



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 34" x 37" [86.5 x 94 cm].

GAUGE

16 sts and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With A, work 28 rows.

With B, work 12 rows.

With C, work 28 rows.

With B, work 12 rows.

With D, work 28 rows.

With B, work 12 rows.

With E, work 28 rows.

These 148 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, cast on 135 sts. **Do not** join. *Working back and forth across needle in rows,* proceed as follows:

1st row: Knit.

2nd row: (RS). Sl1. *K1below. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

3rd row: Sl1. *K1. K1below. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

These 2 rows form pat. First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in pat as established, keeping cont of Stripe Pat until 148 rows of pat have been completed.

With E, cast off (WS).

MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170g; 315 yds/288 m)

Contrast A Ocean (9759) **1 ball**

Contrast B White (9701) **2 balls**

Contrast C Blue Mint (9608) **1 ball**

Contrast D Robin's Egg (9780) **1 ball**

Contrast E Watermelon (9604) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K1below = Knit 1 stitch
1 row below at same time
slipping off stitch above



Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sl1 = Slip next stitch
knitwise

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side
