4. A366.3 - Old Harry Rocks white on blue - fat $1 / 4$
5. A367.1-Purbeck flowers on cream $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
6. A367.3-Purbeck flowers on dark blue $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
7. A368.2-Swanage Seagulls on sunset rose - fat $1 / 4$
8. A368.3-Swanage Seagulls on sunny sky - fat $1 / 4$
9. A369.1-Gentle waves on light aqua - fat $1 / 4$
10. A369.2-Gentle waves on lilac - fat $1 / 4$
11. BB174 - Bumbleberries Turquoise $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$

Wadding and backing 52" x 52"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## From fabric 2 cut

$4 \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 3 cut

$20 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (block 1)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)

## From fabric 4 cut

$16 \times 17 / 8^{" 1} \times 57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (block 3)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)

## From fabric 5 cut

$4 \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3118^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)
$48 \times 1 / 1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (blocks $2 \& 3$ )
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)

## From fabric 6 cut

$9 \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (blocks $1 \& 3$ )
$56 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (blocks1 \& 3)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)
$2 \times 2^{1 ⁄ 2 " 1} \times 2^{1 ⁄ 212 "}$ (corner of middle border)

## From fabric 7 cut

$16 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime}($ block 3$)$
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ (middle border)
$2 \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (corner of middle border)

## From fabric 8 cut

$16 \times 17 / 8 " \times 31 / 8 "$ (block 2)
$4 \times 2112 " \times 5 ½ "$ (middle border)

## From fabric 9 cut

$20 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (block 1)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ (middle border)

## From fabric 10 cut

$16 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)
$4 \times 21 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ (border)

## From fabric 11 cut

$2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (inner border, sides)
$2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 42^{112 "}$ (inner border, top \& bottom)
$8 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{11 / 2 "}$ (next to corners of middle border)
$2 \times 11 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 461 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (outer border, sides)
$2 \times 11 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ (outer border, top \& bottom)

## Making up the blocks

All three blocks are made up in the same way.


Block 1


Block 2


Block 3

Lay out the fabric pieces for each block as in the main diagram. Take the centre square of block and stitch the short strips to the sides. Next sew the squares to each end of the short strips. Stitch to square. Do the same to the outer part of block.
Block 1 you need 5 blocks in total, block 2 you need 4 in total and block 3 sew 2 of each block way.
Stitch the centre part of the quilt together.


## Inner border

Sew the strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to the sides and then strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 42^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to the top and bottom.

## Middle border

Stitch the middle border strips together as in the main diagram. Sewing the small strips of fabric 11 to each end. On two of the strips you will sew a square each end of the strips. Stitch the short ones to the quilt and then the last two strips.

## Outer border

Stitch the shorter strips to the sides and then the top and bottom strips.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 11 to bind the quilt.

Wadding and backing 52" x 52"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## From fabric 2 cut

$4 \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 3 cut

$16 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 57 / 8^{\prime \prime}($ block 3$)$
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)

## From fabric 4 cut

$20 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (block 1)
$4 \times 21 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ (middle border)

## From fabric 5 cut

$9 \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (blocks $1 \& 2$ )
$56 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (blocks $1 \& 3$ )
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)
$2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (border)

## From fabric 6 cut

$4 \times 31 / 8{ }^{1 / x} \times 1 \frac{1}{8 "}$ (block 2)
$48 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2 \& 3)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ (middle border)
$2 \times 21 / 2 " \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (border)

## From fabric 7 cut

$16 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (block 3)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)
$2 \times 21 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ (border)

## From fabric 8 cut

$16 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)

## From fabric 9 cut

$16 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 57 / 8^{" 1}$ (block 2)
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)

## From fabric 10 cut

$20 \times 17 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 8^{\prime \prime}($ block 1 )
$4 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)

## From fabric 11 cut

$2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (inner border, sides)
$2 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{112 "}$ (inner border, top \& bottom)
$8 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (middle border)
$2 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 461 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (outer border, sides)
$2 \times 11 / 2 " \times 481 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (outer border, top \& bottom)

## Making up the blocks

All three blocks are made up in the same way.


Block 1


Block 2


Block 3

Lay out the fabric pieces for each block as in the main diagram. Take the centre square of block and stitch the short strips to the sides. Next sew the squares to each end of the short strips. Stitch to square. Do the same to the outer part of block.
Block 1 you need 5 blocks in total, block 2 you need 4 in total and block 3 sew 2 of each block way.
Stitch the centre part of the quilt together.

## Inner border

Sew the strips $11 / 2$ " $\times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to the sides and then strips $11 / 2$ " $\times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to the top and bottom.

## Middle border

Stitch the middle border strips together as in the main diagram. Sewing the small strips of fabric 11 to each end. On two of the strips you will sew a square each end of the strips. Stitch the short ones to the quilt and then the last two strips.

## Outer border

Stitch the shorter strips to the sides and then the top and bottom strips.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 11 to bind the quilt.
