



# **Haunted House Quilt 1**

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt 44" x 56" - unfinished block size  $12^{1/2}$ " x  $12^{1/2}$ "

### Requirements

Fabrics from the Haunted House collection

- 1. A602.2 Glow in the dark spiders on green 5/8yd 70cm
- 2. A601.2 Glow in the dark pumpkin faces on purple 5%yd 70cm
- 3. A600.3 Glow in the dark stars on black  $\frac{1}{4}$ yd  $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
- 4. A603.1 Hats, cats & bats on spooky
- blue 1/4yd 1/4mtr 5. A599.2 - Orange glow in the dark haunted
- house  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd  $\frac{1}{2}$ mtr
- 6. BB94 Light grey 1/4yd 1/4mtr
- 7. BB302 Neptune blue 1yd 1mtr

Wadding and backing 48" x 60"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.



#### Block 1

Lay out your fabric pieces for block 1. Sew the side strips of fabric 3 to the centre square. Next stitch the top and bottom strips to the centre square.

Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric 1 & 2 stitch a 1/4" seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a 21/2" x 21/2" square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block.

Stitch 6 of block 1 in total.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

 $12 \times 2^{1/2}$ " x  $10^{1/2}$ " left side strips of blocks

12 x 2½" x 8½" top strip of blocks

12 x 3" x 3" corner squares

From fabric 2 cut

12 x 2½" x 10½" right side strips of blocks

 $12 \times 2^{1/2}$ " x  $8^{1/2}$ " bottom strips of blocks

12 x 3" x 3" corner squares

From fabric 3 cut

12 x 11/2" x 81/2" sides (block 1)

12 x 1½" x 6½" top and bottom (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

6 x 6½" x 6½" (block 1)

From fabric 5 cut

6 x 8½" x 8½" (block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

5 x 11/2" x 42" inner border strips

From fabric 7 cut

5 x 31/2" x 42" outer border



#### Block 2

Lay out the fabric pieces for block 2

Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric 1 & 2 stitch a 1/4" seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a 21/2" x 21/2" square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block.

Stitch 6 of block 2 in total.

## Making up the quilt

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram.

Sew in rows, pressing the seam in the opposites. This will help when sewing the rows together.

#### Inner border

Join your strip together to get the length. Sides 2 x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ " and top and bottom 2 x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $38\frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew the sides and then the top and bottom to the quilt.

#### Outer border

Stitch the strip for outer border. 2 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $50\frac{1}{2}$ " sides and the top and bottom 2 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44\frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew the sides to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. You can quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to the size of quilt.

# **Binding**

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.

# **Haunted House Quilt 2**

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt 44" x 56" - unfinished block size  $12^{1/2}$ " x  $12^{1/2}$ "

### Requirements

Fabrics from the Haunted House collection

- A602.3 Glow in the dark spiders on 1. black - 5/8vd - 70cm
- A601.1 Glow in the dark pumpkin faces on orange - 5/8yd - 70cm
- A600.1 Glow in the dark stars on 3. spooky blue –  $\frac{1}{4}$ yd –  $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
- 4. A603.3 - Hats, cats & bats on black - 1/4yd - 1/4mtr
- A599.1 Green glow in the dark haunted house - 1/2 vd - 1/2 mtr
- BB20 Black 1/4yd 1/4mtr 6.
- 7. BB295 - Bright green - 1yd - 1mtr

60" Wadding and backing

All measurements include alseam lowances; press each seam as you go.



#### Block 1

Lay out your fabric pieces for block 1. Sew the side strips of fabric 3 to the centre square. Next stitch the top and bottom strips to the centre square.

Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric 1 & 2 stitch a 1/4" seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a 2½" x 2½" square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block.

Stitch 6 of block 1 in total.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

 $12 \times 2^{1/2}$ " x  $10^{1/2}$ " left side strips of blocks

12 x 21/2" x 81/2" top strip of blocks

12 x 3" x 3" corner squares

From fabric 2 cut

 $12 \times 2^{1/2}$ " x  $10^{1/2}$ " right side strips of blocks

12 x 2½" x 8½" bottom strips of blocks

12 x 3" x 3" corner squares

From fabric 3 cut

12 x 1½" x 8½" sides (block 1)

 $12 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " top and bottom (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

6 x 6½" x 6½" (block 1)

From fabric 5 cut

6 x 8½" x 8½" (block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

5 x 1½" x 42" inner border strips

From fabric 7 cut

5 x 31/2" x 42" outer border



## Block 2

Lay out the fabric pieces for block 2 Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric 1 & 2 stitch a 1/4" seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a 21/2" x 21/2" square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block. Stitch 6 of block 2 in total.

## Making up the quilt

#### Outer border

Stitch the strip for outer border. 2 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $50\frac{1}{2}$ " sides and the top and bottom 2 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44\frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew the sides to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. You can quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to the size of quilt.

# **Binding**

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.

#### Fabrics from the Haunted House collection

- A602.1 Glow in the dark spiders on grey
   -5/8yd 70cm
- 2. A601.3 Glow in the dark pumpkin faces on black 5/8yd 70cm
- 3. A600.2 Glow in the dark stars on orange  $-\frac{1}{4}$ yd  $-\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
- 4. A603.2 Hats, cats & bats on green 1/4yd 1/4mtr
- 5. A599.3 Spooky blue glow in the dark haunted house  $\frac{1}{2}$ yd .  $\frac{1}{2}$ mtr
- 6. BB302 Neptune blue 1/4yd 1/4mtr
- 7. BB110 Rock 1yd 1mtr

Wadding and backing 48" x 60"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.



#### Block 1

Lay out your fabric pieces for block 1. Sew the side strips of fabric 3 to the centre square. Next stitch the top and bottom strips to the centre square.

Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric 1 & 2 stitch a 1/4" seam each side of the diagonally line.  $12 \times 2^{1/2}$ " x  $10^{1/2}$ " right side strips of blocks

12 x 2½" x 8½" bottom strips of blocks

12 x 3" x 3" corner squares

From fabric 3 cut

12 x 1½" x 8½" sides (block 1)

 $12 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " top and bottom (block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

6 x 6½" x 6½" (block 1)

From fabric 5 cut

6 x 8½" x 8½" (block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

5 x 1½" x 42" inner border strips

From fabric 7 cut

5 x 31/2" x 42" outer border



#### Block 2
