LET'S BEGIN CROCHET SCARF | CROCHET



### **MATERIALS**

Caron<sup>®</sup> Simply Soft<sup>®</sup> Tweeds<sup>™</sup> (5 oz/141 g; 250 yds/228 m) Taupe Tweeds (23003)

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.



CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

**Approx** = Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

**Hdc** = Half double crochet

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side **Tog** = Together **WS** = Wrong side

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 9" x 90" [23 x 228.5 cm], excluding fringe.

# **GAUGE**

13 hdc and 9 rows = 4'' [10 cm] in hdc.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Chain (ch) 32.

1st row: [Right Side (RS)]. 1 half double crochet (hdc) in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 30 hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2 (does not count as hdc). 1 hdc in first hdc. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Repeat (rep) 2nd row until work measures approximately (approx) 90" [228.5 cm] long, ending on a Wrong Side (WS) row. Fasten off.

Fringe: Cut strands of yarn 16" [40.5 cm] long. Taking 2 strands together (tog), fold in half and knot into fringe across both ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
