



**CY1064 Cygnet Pure Wool Superwash DK
Ozzy the Owl by Val Pierce**

Measurements

Owl stands approx. 25cm tall

Materials

1 x 50g ball Pure Wool Superwash DK in the following shades

Copper 4888

Gold 2155

Stone 4199

Cream 2195

Mocha 972

Needles

1 pair of 3.75mm (UK 8 – US 6)

Other materials

Toy stuffing

Tension

19 stitches and 26 rows to
10cm (4in) over stocking stitch
on 4mm needles

Abbreviations

k	knit	inc	increase	dec	decrease	patt	pattern
p	purl	foll	following	st	stitches	stst	stocking stitch

Back

Using Stone and 3.75m needles
cast on 28 sts
Work in stst for 2 rows
Now Inc 1 st at each end of next
and following alt rows to 56sts
Work 10 rows in stst
Change to Mocha and work 2
rows garter stitch
Begin stripe pattern :
Change to Stone, work 2 rows
stst
Change to Gold and work 2 rows
stst
Change to Mocha and work 2
rows stst
Work 24 more rows
Keeping stripe sequence correct :
Dec 1 st at each end on the next
and following 2 alternate rows.
Purl 1 row and cast off

Front

Using Mocha and 3.75m needles
cast on 28 sts
Next Row : inc in first st, knit to
last st, inc (30 sts)
Next Row : Knit, Join In Stone

Next Row Using Stone : inc in 1st
st, sl 2, * K6, sl2, rep from * to
last st, inc in last st (32 sts)
Next Row : Using Stone : p2, sl2,
* P6, sl2, rep from * to last 2sts,
p2
Next Row : Using Stone : inc in
next st, k1, sl2 * k6, sl2, rep to
last 2sts, k1, inc in last st (34 sts)
Next Row : Using Stone : p3,
sl2, * p6, sl2, rep from * to last
sts, p3
Next row : Using Stone : inc in
first st, k2, sl2 * K6, sl2. Rep from
* to last 3 sts, k2, inc in last st (36
sts)
Next Row : Using Stone : p4.
sl2, *p6,sl2, rep from * last 4 sts,
p4
Next Row : Using Mocha inc,
knit to last st, inc (38 sts)
Next row : Using Mocha knit
Next Row : Using Stone, inc in
first st, sl2, *k6, sl2, rep to last
3sts, sl2, inc in last st (40 sts)
Next row : Using Stone : p2, sl 2,
* p6, sl2, rep from * to last 4 sts,
sl 2, p2

Next Row : Using Stone : inc in
first st, k1, sl2, * k6, sl2, rep from
* to last 2sts, k1, inc in last st (42
sts)
Next Row : Using Stone : p3, sl2,
*p6, sl2, rep from * to last 3sts,
p3
Next Row : Using Stone : inc in
first st, k2, sl2, *k6, sl2, rep from
* to last 3 sts, k2, inc in last st
Next Row : Using Stone , p4, sl
2, * p6, sl 2, rep from * to last 4
sts, p4. (44 sts)
Next Row : Using Mocha : inc in
first st, knit to last st, inc in last st
(46 sts)
Next Row : Using Mocha : Knit
The last 16 rows set the pattern.
(I have started you off with the
increases to help you incorporate
them into the pattern)
Keeping pattern correct,
continue increasing until you
have 56 sts ending on a wrong
side row.
Work a further 10 rows ending
with a Knit row in Mocha
Change to Gold and work 30
rows st st.

Dec 1 st at each end on the next and following 2 alternate rows.
Purl 1 row and cast off.

Ear tufts (Make 2 each in Cream, Mocha, Copper, Gold and Cream)

Using appropriate colour and 3.75m needles cast on 24 sts, Now cast off.

Feet (Make 2 Worked in garter stitch)

Using 3.75m needles and Copper cast on 20 sts
Knit 4 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of the next and following alt rows until 4sts remain, 4 rows knit, increase 1 st at each end of alt rows to 20 sts, k4 rows and cast off.

Eye mask (Worked in garter stitch)

Using 3.75mm needles and cream, cast on 10 sts
***Knit 2 rows,
Now inc 1 stitch at each end of next and foll alt rows until there are 22 sts
Work 8 rows straight
Dec 1 st at each end of next and foll alt rows until there are 10 sts,
*** work 4 rows on these stitches, work from *** to ***.
Cast off.

Beak

Using 3.75m needles and Copper cast on 3sts,
Knit 1 row
Next Row : inc in first and last st
Next Row : knit
Rep last 2 rows once more
Knit 2 rows
Now dec 1 stitch at each end of every alt row until 3sts
Next Row : k3tog, fasten off

Wings

Large wing (make 2)

Using 3.75m needles and stone cast on 4sts
Next Row : knit
Inc 1 st at each end of next and following alt rows to 20sts
Knit 8 rows straight
Dec 1 stitch at each end of next and following alt rows to 8 sts .
Cast off

Small Feathers make 2 each in Cream, Gold, Copper and Mocha

Using appropriate colour and 3.75m needles cast on 2sts
Next Row : knit
Next Row : inc in first st, knit 1
Next Row : Knit
Next Row : inc in each of next 2sts, k1
Next Row : knit
Next Row : inc in first and last st
Next Row : knit
Continue as last 2 rows to 11sts
Knit 2 rows
Dec 1 stitch at each of next and every following alt rows, to 3sts, cast off

Making up

Work in all ends on pieces. With right sides facing inside, join the back and front together, leave the base open for stuffing. Stuff quite firmly and shape as you do. Close base. Sew eye mask to front just above the patterning. Take the beak and sew in between the eyes, add a little stuffing to pad slightly. Sew the smaller feathers onto each large wing, over lapping slightly. Sew a wing to each side of the body. Sew the seams on the feet pieces, stuff lightly. Close seams. Take a needle and copper yarn and shape the toes on the feet by sewing through from back to front, pull tightly to draw in the foot, repeat twice more to form the owl's foot. Make the other foot the same way. Sew to base of body. Take the ear tufts and sew 4 different colours together on either corner of the top of the head. Using mocha embroider a sleep y eye on each side of the eye mask.



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
