



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remain(ing)

RS = Right side

SM = Slip marker

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through the back loops together.

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MATERIALS

Caront® Simply Soft® O'Go™ (5 oz/141 g; 250 yds/228 m)

Sizes XS/S M L XL 2/3XL 4/5XL

Contrast A and B:

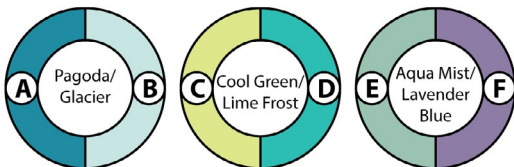
Pagoda/Glacier (40005) 2 3 3 4 4 5 O'Gos

Contrast C and D:

Cool Green/Lime Frost (40008) 2 2 2 3 3 3 O'Gos

Contrast E and F:

Aqua Mist/Lavender Blue (40030) 1 1 2 2 3 3 O'Go(s)



Size U.S. 8 [5 mm] circular knitting needle 29" [73.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle. Stitch marker.

SIZES

To fit bust measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm]
M 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]
L 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]
XL 44-46" [112-117 cm]
2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm]
4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

Finished bust measurement

XS/S 40½" [103 cm]
M 44" [112 cm]
L 48" [122 cm]
XL 52½" [133.5 cm]
2/3XL 56½" [143.5 cm]
4/5XL 64" [162.5 cm]

GAUGE

17 sts and 34 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Easily separate colors of each O'go by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition.
- Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go Contrast A to E.

SECTION ONE

With A, cast on **86** (**94-102-224-112-124**) sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Sizes XS/S, M, L, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

Work in garter st, noting that first row is WS for **2** (**2-1-2-3**)" [**5** (**5-2.5-5-7.5**) cm], ending with a WS row.

Do not turn work. PM at end of row. Cast on **86** (**94-102-112-124**) sts. **172** (**188-204-224-248**) sts.

Size XL only: Next row: (WS). K112. PM. K112. 224 sts.

All sizes:

Knit **2** (**2-2-0-2-2**) rows.

****1st row:** (RS). Knit to 2 sts before marker. K2tog. SM. ssk. Knit to end of row. **170** (**186-202-222-222-246**) sts.

2nd row: Knit.

These 2 rows form Mitered Pat.

Rep last 2 rows until work from initial cast on measures **5** (**5-4½-4¼-5½-7**)" [**12.5** (**12.5-11.5-11-14-18**) cm], ending with a WS row. Break A. Join B. Cont in Mitered Pat with B until work from initial cast on measures **8** (**8½-8-8-9-11**)" [**20.5** (**21.5-20.5-20.5-23-28**) cm], ending with a WS row.

Break B. Join C. Cont in Mitered Pat with C until work from initial cast-on measures **11** (**11½-11½-11¾-12½-15**)" [**28** (**29-29-30-32-38**) cm], ending with a WS row.

Break C. Join D. Cont in Mitered Pat with D until work from initial cast-on measures **14** (**14½-15-15-19½-23**)" [**35.6** (**37-38-38-49.5-58.5**) cm], ending with a WS row.

Break D. Join E. Cont in Mitered Pat with E until work from initial cast-on measures **17** (**17½-18½-18¾-21½-26**)" [**43** (**44.5-47.5-49-54.5-66**) cm], ending with a WS row.

Break E. Join F. Cont in Mitered Pat with F until 2 sts rem.

Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.**

SECTION TWO

With A, cast on **86** (**94-102-224-112-124**) sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

Sizes XS/S, M, L, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

Work in garter st, noting that first row is WS for **2** (**2-1-2-3**)" [**5** (**5-2.5-5-7.5**) cm], ending with a RS row.

Do not turn work. PM at end of row. Cast on **86** (**94-102-112-124**) sts. **172** (**188-204-224-248**) sts.

Size XL only: Next row: (WS). K112. PM. K112. 224 sts.

All sizes:

Knit **1** (**1-1-2-1-1**) row(s).

Work from ** to ** as given for Section One.

FINISHING

With RS of Section One and Section Two facing each other, sew shoulder seams, leaving **12¼** (**12-12-12¼-12¼-14**)" [**31** (**30.5-30.5-31-31-35.5**) cm] open at center for neck. Sew side seams, leaving **7** (**7½-8-8½-9-10**)" [**18** (**19-20.5-21.5-23-25.5**) cm] open for armholes.
