

CY1127 SERIOUSLY CHUNKY METALLICS
TWISTED LATTICE SCARF

Size

Approx. 150 cm (59 ins) length x 18 cm (7 ins) width

Materials

Seriously Chunky Metallics

Cobalt 622 1 x 100g ball Large Tapestry Needle for sewing in ends

12mm Knitting needles

Lead 477 1 x 100g Ball Crochet hook for tassels

Abbreviations

k knit k2tog knit 2 together sl 1 slip 1 stitch yf yarn forward yb yarn back st stitch

With 12mm needles cast on 20 sts.

Row 1: knit

Row 2: k2, *sl 1, k1; rep from * to end

Row 3: *k1, yf, sl 1, yb; rep from *

to last 2 sts, k2

Row 4: k1, *yo, k2tog; rep from *

to last st, k1

Last 4 rows set pattern. Continue in pattern until scarf measures approx. 150cm, ending on Row 1 of pattern.

Cast off loosely.

FRINGE

Using **Lead** cut 40 strands approx. 35cm in length. Take two lengths and fold in half, creating a loop. Using a crochet hook, pull the loop part way through the corner stitch of the end of the scarf. From the front, insert the hook through the loop and pull the four strands through all the way through the loop. Pull tight. Work 10 tassels evenly across every

other stitch of each end of scarf. Trim so all tassels are same length.

Weave in loose ends.
