



EY1037 Cygnet Seriously Chunky Geometric Pouffe

Measurements

Finished size: 44 cm diameter, 36cm height

Materials

Col A: Seriously Chunky Cream	4
Col B: Seriously Chunky Barley	4
Col C: Seriously Chunky Sage	4
Col D: Seriously Chunky Slate Grey	4

Pouffe or beanbag measuring approximately 42cm in diameter and 36cm in height (I used one from Dunelm Mill)

Hooks

10mm hook
12mm hook

Tension

Finished triangle measures approx. 18cm height, 21 cm width

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If you tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

Abbreviations

Ch chain

Chsp chain space

Col colour

Dc double crochet – insert hook into stitch, yrh and pull through stitch (2 loops on hook), yrh pull through both loops on hook

Tr treble crochet – yrh, insert hook into stitch, yrh and pull through stitch (3 loops on hook), yrh, pull through first two loops on hook (2 loops on hook), yrh and pull through two sts on hook

Yrh wrap yarn around hook

TRIANGLES (make 6 of each col)

With 12mm hook:

R1: ch 3, dc into 3rd ch from hook

R2: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next st (3 sts)

R3: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 2 sts (4 sts)

R4: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 3 sts (5 sts)

R5: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 4 sts (6 sts)

R6: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 5 sts (7 sts)

R7: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 6 sts (8 sts)

R8: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 7 sts (9 sts)

R9: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 8 sts (10 sts)


R10: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 9 sts (11 sts)

R11: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 10 sts (12 sts)

R12: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 11 sts (13 sts)

R13: ch 3, dc into same st, dc in next 12 sts (14 sts)

Using whip stitch (overcast st) join all triangles in following layout and then join the ends to form a large circle. Tie in loose ends.



TOP/BOTTOM (make two)

With 12mm hook and Col A:

R1: ch 4, join with slst to form a ring

R2: *tr 2 into ring, ch 2; rep from * another 5 times

R3: ch 3 (forms first tr), tr in same st, tr in next st, tr in ch sp, ch 2, *tr in chsp, tr in next 2 sts, tr in chsp, ch 2; rep 4 more times. Join to form a ring and fasten off.

Attach Col B

R4: ch 3 (forms first tr), tr in same st, tr in next 2 sts, tr in ch sp, ch 2, *tr in chsp, tr in next 3 sts, tr in chsp, ch 2; rep 4 more times. Join to form a ring.

R5: ch 3 (forms first tr), tr in same st, tr in next 3 sts, tr in ch sp, ch 2, *tr in chsp, tr in next 4 sts, tr in chsp, ch 2; rep 4 more times. Join to form a ring and fasten off.

R7: ch 3 (forms first tr), tr in same st, tr in next 5 sts, tr in ch sp, ch 2, *tr in chsp, tr in next 6 sts, tr in chsp, ch 2; rep 4 more times. Join to form a ring and fasten off.

Attach Col D

R8: ch 3 (forms first tr), tr in same st, tr in next 6 sts, tr in ch sp, ch 2, *tr in chsp, tr in next 7 sts, tr in chsp, ch 2; rep 4 more times. Join to form a ring.

R9: ch 3 (forms first tr), tr in same st, tr in next 7 sts, tr in ch sp, ch 2, *tr in chsp, tr in next 8 sts, tr in chsp, ch 2; rep 4 more times. Join to form a ring and fasten off.

Making up

Pin top in place over the circle formed by the triangles, lining up the edges of the hexagon of the top with the triangles around the edges. Using Col D, dc through each st around edge through back loops only of top and edge. Repeat for bottom. Tie in loose ends.
