



Hibiscus Hummingbird Quilt 1

Designed and made by Sally Ablett

Size of quilt 60" x 60" - unfinished block size

12½" x 12½"

Requirements

Fabrics from the Hibiscus Hummingbird collection

1. A595.3 - Hummingbird mono on blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
 2. A597.1 - Scattered hummingbirds on cream - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
 3. A596.1 - Hibiscus on cream - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
 4. A594.3 - Little flower dot on dark navy - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
 5. A595.1 - Hummingbird mono on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
 6. A597.2 - Scattered hummingbirds on tropical green - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
 7. A596.3 - Hibiscus on blue - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
 8. A594.2 - Little flower dot on dark coral - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
 9. A593.3 - Hummingbird large floral on dark blue - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 70cm
 10. A593.1 - Hummingbird large floral on blush pink - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 70cm
 11. BB40 - Cream - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ mtr
 12. BB290 - Tropics blue - 1yd - 1mtr
- Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

From fabric 9 cut

The numbers in brackets are the row to place your sashing strips in.

3 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (3,5 & 7)

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1 & 9)

10 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (2,4,6 & 8 in between blocks)

6 x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (1,3,5,7 & 9)

From fabric 10 cut

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1, 3, 7 & 9)

2 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (5)

10 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (2,4,6 & 8 in between blocks)

6 x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (1,3,5,7 & 9)

From fabric 11 cut

8 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 1)

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

From fabric 12 cut

8 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 1)

From fabric 2 cut

8 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

8 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

16 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

From fabric 7 cut

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

From fabric 8 cut

8 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

Making up the blocks

For this quilt you have a nine-patch block both are made up in the same way.

Lay out the fabric pieces for the block 1 as in the block diagram.

Corners of top and bottom rows. Sew the two small squares together and then stitch them to the strip to make a square.

Now sew two of the small triangles together, repeat and then stitch the two triangles together to make a square. Make four squares this way.

Lay out the squares and sew in rows and then stitch your rows together to make the block.

8 in total of block 1

Block 2 is made up in the same way as block 1 and again 8 blocks in total.

Complete the quilt.

Sew the small triangles together to make a square. 12 in total

Lay out your sashing, squares and blocks as in the main diagram.

Row 1 - Start with the sashing strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ ", square, sashing strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ ", square and then a strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Rows 2, 4, 6 and 8 - will be the same sashing with blocks in between. Four blocks on each row.

Just the block 1 & 2 are in different places on each of the rows.

Row 3 - Square, sashing strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ ", square and then a strip $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ " and then ending up with a square.

Keep working down the rows as in the main diagram. I would not sew your rows together as you go. Just in case you have sewn the wrong piece in place. Pressing each row in the opposite way each time. This will help when sewing your rows together.

When all the rows are complete stitch them together in order to complete the quilt top.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together.

You can quilt by hand or machine as desired.

Trim backing and wadding to the size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 12 to bind the quilt.

Requirements

Fabrics from the Hibiscus Hummingbird collection

1. A595.1 - Hummingbird mono on cream - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
2. A597.3 - Scattered hummingbirds on tropical blue - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
3. A596.2 - Hibiscus on dark pink - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
4. A594.1 - Littleflower dot on cream - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
5. A595.2 - Hummingbird mono on pink - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A597.1 - Scattered hummingbirds on cream - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
7. A596.1 - Hibiscus on cream - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
8. A594.3 - Little flower dot on dark navy - $\frac{1}{4}$ yd - $\frac{1}{4}$ mtr
9. A593.2 - Hummingbird large floral on tropical blue - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 70cm
10. A593.3 - Hummingbird large floral on dark blue - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 70cm
11. BB290 - Tropics blue - $\frac{3}{4}$ yd - $\frac{3}{4}$ mtr
12. BB297 - Hibiscus pink - 1yd - 1mtr

Wadding and backing 64" x 64"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

From fabric 9 cut

The numbers in brackets are the row to place your sashing strips in.

3 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (3,5 & 7)

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1 & 9)

10 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (2,4,6 & 8 in between blocks)

6 x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (1,3,5,7 & 9)

From fabric 10 cut

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1, 3, 7 & 9)

2 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (5)

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6 x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once (1,3,5,7 & 9)

From fabric 11 cut

8 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 1)

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

From fabric 12 cut

8 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 1)

From fabric 2 cut

8 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

From fabric 3 cut

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 1)

From fabric 4 cut

8 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

From fabric 5 cut

16 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

From fabric 6 cut

8 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

From fabric 7 cut

32 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (for block 2)

From fabric 8 cut

8 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (for block 2)

Making up the blocks

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Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together.

You can quilt by hand or machine as desired.

Trim backing and wadding to the size of quilt.
