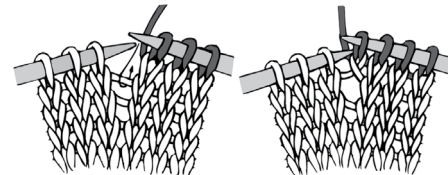
Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side



MEASUREMENTS

Approx 90" [228.5 cm] at longest point x 25" [63.5 cm] at widest point, excluding fringe.

GAUGE

15 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

MATERIALS

Caron® Colorama Halo™ O'Go™ (8 oz/227 g; 481 yds/440 m)

Beeswax Frost (28002)

3 O'Gos

Size U.S. 10 (6 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle. Stitch marker. Crochet hook for applying fringe.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Start knitting!
- Increases (inc) are made on every RS row. To help keep track of this, you may find it helpful to place a st marker on RS of work.
- Shawl is worked from bottom up
- When necessary, join new O'Go's dark end to dark end to continue ombre effect.

Working from lightest end of O'Go, cast on 138 stitches (sts). **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle, proceed as follows:

1st row: (Wrong Side - WS). Knit.

2nd row: (Right Side - RS). Knit 1 (K1). Make 1 (M1 – see abbreviation). Knit to last st. M1. K1.

Repeat (Rep) last 2 rows, inc 1 st at each end of every RS row to 300 sts, ending on a WS row.

Cast off loosely.

FINISHING

Cut lengths of yarn 30" [76 cm] long. Taking 3 strands together (tog), fold in half and knot into fringe evenly across 2 shorter sides of Shawl. Trim fringe evenly.
