Materials

2 x 200g ball of Scrumpalicious Cherry Pink 4004

2 x 200g ball of Scrumpalicious Pebble Grey 2002

KEY

St/Sts Stitch/Stitches

K Knit

P Purl

SI Slip

K2tog Knit 2 stitches together

NOTE

Instructions are given for sizes XS (S, M, L, XL, XXL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL)

SCRUMPALICIOUS STRIPED CARDI

BODY:

Step 1: With 12mm needles and Cherry, cast on 61 (64, 70, 76, 82, 88, 94, 100, 106) sts. Work in 1x1 rib for 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5) rows.

Step 2: Change to 15mm needles and Pebble Grey and work in stocking st for 6 rows

Step 3: Change to Cherry and work in stocking st for 6 rows. Rep steps 2-3, 1 more time.

Rep step 2, 0 (0, 0, 0, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) more times.

Step 4: Change to opposite colour just worked, and work in stocking st for 4 (4, 4, 5, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5) rows.

You will now work the fronts and back separately.

RIGHT FRONT: worked across the first 16 (16, 16, 17, 17, 18, 18, 18, 19) sts only

Cont with colour used in step 4 of the body, and work in stocking st for 4 (4, 4, 5, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5) rows to complete this 6 row stripe.

Change to alternate colour and work in stocking st for 6 rows.

Change to alternate colour and work in stocking st for 6 rows.

Change to alternate colour and work in stocking st for 0 (0, 0, 1, 0, 0, 1, 1, 1) rows. Cast off all sts in colour that matches final stripe worked.

BACK: worked across the next 33 (35, 38, 41, 45, 48, 51, 54, 58) sts only

Rejoin yarn and rep as for right front.

LEFT FRONT: worked across the final 16 (16, 16, 17, 17, 18, 18, 18, 19) sts

Rejoin yarn and rep as for right front.

SLEEVES: make two

Step 1: Using 12mm needles and Cherry, cast on 14 (14, 16, 16, 18, 18, 20, 20) sts. Join your work in the rnd, taking care not to twist the cast on edge. Work in 1x1 rib for 3 (3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5) rnds.

Step 2: Using 15mm needles, inc evenly around to 24 (25, 26, 28, 29, 31, 34, 36, 38) sts.

Step 3: Change to Pebble Grey and work in stocking st for 6 rows.

Step 4: Change to Cherry and work in stocking st for 6 rows.

Sizes XS and S only:

Rep Step 3, one more time. Change to alternate colour and work in stocking st for 5 rnds. Cast off all sts.

Sizes M, L, XL, XXL, 4XL, 5XL only:

Rep steps 3-4, 1 more time. Change to alternate colour and work in stocking st for 0 (2, 3, 4, 5, 5, 6) more rnds. Cast off all sts.

ASSEMBLY AND NECKLINE:

Sew front and back together at shoulders.

Match centre point of sleeve with shoulder seam, and match a point directly opposite this to the line where the side seam would be. Sew in sleeve evenly, taking care not to pull too tightly.

Using 12mm needles and Cherry, pick up and knit 28 (28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35) sts up front of cardigan, 5 (5, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 9, 9) sts across back neckline and 28 (28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35) sts down front of cardigan. Work in 1x1 rib for 3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5) rows. Cast off loosely. Weave in all ends.
