## Measurements and Materials

Actual Measurement	92	98	102	cm
	36	38	40	in
Cygnnet Glittery DK 100g shade 117 Coal	3	3	4	balls

A pair of 3.25mm (US3) and 4 mm (US6) knitting needles.

3.25mm (US3) circular needle

2 metres 2cm wide Black Ribbon

## TENSION

22 sts and 27 rows to 10 cm, 4 ins measured over stst on 4 mm needles

If fewer stitches are obtained use a thicker needle, if more use a thinner needle

## ABBREVIATIONS

K Knit P Purl st(s) stitch(es) yf yarn forward stst stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 row P)  
skpo slip 1, k1, pass slipped st over tog together rept repeat cont continue rem remaining  
y2rn wrap yarn twice around needle yon yarn over needle

## BACK

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 102[108,114]sts and work 15cm in K2, P2 rib.

Change to 4 mm needles and cont in stst until Back measures 34 cm, mark each end of last row with a coloured thread. \*\*

Work a further 20[21,22]cm from marker, end with a P row.

### Shape Shoulders and neck

**Next row** K27[29,31], turn and work on these sts only.

**Next row** Cast off 8 sts, P to end.

**Next row** K to last 2 sts, K2tog.

Rept last 2 rows once more.

**Next row** P to end.

**Next row** Cast off 4[5,6] sts, K to last 2 sts, K2tog.

**Next row** P to end.

Cast off rem 4[5,6]sts.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 48[50,52]sts and K to end.

**Next row** P to last 2 sts, P2tog.

**Next row** Cast off 8 sts, K to end.

Rept last 2 rows once more.

**Next row** Cast off 4[5,6] sts, P to last 2 sts, P2tog.

**Next row** K to end.

Cast off rem 4[5,6]sts.

## FRONT

Work as given for Back to \*\*

Work a further 6 cm from marker, end with a P row.

### Shape Neck

**Next row** K39[41,43], turn and work on these sts only.

**Next row** Cast off 3 sts, P to end.

**Next row** K to end.

Rept last 2 rows twice more.

**Next row** Cast off 2 sts, P to end.

**Next row** K to end.

**Next row** Cast off 2 sts, P to end.

**Next row** K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

**Next row** P to end.

Rept last 2 rows until 8[10,12]sts rem.

Cont straight until Front measures same as Back to Shoulder, ending at armhole edge.

### Shape left shoulder and Neck

**Next row** Cast off 4[5,6]sts, K to end.

**Next row** Purl. Cast off rem 4[5,6] sts.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 24[26,28]sts and K to end.

**Next row** P to end.

**Next row** Cast off 3 sts, K to end.

Rept last 2 rows twice more.

**Next row** P to end.

**Next row** Cast off 2 sts, K to end.

Rept last 2 rows once more.

**Next row** P to end.

**Next row** K1, skpo, K to end.

Rept last 2 rows until 8[10,12] sts rem.

Cont straight until Front measures same as Back to Shoulder, ending at armhole edge.

### Shape Right Shoulder

**Next row** Cast off 4[5,6] sts, P to end.

**Next row** K to end. Cast off rem 4[5,6] sts.

## NECK EDGING

Join shoulder seams. Using a 3.25 mm circular needle and with rs facing, starting at left shoulder seam, pick up and K42[42,46] sts down left side of front neck, 24[24,28] sts from centre front, pick up and K42[42,46] up right side of front neck, 12[12,14] sts down right side of back neck, pick up and K48[48,50] sts at back neck and pick up and K12[12,14] sts up left side of back neck. 180[180,198]sts:

Now working in rounds from the right side, cont as follows:

**Next row** P to the end of the round to form a ridge. Knit 3 rounds.

**Next row** K3, \* y2rn, K2tog, K7, rept from \* to last 6 sts, y2rn, K2tog, K4.

**Next row** K3, \* drop first yrn, slip next yrn, yon, k2tog, K6, rept from \* to last 6 sts, drop the first yrn, slip next yrn, yon, k2tog, K3.

**Next row** K1, \* K2tog, slip next 2 yons, yon, K5, rept from \* to last rep, k2tog, slip next 2 yons, yon, K4.

**Next row** K2, \* (knit next yon] twice, place yon loops back on left hand needle \* then k all three yons tog (making 3 sts from the 3 yons) \* K6, rept from \* to \*ending last rep, K4.

Knit 3 rounds. Cast off purlwise.

### Finishing Off

Join side seams to markers. Thread ribbon through eyelet holes to tie at centre front.

Hem the ribbon ends to prevent fraying when washing



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
