## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\ominus}$ Tweeds $^{\mathrm{Tm}}$ ( $5 \mathrm{oz} / 141 \mathrm{~g} ; 250 \mathrm{yds} / 228 \mathrm{~m}$ ) Taupe Tweeds (23003) 3 balls
Size U.S. H/8 ( 5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

## CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

## ABBREVIATIONS

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Approx = Approximately
Ch = Chain(s)
Hdc = Half double crochet
RS \(=\) Right side
Tog = Together
ws = Wrong side
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Rep $=$ Repeat

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 9" x 90" [23 x 228.5 cm ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

13 hdc and 9 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in hdc.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Chain (ch) 32.

1st row: [Right Side (RS)]. 1 half double crochet (hdc) in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 30 hdc .
2nd row: Ch 2 (does not count as hdc). 1 hdc in first hdc. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. Repeat (rep) 2nd row until work measures approximately (approx) 90 " [228.5 cm ] long, ending on a Wrong Side (WS) row. Fasten off.

Fringe: Cut strands of yarn 16" [ 40.5 cm ] long. Taking 2 strands together (tog), fold in half and knot into fringe across both ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
