





CY1681 CYGNET SILCARESS DK LADIES GRANNY STRIPE SWEATER

Materials and Measurements

4 and 4.5 mm crochet hooks

Pattern notes -

Yarn A – 3 x balls pearl grey 2672

Yarn B – 2 x balls raspberry 2278

Yarn C – 2 x balls sherbert 2723

UK terminology used

UK size 8 to 10

Neck 52 cm, chest 80 cm, length 58 cm.

Abbreviations explained -

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch

Cluster – work 3 treble crochet into the same stitch or space.

V stitch – work 1 treble crochet + chain 1 + 1 treble crochet into the same stitch or space.

bphtr – back post half treble **Abbreviations** vst – v stitch crochet dc – double crochet t – turn your work ch(s) - chain(s) tr - treble crochet fo – fasten off yarn sk - skip htr – half treble crochet nxt – next st(s) - stitch(s) fphtr – front post half treble bet – between crochet tur - turning sp(s) - space(s) cl(s) - cluster(s)

Ribbed neck trim -

With yarn A and 4mm hook, ch 90 and slst to join into a ring

(90)

Row 1 – ch 1, htr into each ch around, slst to 1st st

Row 2 - ch 1, fphtr into 1st, * bphtr into nxt, fphtr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st st

Rows 3 + 4 - ch 1, fphtr into fphtr, bphtr into bphtr, rept around, slst to 1st st

Row 5 – ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to 1st st, fo A (90)

Increase rows -

Attach yarn B and change to 4.5mm hook

Row 1 – ch 1, cl into 1st st, [sk 2, cl into nxt] twice, sk 2, vst into nxt, [sk 2, cl into nxt] x 6, sk 2, vst into nxt, [sk 2, cl into nxt] x 7, sk 2, vst into nxt, [sk 2, cl into nxt] x 6, sk 2, vst into nxt, [sk 2, cl into nxt] x 4, slst to 1st st. fo B

From now we will be working the cluster stitches in the spaces between the clusters and the v stitches into the chain 1 space of the v stitches on the row before.

Row 2 – attach C into any space on the back, ch 1, * work a cl into each sp till you reach the vst, vst into the chain 1 sp, rept from * all the way around, slst to 1st st, fo C

Row 3 – attach A and rept row 2

Row 4 – attach B and rept row 2

Row 5 – attach C and rept row 2

Continue the increase rows till you have worked a total of 12 rows, changing colour after each row.

Separating for sleeves -

Attach colour B into any space on the back, ch 1, * work a cl into each sp till you reach the vst, vst into the chain 1 sp, sk to the nxt vst, and vst into that, rept from * around, slst to 1st st, fo B

Body -

Row 1 – Attach colour C into any space on the back, ch 1, * work a cl into each sp all the way around, slst to 1st st.

Row 2 – with A rept row 1

Row 3 - with B rept row 1

Continue these cluster rows till you have worked a total of 32 rows, changing colour after each row.

Ribbed waist trim -

Row 1 – Attach A into any sp on the back, ch 1, htr into each st around, slst to 1st st

Row 2 - ch 1, fphtr into 1st, * bphtr into nxt, fphtr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st st

Rows 3 to 8 – ch 1, fphtr into fphtr, bphtr into bphtr, rept around, slst to 1st st

Sleeves -

Row 1 – on the underarm attach B into the sp left of the vst, ch 1, cl into the nxt 18 sps, slst to 1st st, fo B

Row 2 – attach C, ch 1, cl into each of the nxt 18 sps, slst to 1st st

Row 3 - with A rept row 1

Row 4 - with B rept row 1

Continue these cluster rows till you have worked a total of 32 rows, changing colour after each row.

Ribbed sleeve trim -

Row 1 – Attach A into any sp on the sleeve, ch 1, htr into each st around, slst to 1st st

Row 2 - ch 1, fphtr into 1st, * bphtr into nxt, fphtr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st st

Rows 3 and 4 - ch 1, fphtr into fphtr, bphtr into bphtr, rept around, slst to 1st st

Fasten off and weave in all ends.
