

MATERIALS
Caron ${ }^{\otimes}$ Simply Soft $\mathbf{O}^{\prime} \mathbf{G o}^{\text {rm }}$ ( $5 \mathrm{oz} / 141 \mathrm{~g} ; 235 \mathrm{yds} / 215 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A \& B Graphite/White (40027) 2 O'Gos
Contrast C \& D Pagoda Glacier (40005 2 O'Gos
Contrast E \& F Harvest Red/Soft Pink (40019) 2 O'Gos


Size U.S. 8 [ 5 mm ] knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Yarn needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg $=$ Beginning
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit
Rem = Remain(ing)
RS $=$ Right side
St(s) = Stitch(es)

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 10" x 70 " [ $25.5 \times 178 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## GAUGE

17 sts and 32 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in garter st.
$\mathbf{W \& T}=($ Wrap \& turn). Bring yarn to front of work. Slip next stitch purlwise. Bring yarn to back of work. Slip stitch back onto lefthand needle. Turn.


WS = Wrong side

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

- To begin working with O'Go, locate the end of the yarn.
- Carefully cut plastic tie where ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull to remove tie.


## Yarnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A through F). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A through F.


Make 4 Color 1: B Color 2: A


Make 6 Color 1: C Color 2: B


Make 4
Color 1: F
Color 2: D


Make 4
Color 1: F
Color 2: E


## SCARF BLOCKS

Make 4 using $B$ as Color 1 and $A$ as Color 2.
Make 6 using $C$ as Color 1 and $B$ as Color 2.
Make 4 using F as Color 1 and D as Color 2.
Make 4 using F as Color 1 and E as
Color 2.
Make 4 using C as Color 1 and A as Color 2.
Make 6 using E as Color 1 and D as Color 2.

Triangle 1: With Color 1, cast on 23 sts.
1st row: (RS). Knit.
**2nd row: K21. W\&T.
3rd row: Knit.
4th row: (WS). Knit to 1 st before last wrapped st. W\&T.
5th row: (RS). Knit.
Rep last 2 rows until 2 sts rem.
Next row: (WS). K1. W\&T.
Next row: K1.
Next row: K23.
Break Color 1.
Triangle 2: With Color 2, proceed as follows:
1st row: (RS). Knit.
2nd row: Knit.
3rd row: K1. W\&T.
4th row: Knit.

5th row: Knit to 1 st after last wrapped st. W\&T.

## 6th row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows until 1 st rem after wrapped st and last row is K21.
(1 st remains unworked after last wrapped st. 1st row of next Triangle is worked across all 23 sts) Cast off purlwise.

## FINISHING

Pin Scarf Blocks to measure approx 5 " $[12.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$ square. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry. Sew seams between Blocks as shown in Assembly Diagram using a flat seam.
