

## MATERIALS

Caron ${ }^{\circledR}$ Simply Soft ${ }^{\circledR}$ (Solids: 6 oz/170.1 g; 315 yds/288 m; Paints: 4 oz/ $113.4 \mathrm{~g} ; 204 \mathrm{yds} / 186 \mathrm{~m} ;$ Heathers: $5 \mathrm{oz} / 141.7 \mathrm{~g} ; 250 \mathrm{yds} / 228 \mathrm{~m})$
Contrast A Sticks and Stones (P0009) 1 ball
Contrast B Charcoal Heather (H9508) 1 ball
Contrast C Grey Heather (H9509) 1 ball
Contrast D Off White (39702) 2 balls
Size U.S. H/8 ( 5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 10 " x 100" [ $25.5 \times 254 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

Granny Square (make 10)
See diagram on page 2.
With A, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.
1st rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 11 dc in ring. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.12 dc .

2nd rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. 2 dc in each of next 11 dc . Join with sl st to top of ch 3.24 dc .
3rd rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 1. Skip next dc. 3 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last dc. Ch 1. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

4th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 2.3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * around to last 3 dc . Ch 2 . Join B with sl st to top of ch 3 .
5th rnd: Ch 4 (counts as tr). 2 tr in same sp as last sl st. Ch 1.3 dc in next ch 2 sp . Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. *(3 tr. Ch 3.3 tr$)$ in next ch-2 sp. (Ch 1.3 dc in next ch-2 sp) twice. Ch 1. Rep from * to last ch-2 sp. 3 tr in last ch-2 sp. Ch 3. Join with sl st to top of beg ch 4.
6th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 1.3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2.3 dc ) in corner ch-3 sp. (Ch 1.3 dc ) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1.3 dc in last ch 3 sp. Ch 2. Join C with sl st to top of ch 3.
7th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 1.3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2.3 dc ) in corner
ch-2 sp. (Ch 1.3 dc ) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1.3 dc in last ch 2 sp . Ch 2. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.
8th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 1.3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2.3 dc ) in corner ch-2 sp. (Ch 1.3 dc ) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1.3 dc in last ch-2 sp. Ch 2. Join D with sl st to top of ch 3.
9th and 10th rnds: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 1.3 dc ) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc ) in corner ch-2 sp. (Ch 1.3 dc ) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 3 dc in last ch-2 sp. Ch 2 . Join with sl st to top of ch 3.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew 10 Granny Squares tog end to end to form Scarf.

Fringe: Cut strands of D 20 " $[51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] long. Taking 4 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe across ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
