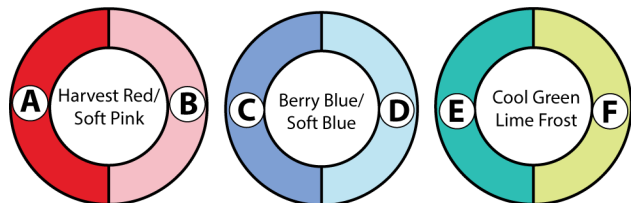
MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® O'Go™ (5 oz/141 g; 250 yds/228 m)

Contrast A and B: Harvest Red/Soft Pink (40019) **3 O'Gos**

Contrast C and D: Berry Blue/Soft Blue (40025) **3 O'Gos**

Contrast E and F: Cool Green/Lime Frost (40024) **3 O'Gos**



Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 7" [18 cm] wide piece of cardboard for tassels. Yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 52" x 57½" [132 x 146 cm], excluding tassels.

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Easily separate colors of each O'go by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition.
- Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go Contrast A to F.

Stripe Pat

With A: 20 rows.

**With B: 18 rows.

With C: 18 rows.

With E: 18 rows.

With F: 18 rows.

With D: 18 rows.

With A: 18 rows.**

Rep from ** to ** twice more.

These 344 rows complete Stripe Pat.

BLANKET

With A, cast on 235 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Knit 2 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is RS.

1st row: (RS). K3. *yo. K3. Sl1. K2tog. pss0. K3. yo. K1. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

2nd row: K2. Purl to last 2 sts. K2.

These 2 rows form Zig Zag Pat.

First 4 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, cont in Zig Zag Pat until 344 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

With A, knit 2 rows (garter st).
Cast off.

Tassels (make 4)

Cut a piece of cardboard 7" [17.5 cm] wide. Holding B, C, D, E and F tog, wind yarn around cardboard 30 times. Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops 1" [2.5 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim ends evenly. Sew a Tassel to each corner of Blanket.
