

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Dino Glow collection.
From fabrics 1 to 10 you need a long $1 / 4$ of each.

1. A671.1 - Volcano \& Dinos on natural with glow in the dark
2. A672.2 - Glow in the dark Dino blender on heather
3. A673.3 - Ammonites on dark grey with glow in the dark
4. A674.1-Glow in the dark Dino skeletons on light grey
5. A675.2 - Glow in the dark dinosaurs on slate
6. A671.3 - Volcano \& Dinos on soft indigo with glow in the dark
7. A672.1-Glow in the dark Dino blender on olive
8. A673.1 - Ammonites on grey with glow in the dark
9. A674.3-Glow in the dark Dino
skeletons on warm indigo
10. A675.1 - Glow in the dark Dinosaurs on warm grey
11. BB318 - Heather - 5/8yd
12. BB328-Glow in the dark on cream 5/8yd
13. BB325-Dark blue - 3/4yd

Wadding and backing 56 " x 68 "
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.
you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ W x $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ H (block 1)
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Hx} 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$
From fabric 2 cut
$8 \times 41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ (block 1 )
From fabric 3 cut
$8 \times 41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ (block 1 )
From fabric 4 cut
$8 \times 41 / 2 " \times 8^{1 / 2}$ " (block 1 )
From fabric 5 cut
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$ (block 1)
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \mathrm{x} 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$
From fabric 6 cut
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ W x 61⁄2" H (block 2)
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Hx} 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$


Three of the rows

From fabric 7 cut
$8 \times 4^{1 ⁄ 2 \prime} \times 61 / 2 "$ (block 2)
From fabric 7 cut
$8 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)
From fabric 8 cut
$8 \times 4^{1 / 2 "} \times 6^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}($ block 2$)$
From fabric 9 cut
$8 \times 4112$ " x $61 / 2 "$ (block 2)
From fabric 10 cut
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$ (block 2)
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \mathrm{x} 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$
From fabric 11 cut
$80 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 6{ }^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
From fabric 12 cut
$80 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} \times{ }^{1} \times 1 / 2 "$
From fabric 13 cut
$6 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF

## Making up the blocks.

All the blocks are made up in the same way. Lay out the fabric pieces as in the block
diagram. On block 1 you will use fabric 11 to stitch each side of your $41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strip. You will sew 40 of block 1 in total. On block 2 you will use fabric 12 and sew as before and again you will sew 40 blocks in total.

## Making up the quilt

Place the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows, press the seams in the opposite way each time. This helps when stitching the rows together.

## Border

For the border you need to join your fabric strips.
Side strips - $2 \times 2^{1 / 2 "} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sew to the quilt center, press back.
Top \& bottom strips $-2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ stitch to
the top \& bottom of the quilt.

## Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Wadding and backing $56^{\prime \prime} \times 68^{\prime \prime}$
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
$4 \times 41 / 2$ " W x $61 / 2{ }^{1}$ " H (block 1 )
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$
From fabric 2 cut
$8 \times 41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ (block 1 )
From fabric 3 cut
$8 \times 41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ (block 1 )
From fabric 4 cut
$8 \times 41 / 2 " \times 8^{1 / 2}$ " (block 1 )
From fabric 5 cut
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 61 / 2^{1} \mathrm{H}$ (block 1)
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \mathrm{x} 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$
From fabric 6 cut
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ W x 61⁄2" H (block 2)
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Hx} 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$

From fabric 7 cut
$8 \times 4^{1 ⁄ 2 \prime} \times 61 / 2 "$ (block 2)
From fabric 7 cut
$8 \times 41 / 2$ " x $61 / 2$ " (block 2)
From fabric 8 cut
$8 \times 4^{112} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 "$ (block 2)
From fabric 9 cut
$8 \times 41 / 2$ " x $61 / 2 "$ (block 2)
From fabric 10 cut
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ W x 61⁄2" H (block 2)
$4 \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \mathrm{x} 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$
From fabric 11 cut
$80 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2 \times 61 / 2 "$
From fabric 12 cut
$80 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} \times{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
From fabric 13 cut
$6 \times 21 / 2 " \times$ WOF

## Making up the blocks.

All the blocks are made up in the same way. Lay out the fabric pieces as in the block diagram. On block 1 you will use fabric 11 to stitch each side of your $41 / 2$ " $\times 6{ }^{1 / 2}$ " strip. You will sew 40 of block 1 in total. On block 2 you will use fabric 12 and sew as before and again you will sew 40 blocks in total.

## Making up the quilt

Place the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows, press the seams in the opposite way each time. This helps when stitching the rows together.
3 of the rows

## Border

For the border you need to join your fabric strips.
Side strips - $2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sew to the quilt center, press back.
Top \& bottom strips $-2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ stitch to the top \& bottom of the quilt.

## Quilting

E. Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

## Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 13 to
bind the quilt.
