


# **Bee Kind Quilt**

# **DESIGN 1 (Main Diagram)**

# **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Bee Kind Collection)**

Fabric 1: 11/8yd - 110cm - A281.1 (Allium & poppies on light sage)

Fabric 2: 1/2yd - 1/2mtr - A282.2 (Peach honeycomb)

Fabric 3: ½yd - ½mtr - A283.1 (Bee hexagons natural)

Fabric 4: %yd - 80cm - A284.1 (Lavender on white)

Fabric 5: %yd - 80cm - A285.2 (Bees on sage)

Fabric 6: 7/8yd - 80cm - BB130 (Candyfloss)

Fabric 7: 5/8yd - 60cm - BB141 (Khaki green)

Wadding and backing 61" x 73"

### **CUTTING**

**1.** From fabric 1 cut:

2 x 4" x 621/2" (sides)

2 x 4" x 571/2" (top and bottom)

2. From fabric 2 cut:

40 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once

**3.** From fabric 3 cut:

20 x 71/4" x 71/4" cut in half diagonally twice

**4.** From fabric 4 cut:

20 x 71/4" x 71/4" cut in half diagonally twice

**5.** From fabric 5 cut:

80 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once

6. From fabric 6 cut:

40 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once

**7.** From fabric 7 cut:

2 x 11/2" x 601/2" (sides)

2 x 11/2" x 501/2" (top and bottom)

## **MAKING UP THE BLOCK**



**Block diagram** 

The block is made up of flying geese, eight for each block




Sew the small triangles to each side of the large triangle. Stitch two together to make a square


Next sew the squares in rows and then sew them together to make the block

Sew 20 in total

## **MAKING UP THE QUILT CENTRE**



Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch the top row together, pressing the seams to the right. On the next row press the seams to the left. Keep doing this to each row, it will help when you are sewing the rows together



### **BORDERS**

Stitch the inner strips to the sides and then the top and bottom

Next sew the outer borders, sides and then the top and bottom

### **COMPLETION**

### Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size

### **Binding**

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt

# **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Bee Kind Collection)**

Fabric 1: 11/8yd - 110cm - A281.3 (Allium & poppies on warm grey)

Fabric 2: ½yd - ½mtr - A282.1 (Blue honeycomb)

Fabric 3: 1/2yd - 1/2mtr - A283.3 (Bee hexagons pink)

Fabric 4: %yd - 80cm - A284.3 (Lavender on sage)

Fabric 5: %yd - 80cm - A285.3 (Bees on lavender)

Fabric 6: 7/8yd - 80cm - BB137 (Blackberry juice)

Fabric 7: 5/8yd - 60cm - BB135 (Purple berry)

Wadding and backing 61" x 73"

### **CUTTING**

**1.** From fabric 1 cut:

2 x 4" x 621/2" (sides)

2 x 4" x 571/2" (top and bottom)

2. From fabric 2 cut:

 $40 \times 3\%$ " x 3%" cut in half diagonally once

**3.** From fabric 3 cut:

20 x 71/4" x 71/4" cut in half diagonally twice

**4.** From fabric 4 cut:

20 x 71/4" x 71/4" cut in half diagonally twice

**5.** From fabric 5 cut:

80 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once

6. From fabric 6 cut:


40 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once

**7.** From fabric 7 cut:

2 x 11/2" x 601/2" (sides)

2 x 1½" x 50½" (top and bottom)

## **MAKING UP THE BLOCK**



**Block diagram** 


The block is made up of flying geese, eight for each block

Next sew the squares in rows and then sew them together to make the block

# MAKING UP THE QUILT CENTRE



Fabric 3: 1/2yd - 1/2mtr - A283.2 (Bee hexagons green)
Fabric 4: 1/8yd - 80cm - A284.2 (Lavender on pink)
Fabric 5: 1/8yd - 80cm - A285.1 (Bees on grey)
Fabric 6: 1/8yd - 80cm - BB133 (Lavender)
Fabric 7: 1/8yd - 60cm - BB135 (Purple berry)

Wadding and backing 61" x 73"

#### **CUTTING**

**1.** From fabric 1 cut:

2 x 4" x 621/2" (sides)

2 x 4" x 571/2" (top and bottom)

2. From fabric 2 cut:

40 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once

**3.** From fabric 3 cut:

20 x 71/4" x 71/4" cut in half diagonally twice

**4.** From fabric 4 cut:

20 x 71/4" x 71/4" cut in half diagonally twice

**5.** From fabric 5 cut:

80 x 3%" x 3%" cut in half diagonally once

6. From fabric 6 cut:



2 x 11/2" x 601/2" (sides)

2 x 11/2" x 501/2" (top and bottom)




