## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\oplus}$ ( 6 oz/170 g; 315 yds/288 m)

| Contrast A Grey Heather (9509) | $\mathbf{4}$ balls |
| :--- | :--- |
| Contrast B Sage (9705) | $\mathbf{3}$ balls |
| Contrast C Victorian Rose (9721) | $\mathbf{2}$ balls |

Size U.S. I/9 ( 5.5 mm ) crochet hook, or size to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximately BPdc $=$ Back-post double crochet. Yarn over, insert hook from back to front and then to back again around post of stitch, yarn over and draw up loop, complete as dc.
BPtr $=$ Back-post treble crochet. Yarn over twice, insert hook from back to front and then to back again around post of stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, complete as tr.

## Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet FPdc $=$ Front-post double crochet. Yarn over, insert hook from front to back and then to front again around post of stitch, yarn over and draw up loop, complete as dc.
FPtr $=$ Front-post treble crochet. Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back and then to front again around post of stitch, yarn over and
draw up a loop, complete as tr. Pat $=$ Pattern
$\mathbf{P c}=$ Popcorn stitch. 5 dc in indicated space, drop loop from hook, insert hook in first dc (of the 5-dc just made), pick up dropped loop and draw through.
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
Shell $=5 \mathrm{dc}$ in indicated space. Open-shell = (Dc, ch 1, dc,
ch $1, \mathrm{dc}$ ) in indicated space. Tr $=$ Treble crochet

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 45 " $[114 \mathrm{~cm}]$ wide $\times 62$ " $[157.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ long.

## GAUGE

12 sts and $7 ½$ rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in basket weave pattern. post and shell panel $=6 \frac{1}{4}$ " $[16 \mathrm{~cm}]$ wide in shell pattern. shell and popcorn panel $=5 "[12.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ wide in shell pattern.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Basket Weave Panel (make 4)

With A, ch 13.
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn-12 sc.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each st across, turn.
Row 3: Ch 3, [FPtr around next 2 sts, BPtr around next 2 sts] twice, FPtr around next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn-2 dc, 6 FPtr, and 4 BPtr.
Row 4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), [BPdc around next 2 sts, FPdc around next 2 sts] twice, BPdc around next 2 sts, hdc in last st, turn-2 hdc, 4 FPdc, and 6 BPdc.
Row 5: Ch 3, [BPtr around next 2 sts, FPtr around next 2 sts] twice, BPtr around next 2 sts, dc in last st, turn-2 dc, 6 BPtr, and 4 FPtr.
Row 6: Ch 2, [FPdc around next 2 sts, BPdc around next 2 sts]
twice, FPdc around next 2 sts, hdc in last st, turn -2 hdc, 6 FPdc, and 4 BPdc.
Rows 7-110: Repeat Rows 3-6.twenty-six times.

## Rows 111--113: Repeat Rows 3-5.

Row 114: Ch 1, sc in each st across, do not turn.
Side Edging: Row 1: Working in ends of rows, sc in end of first 2 rows, *2 sc in end of next row, sc in end of next row; repeat from * across side edge-170 sc. Fasten off.

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## Post and Shell Panel (make 3)

With B, ch 22.
Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across- 21 sc .
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), [dc in next sc, skip next 2 sc , shell in next sc, skip next 2 sc$] 3$ times, dc in last 2 sc , turn- 6 dc , and 3 shells
Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), [BPdc around next st, ch 2, sk next 2 dc , sc in center dc of next shell, ch 2, sk next 2 dc 3 times, BPdc around next st, hdc in last st, turn-2 hdc, $4 \mathrm{BPdc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$, and $6 \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$.
Row 4: Ch 3, [FPdc around next st, sk next ch-2 sp, shell in next sc, sk next ch-2 sp] 3 times, FPdc around next st, dc in last st, turn-2 dc, 4 FPdc, and 3 shells.
Rows 5-113: Repeat Rows 3 and 4 fifty-four times, then repeat Row 3 once more.
Row 114: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, sc in each ch and st across, do not turn-21 sc.
Side Edging: Work as for basket weave panel side edging.

## Shell and Popcorn Panel (make 2)

With C, ch 18.
Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across- 17 sc
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, [skip next 3 sc , ch 1, open-shell in next sc, skip next 3 sc , ch 1, sc in next sc] twice, turn-3 sc, 2 open-shells, and 4 ch- 1 sps.
Row 3: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), sc in center dc of next open-shell, ch 3, pc in next sc, ch 4 , sc in center dc of next open-shell, ch 3, dc in last sc, turn-2 dc, 2 sc, 1 pc, 2 ch-3 sps, and 1 ch-4 sp.
Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first dc, ch 1, open-shell in next sc, ch 1, sc in top of next pc, ch 1, open-shell in next sc, ch 1 , sc in 3rd ch of turning ch, turn-3 sc, 2 open-shells, and 4 ch-1 sps.
Rows 5-113: Repeat Rows 3 and 4 fifty-four times, then repeat Row 3 once more.
Row 114: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, sc in each ch and st across, do not turn-21 sc.
Side Edging: Work as for basket weave panel side edging.

## Finishing

Arrange panels according to assembly diagram. Using yarn needle, whipstitch panels together through back loops only. Using yarn needle, weave in all remaining ends.
