

## Haunted House Quilt 1

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt $44^{\prime \prime} \times 56^{\prime \prime}$ - unfinished block size

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Haunted House collection

1. A602.2-Glow in the dark spiders on green - $5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
2. A601.2-Glow in the dark pumpkin faces on purple $-5 / 8 y d-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
3. A600.3-Glow in the dark stars on black $1 / 4 y d-1 / 4 m t r$
4. A603.1-Hats, cats \& bats on spooky blue - $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-1 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
5. A599.2- Orange glow in the dark haunted house - $1 / 2 y d-1 / 2 m t r$
6. BB94-Light grey - $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-1 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
7. BB302-Neptune blue - 1yd - 1 mtr

Wadding and backing $48^{\prime \prime} \times 60$ "

All measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances; press each seam as you go.


## Block 1

Lay out your fabric pieces for block 1. Sew the side strips of fabric 3 to the centre square. Next stitch the top and bottom strips to the centre square.
Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric $1 \& 2$ stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block. Stitch 6 of block 1 in total.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ left side strips of blocks
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81^{1 / 2 "}$ top strip of blocks
$12 \times 3$ " $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ corner squares
From fabric 2 cut
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ right side strips of blocks
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ bottom strips of blocks
$12 \times 3$ " $\times 3$ " corner squares
From fabric 3 cut
$12 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides (block 1 )
$12 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom (block 1)
From fabric 4 cut
$6 \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (block 1)
From fabric 5 cut
$6 \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)
From fabric 6 cut
$5 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ inner border strips
From fabric 7 cut
$5 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ outer border


Block 2
Lay out the fabric pieces for block 2
Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric $1 \& 2$ stitch a $1 / 4$ " seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block.
Stitch 6 of block 2 in total.

## Making up the quilt

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram.
Sew in rows, pressing the seam in the opposites. This will help when sewing the rows together.

## Inner border

Join your strip together to get the length. Sides $2 \times 1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 48^{1 / 2 "}$ " and top and bottom $2 \times 1 \frac{112 "}{}$ x $381 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew the sides and then the top and bottom to the quilt.

## Outer border

Stitch the strip for outer border. $2 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides and the top and bottom $2 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{1 / 2 "}$. Sew the sides to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together.
You can quilt by hand or machine as desired.
Trim backing and wadding to the size of quilt.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Haunted House collection

1. A602.3-Glow in the dark spiders on
black $-5 / 8 y d-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
2. A601.1-Glow in the dark pumpkin faces
on orange $-5 / 8 y d-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
3. A600.1-Glow in the dark stars on spooky blue $-1 / 4 y d-1 / 4 m t r$
4. A603.3-Hats, cats \& bats on black - $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ - $1 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
5. A599.1-Green glow in the dark haunted house - $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}-1 / 2 \mathrm{mtr}$
6. BB20-Black-1/4yd- $1 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
7. BB295-Bright green-1yd-1mtr

Wadding and backing 48 " x 60 "
All measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances; press each seam as you go.


## Block 1

Lay out your fabric pieces for block 1. Sew the side strips of fabric 3 to the centre square. Next stitch the top and bottom strips to the centre square.
Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric $1 \& 2$ stitch a $1 / 4$ " seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block. Stitch 6 of block 1 in total.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ left side strips of blocks
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top strip of blocks
$12 \times 3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ corner squares
From fabric 2 cut
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ right side strips of blocks
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ bottom strips of blocks
$12 \times 3$ " x 3 " corner squares
From fabric 3 cut
$12 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides (block 1 )
$12 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom (block 1 )
From fabric 4 cut
$6 \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 "$ (block 1)
From fabric 5 cut
$6 \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)
From fabric 6 cut
$5 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ inner border strips
From fabric 7 cut
$5 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ outer border


Block 2
Lay out the fabric pieces for block 2
Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric $1 \& 2$ stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block.
Stitch 6 of block 2 in total.

## Making up the quilt

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram.
Sew in rows, pressing the seam in the opposites. This will help when sewing the rows together.

## Inner border

Join your strip together to get the length. Sides $2 \times 1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 48^{1 / 2 "}$ " and top and bottom $2 \times 1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ x $381 / 2 "$. Sew the sides and then the top and bottom to the quilt.

## Outer border

Stitch the strip for outer border. $2 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides and the top and bottom $2 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{1 / 2 "}$. Sew the sides to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together.
You can quilt by hand or machine as desired.
Trim backing and wadding to the size of quilt.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt $44^{\prime \prime} \times 56$ " - unfinished block size

## Requirements

## Fabrics from the Haunted House collection

1. A602.1-Glow in the dark spiders on grey $-5 / 8 y d-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
2. A601.3-Glow in the dark pumpkin faces on black $-5 / 8 y d-70 \mathrm{~cm}$
3. A600.2-Glow in the dark stars on orange $-1 / 4 y d-1 / 4 m t r$
4. A603.2-Hats, cats \& bats on green - $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ - $1 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
5. A599.3 - Spooky blue glow in the dark haunted house - $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$. $1 / 2 \mathrm{mtr}$
6. BB302-Neptune blue - $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}-1 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$
7. BB110-Rock-1yd-1mtr

Wadding and backing 48 " x 60"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.


## Block 1

Lay out your fabric pieces for block 1 . Sew the side strips of fabric 3 to the centre square. Next stitch the top and bottom strips to the centre square.
Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric $1 \& 2$ stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block. Stitch 6 of block 1 in total.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ left side strips of blocks
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top strip of blocks
$12 \times 3$ " $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ corner squares
From fabric 2 cut
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ right side strips of blocks
$12 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ bottom strips of blocks
$12 \times 3$ " $\times 3$ " corner squares
From fabric 3 cut
$12 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides (block 1 )
$12 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom (block 1 )
From fabric 4 cut
$6 \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (block 1)
From fabric 5 cut
$6 \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (block 2)
From fabric 6 cut
$5 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ inner border strips
From fabric 7 cut
$5 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ outer border


Block 2
Lay out the fabric pieces for block 2
Take the squares of fabrics 1 and draw a diagonally line on the back. With right sides together of fabric $1 \& 2$ stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam each side of the diagonally line. Cut down the pencil line and press open. Trim back to a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Next sew the side strips to the block. Stitch the squares to the end of the top and bottom. Sew to the strips to the block. Stitch 6 of block 2 in total.

## Making up the quilt

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram.
Sew in rows, pressing the seam in the opposites. This will help when sewing the rows together.

## Inner border

Join your strip together to get the length. Sides $2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and top and bottom $2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $381 / 2 "$. Sew the sides and then the top and bottom to the quilt.

## Outer border

Stitch the strip for outer border. $2 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides and the top and bottom $2 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew the sides to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

## Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together.
You can quilt by hand or machine as desired.
Trim backing and wadding to the size of quilt.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.
