Size: 54" x 54"

Block: 4½" x 4½"



Main Diagram

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Geometrix Collection)

- Fabric 1: ½yd - ½mtr - BB20 (Black)
- Fabric 2: ⅝ - 60cm - GX3.4 (Hot pink wave)
- Fabric 3: ½yd - ½mtr - GX1.1 (Black & white circles)
- Fabric 4: ½yd - ½mtr - GX4.1 (Black & white half hex)
- Fabric 5: ½yd - ½mtr - GX2.1 (Black & white tiny triangles)
- Fabric 6: ½yd - ½mtr - GX5.3 (Multi hexagon on black)
- Fabric 7: ½yd - ½mtr - GX1.2 (Cream circles)
- Fabric 8: ½yd - ½mtr - GX3.1 (Black & white wave)
- Fabric 9: ½yd - ½mtr - GX5.1 (Multi hexagon on white)
- Fabric 10: ½yd - ½mtr - GX3.5 (Black & grey wave)

Wadding and backing 58" x 58"

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

CUTTING

1. From fabric 1 cut:

2 x 2½" x 54½" (you will need to join your fabric strips to get the length) top & bottom

2 x 2½" x 50½" (you will need to join your fabric strips to get the length) sides

2. From fabric 2 cut:

2 x 1½" x 50½" (you will need to join your fabric strips to get the length) top & bottom

2 x 1½" x 48½" (you will need to join your fabric strips to get the length) sides

3. From each of the fabrics 3, 4, 9 and 10 cut:

18 x 4⅞" x 4⅞" cut in half diagonally once from top left to bottom right

4. From each of the fabrics 5, 6, 7 and 8 cut:

18 x 4⅞" x 4⅞" cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right

MAKING UP THE BLOCKS



Lay out the fabric pieces for each of the blocks. Sew the triangles together to make a square. Do this to all your triangles

You will have 36 blocks from each of the colour sets

COMPLETE THE QUILT TOP

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram and stitch the rows together

Press the seams for each row in opposite directions to make the finish of the completed quilt top neater

Stitch the rows together to complete the quilt top

QUILTING

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together

Quilt by hand or machine as desired

Trim backing and wadding to size

BINDING

Use your favourite method from fabric 2 to bind the quilt
