



## Seriously Chunky Meadow Green Bag

### Materials

2 x 100g balls of Seriously Chunky model worked in 3877 Meadow Green

Pair of 8mm needles

2 bag handles

### Instructions

*Bag Front and Back* (knit two the same)

Cast on 25 stitches on 8mm needles

Row 1: k4, \*p1, K7; repeat from \* to last 5 stitches, p1, K4

Row 2: P3, \*k1, p1, k1, p5; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, k1, p1, k1, p3

Row 3: K2, \*p1, k3; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, p1, K2

Row 4: p1, \*k1, p5, k1, p1; repeat from \* to end

Row 5: \*p1, k7; repeat from 8 to last stitch; p1

Row 6: p1, \*k1, p5, k1, p1; repeat from \* to end

Row 7: K2, \*p1, k3; repeat from \* to last 3 stitches, p1, K2

Row 8: P3, \*k1, p1, k1, p5; repeat from \* to last 6 stitches, k1, p1, k1, p3

Repeat these 8 rows, 3 times

Continue in stocking stitch (k1 row p1 row) for approx. 3cms depending on bag handle used.

### Make Up

Seam bottom seam and side seams leaving approx. 3cms open at top of each side seam. Thread stocking stitch section through the bag handle and neatly stitch down to form a casing.

**Abbreviations:** K – Knit                      P – Purl
