



CYGNET COLOUR RUSH DK CROSS STITCH TODDLER PONCHO CY1664

Materials –

4.5 mm crochet hook

1 x 100g ball of Cygnet Colour rush DK in Watermelon 652

3 x 15mm wooden buttons

Pattern Notes –

UK terminology used

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1st stitch of the row unless otherwise stated.

Treble crochet x stitch – skip 1 stitch, treble crochet into next stitch, treble crochet into the skipped stitch, x stitch completed.

Increase – 2 treble crochet worked into the same stitch.

Abbreviations –

tr – treble crochet
htr – half treble
crochet

dc – double crochet
xst – cross stitch
inc - increase
chsp- chain space

t - turn your work
nxt – next
rept - repeat
sk - skip

sp(s) - space(s)
slst – slip stitch
fo – fasten off

2 – 3 years –

Ch 54

Row 1 – htr into 2nd ch from hook, htr into each ch across (53)

Row 2 – ch 1, * tr 2, inc into nxt, rept from * across (70)

Row 3 – ch 1, t, work xst across the row till the end (35)

Row 4 – ch 1, t, * tr 2, inc into nxt, rept from * till 2 sts left, tr 2 (92)

Row 5 – rept row 3 (46)

Row 6 – ch 1, t, * tr 2, inc into nxt, rept from * across (122)

Row 7 – rept row 3 (61)

Row 8 – ch 1, t, tr across (122)

Row 9 – rept row 3 (61)

Rept rows 8 and 9 - 7 more times

Rept row 8 - 1 more time

Row 25 – ch 1, t, htr across, fo

Button band – Attach yarn at the bottom left side

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to top working 2 dc into the side of every tr

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc to bottom

Row 3 – ch 1, t, dc to top, fo

Buttonhole band – Attach yarn at the bottom right side

Row 1 – ch 1, dc evenly to top working 2 dc into the side of every tr

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc 2, [ch 1, sk 1, dc 5] 3 times, dc to end

Row 3 – ch 1, t, dc into each dc and chsp

Fasten off, weave in all ends and sew on buttons.

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
