## Square pattern 1 (make 18)

**With Col E,** ch4 and join with slst to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** ch3, tr 11 into ring. Join to top of ch3 with slst.

Fasten off Col E. Join Col C.

Rnd 2: ch3, tr in same st, ch 1, \*tr 2 in next st, ch 1; rep from \* 10 more times and join to top of ch 3 with slst.

Fasten off Col C. Join Col B in chsp. Rnd 3: ch 3, tr 2 in same chsp, ch 1, \*3 tr in next chsp, ch 1; rep from \* 10 more times and join to top of ch 3 with slst.

Fasten off Col B. Join Col A in chsp.

Rnd 4: ch3, tr 2 in same chsp, ch 1, \*tr 3, ch 2, tr 3 in next chsp, tr 3, ch1 in next two chsp; rep around and join to top of ch3. Slst to next chsp.

Rnd 5: Work (3 tr, ch 1) in each 1 chsp and (3tr, ch 2, 3tr, ch 1) in each corner 2 chsp. Join to top of ch3 and fasten off.

## Square pattern 2 (make 18)

Work as for Square 1 but in the following order:

Col E

Col D

Col F

Col A

Using Linen, join squares in an alternating pattern using double crochet or whipstitch.

#### **BORDER**

Work around blanket using dc in each st, 1 dc in each chsp and (dc, htr, dc) in each corner space. Do one row in each shade in the following order:

Col F

Col E

Col D

Col C

Col E
