



## CY1691 Patterned Sweater Baby Soft DK

### Measurements and Materials

To Fit Chest 46 51 56 61 cm

18 20 22 24 in

1 2 2 2 balls

Cygnets Baby Soft DK 100g balls Whirly Pop 553

A pair of 3mm and 3.75mm needles (US 3 and 5). Stitch holders.

4 Buttons

## TENSION

24 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm, 4 ins measured over pattern on 3.75 mm needles  
If fewer stitches are obtained use a thicker needle, if more use a thinner needle

## ABBREVIATIONS

K Knit P Purl st(s) stitch(es) rept repeat cont continue patt pattern beg beginning dec decrease  
alt alternate rem remaining rs right side ws wrong side foll following

## BACK

\*\* Using 3 mm needles cast on 61[67,73,79] sts and work 4cm in K1, P1 rib.

Change to 3.75 mm needles and commence pattern.

1<sup>st</sup> row (rs) P1, \* K5, P1, rept from \* to end.

2<sup>nd</sup> row P1, \* K1, P3, K1, P1, rept from \* to end.

3<sup>rd</sup> row \* K2, P1, K1, P1, K1, rept from \* to last st, K1.

4<sup>th</sup> row \* P3, k1, P2, rept from \* to last st, P1.

These 4 rows form the pattern.

Cont in patt until back measures 17[18,21,23.5] cm from beg ending with a 4<sup>th</sup> patt row.

**Shape Armholes** (keeping patt correct)

Cast off 3[3,4,4] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 55[61,65,71] sts

Dec one st at each end of next and every alt row until 47[51,53,57] sts rem. \*\*

Cont in patt until armholes measure 9[10,11.5,12.5] cm ending on a rs row.

Change to 3 mm needles and work 6 rows in K1, P1 rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

## FRONT

Work from \*\* to \*\* on Back.

Cont in patt until armhole measures 5[5.5,7,7.5] cm ending with a ws row.

**Shape Neck**

Next row Patt 19[21,21,23] sts, turn and work on these sts only.

Dec one st at neck edge in every row until 13[14,14,16] sts rem. Work without further shaping until armholes measure 9[10,11.5,12.5] cm ending with a ws row. Leave sts on a holder.

With rs facing, slip 9[9,11,11] sts to a holder and rejoin yarn to rem 19[21,21,23] sts.

Next row Patt to end.

Complete to match first side.

## FRONT NECKBAND

Using 3 mm needles and with rs facing, k across 13[14,14,16] sts on first shoulder, pick up and K11[13,13,15] sts down front neck, k across sts on holder at centre front, pick up and K11[13,13,15] sts up front neck and k across 13[14, 14,16] sts on second shoulder. 57[63,65,73,sts.

Work 3 rows in rib.

4<sup>th</sup> row (make buttonholes) rib 5, yarn forward, k2tog, rib 3[3,3,5] yarn forward, k2 tog, rib to last 12[12,12,14] sts, k2tog, yarn forward, rib 3[3,3,5] k2tog, yarn forward, rib 5.

Work 2 more rows in rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

## **SLEEVES (Both alike)**

Using 3 mm needles cast on 31[33,35,35] sts and work 4 cm in rib.

Next row (inc row) rib2[4,3,10] \* inc in next st, rib4[7,3,14] rept from \* to last 4[5,4,10]sts, inc in next st, rib to end. 37[37,43,37] sts.

Change to 3.75 mm needles and work 4[4,8,4] rows in patt as given for Back.

### **Sizes 46, 51 and 61 cm only**

Keeping patt correct, inc one st at each end of next and every foll 4<sup>th</sup> row to 43[41,53] sts then each end of every foll 8<sup>th</sup> row to 49[49,61] sts.

### **Size 56 cm only**

Keeping patt correct, inc one st at each end of next and every foll 9<sup>th</sup> row to 55 sts

### **All Sizes**

Cont without further shaping until sleeve measures 16[19,23, 27] cm from beg ending with a 4<sup>th</sup> patt row.

### **Shape Top**

Keeping patt correct

Cast off 3[3,4,4] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 43[43,47,53] sts

Dec one st at each end of next and every alt row to 39[35,39,43] sts then each end of every row to 17 sts.

Cast off loosely.

## **FINISHING OFF**

Join side and sleeve seams. Place front neckband over back neckband and join at the armhole edge.

Insert sleeves. Sew on buttons to shoulders.
