4mm hook
1 button

Tension 16 treble stitches per $10 \mathrm{~cm} / 4 i n$ square, over 9 rows
IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING.
If your tension square has less stitches, use a smaller hook, if more, use a larger hook

## Abbreviations

Ch Chain Dc Double crochet (US single) Insert hook, yo, pull yarn through, yo, pull through both loops on hook Htr Half treble (US half double) Yo, insert hook, yo, pull through, pull through 3 loops on hook $\operatorname{Tr}$ Treble (US double) Yo, insert hook, yo, pull through, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook, yo, pull through remaining 2 loops Slst Slip stitch Insert hook, yo, pull through all loops on hook Yo Yarn over Wrap yarn around hook V st V stitch Work (htr, ch 1, htr) in next st Htr2tog Half treble 2 together Yo, insert hook, yo, pull through, yo, insert hook into next st, yo, pull through all loops on hook Trcl Treble cluster Work x amount of trebles, omitting the last stage of each tr leaving the last two loops on hook. When worked last tr, yo and pull through all remaining loops

When working yoke, change colour at beginning of each row in the following order: Blush; White; Peony Pink, Pearl Grey

With 4 mm hook and Blush ch 59.
Row 1: beginning in 3rd ch from hook, htr 7, v st, htr 11, v st, htr 16, v st, htr 11, v st, htr 8 ( 66 sts)
Row 2: ch 3 , htr 8 , v st, htr 4 , htr2tog, htr 1 , htr2tog, htr $4, v$ st, htr $18, v$ st, htr 4 , htr2tog, htr 1 , htr2 tog, htr $4, v$ st, htr 9 (70 sts)
Row 3: ch 3, htr 9, v st, htr $13, v$ st, htr 20, v st, htr $13, v$ st, htr 10 ( 78 sts)
Row 4: ch 3 , htr 10, v st, htr $15, \mathrm{v}$ st, htr 22, v st, htr $15, \mathrm{v}$ st, htr 11 ( 86 sts)
Row 5: ch 3, htr 11, v st, htr 5, htr2tog, htr 3, htr2tog, htr 5, v st, htr 24, v st, htr 5, htr2tog, htr 3, htr 5, v st, htr 12
(90 sts)
Row 6: ch 3 , htr 12 , v st, htr $17, \mathrm{v}$ st, htr 26 , v st, htr 17 , v st, htr 13 (98 sts)
Row 7: ch 3 , htr 13, v st, htr 19, v st, htr 28, v st, htr 19 , vst, htr 14 (106 sts)

Row 8: ch3, htr 14, v st, htr 6, htr2tog, htr 5, htr2tog, htr 6, vst, htr 30, htr 6, htr2tog, htr 5, htr2tog, htr 6, v st, htr 15 (110 sts)
Row 9: ch 3 , htr $15, \mathrm{v}$ st, htr $21, \mathrm{v}$ st, htr 32 , v st, htr $21, \mathrm{v}$ st, htr 16 (118 sts)

## 1 st size only

Next row: ch 3, htr 17, ch 8, skip 23, htr 36, ch 8, skip 23, htr 18
For all other sizes:
Row 10: ch 3, htr 16, v st, htr 23 , v st, htr 34 , v st, htr 23, v st, htr 17 (126 sts)

## 2nd size only:

Next row: ch 3 , htr 18 , ch 10 , skip 25 , htr 38 , ch 10 , skip 25 , htr 19

## 3 rd, 4th and 5th sizes only:

Row 11: ch 3 , htr 17 , v st, htr 25 , v st, htr 36 , v st, htr 25 , v st, htr 18 ( 134 sts) 3 rd size only:

Next row: ch 3, htr 19, ch 12, skip 27, htr 40, ch 12, skip 27, htr 20

## 4 th and 5th sizes only:

Row 12: ch 3 , htr 19, v st, htr 27 , v st, htr 38 , v st, htr 27 , v st, htr 19 ( 142 sts)
Next row: ch 3, htr 20, ch 14, skip 29, htr 42, ch 14, skip 29, htr 21

## For all sizes

With silver: Next Rows: ch3, turn tr in each st (88[96:104:112:112]sts)
Next row: ch 3, tr 17[18:19:20:20], place marker, tr 8[10:12:14:14], place marker, tr 36[38:40:42:42] place marker, tr 8[10:12:14:14], place marker, $\operatorname{tr}$ 18[19:20:21:21] Inc row: ch 3 , tr in each st to last st before marker, 2 tr in next st, slip marker, tr to next marker, slip marker, 2 tr in next st, tr in each st to last st before marker, 2 tr in next st, slip marker, tr in each st to next marker, slip marker, 2 tr in next st, tr in each st to end. (92[100:108:116:116]sts) Next row: ch 3 , tr in each st to end

Repeat last two rows until there are 96[112:112:128:140]sts Fasten off.

## Granny Square borders Make 7 [8:8:9:10]

With Candy Pink and 4 mm hook ch 5 and join with slst to form a ring
Rnd 1: ch 2, 3trcl, ch4, *4trcl, ch4; rep from * 4 more times and join to top of first cluster using slst. Fasten off. Join Silver Rnd 2: ch 3, tr in same st, * 4 tr in ch sp, 2 tr in next st; rep from * 4 more times, 4 tr in chsp, join to top of ch 3 with slst. Fasten off.

Join White Rnd 3: ch 1, dc in same st, *htr in next st, tr in next 2 sts, (dtr, ch 2, dtr) in next st, tr in next 2 sts, htr in next st, ${ }^{* *}$ dc in next 2 sts; repeat from ${ }^{*}$ twice then from ${ }^{*}$ to ${ }^{* *}$ once more. Join with slst and fasten off. Join Powder Blue Rnd 4: dc in each st, working 3 dc in each corner chsp. Join with slst. Fasten off.

Making up Block squares. With right sides together and using Powder Blue dc squares together along one side seam until there are 7 [8:8:9:10] in a row. With right sides together, pin top and squares together, easing in as necessary and dc in place. Using Candy pink, dc in each st around armholes and neckband, front borders and hem, working 3 sts in any corners and working a ch 6 loop at the top front left neck for button loop. Attach button. Block garment.
