## Requirements

Fabrics from the Little Matryoshka collection

1. A566.1 - Matryoshka on cream - 1yd - 1m
2. A567.1 - Daisy dot on pink - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A568.1 - Hearts on red -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
4. A570.3 - Little bird floral heart on black -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
5. A569.3 - Matryoshka floral on black - 1yd - 1mtr
6. BB270 - Bumbleberries Aqua - 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yds - 1.20m
7. BB273 - Bumbleberries Sunshine Yellow -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm

Wadding and backing 62" x 72"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.  
(You will need to join your strips to get the length on the borders)

**When cutting diagonal lines look at the pattern on the fabric**

### Cutting fabrics

#### From fabric 1 cut

30 x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (B1)

#### From fabric 2 cut

30 x 3" x 3" (B1)

#### From fabric 3 cut

9 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right (B2)

6 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once top left to bottom right (B2)

30 x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " (B2)

#### From fabric 4 cut

9 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right (B2)

6 x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 5 $\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once top left to bottom right (B2)

30 x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " (B2)

#### From fabric 5 cut

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (outer border sides)

2 x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (outer border top & bottom)

#### From fabric 6 cut

30 x 3" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (B1)

30 x 3" x 3" (B1)

30 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " cut in half diagonally twice (B1)

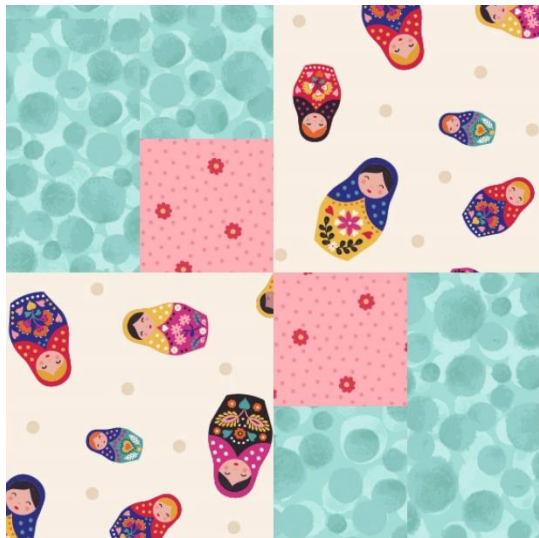
30 x 21/4" x 21/4" cut in half diagonally once (B1)

### From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" (inner border sides)

2 x 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" (inner borders top & bottom)

### Making up block 1 and block 1 A

Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1. Stitch the two small squares 3" x 3" together to make a strip 3" x 5 1/2".

Next sew the two strips of 3" x 5 1/2" together to make a square.

Now lay out all four squares as in block 1 diagram.

Sew the two top squares together, press and then your bottom two. Stitch together to complete the block.

In total you need 9 of block 1 and 6 of block 1 A.

### Making up block 2

Both blocks are made up in the same way.

Lay out all the fabric pieces for block 1. Stitch a triangle each side of the square, press back and then sew the small triangle to the top.

now sew the two triangles together to make a square.

Do the same to the other pieces. Sew in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the block. You need to sew 6 of block 2 and 9 of block 2 B in total.

### **Making up the quilt centre**

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows and then stitch the rows together to complete the centre.

### **Inner border**

Sew the sides to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

### **Outer border**

Sew the sides to the quilt and then the top and bottom.

### **Quilting**

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

### **Binding**

Use your favourite method from fabric 5 to bind the quilt.

1. A566.2 - Matryoshka on dark red - 1yd - 1mtr
2. A567.3 - Daisy dot on turquoise - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A568.3 - Hearts on black -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ mtr
4. A570.1- Little bird floral heart on cream -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
5. A569.1 - Matryoshka floral on cream - 1yd - 1mtr
6. BB40 - Bumbleberries Cream -  $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd – 1.20mtrs
7. BB270 - Bumbleberries Aqua -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm

Wadding and backing 62" x 72"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

### Cutting fabrics

#### From fabric 1 cut

30 x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (B1)

#### From fabric 2 cut

30 x 3" x 3" (B1)

#### From fabric 3 cut

9 x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right (B2)

6 x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once top left to bottom right (B2)

30 x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " (B2)

#### From fabric 4 cut

9 x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right (B2)

6 x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once top left to bottom right (B2)

30 x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " (B2)

#### From fabric 5 cut

2 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $62\frac{1}{2}$ " (outer border sides)

2 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $58\frac{1}{2}$ " (outer border top & bottom)

#### From fabric 6 cut

30 x 3" x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (B1)

30 x 3" x 3" (B1)

30 x 4½" x 4½" cut in half diagonally twice (B1)

30 x 2¼" x 2¼" cut in half diagonally once (B1)

### From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1½" x 60½" (inner border sides)

2 x 1½" x 52½" (inner borders top & bottom)

### Making up block 1 and block 1 A

Lay out the fabric pieces for block 1. Stitch the two small squares 3" x 3" together to make a strip 3" x 5½".

Next sew the two strips of 3" x 5½" together to make a square.

Now lay out all four squares as in block 1 diagram.

Sew the two top squares together, press and then your bottom two. Stitch together to complete the block.

In total you need 9 of block 1 and 6 of block 1 A.

### Making up block 2

Both blocks are made up in the same way.

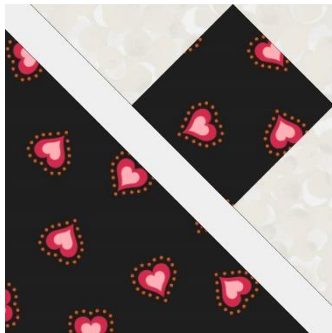
Lay out all the fabric pieces for block 1. Stitch a triangle each side of the square, press back and then sew the small triangle to the top.

3. A568.2 - Hearts on blue -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
4. A570.2 - Little bird floral heart on red -  $\frac{3}{4}$ yd -  $\frac{3}{4}$ m
5. A569.2 - Matryoshka floral on red - 1yd - 1m
6. BB40 - Bumbleberries Cream -  $1\frac{1}{4}$ yd – 1.20m
7. BB20 - Bumbleberries Black -  $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm

Wadding and backing 62" x 72"

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.  
(You will need to join your strips to get the length on the borders)

**When cutting diagonally lines look at the pattern on the fabric**

### Cutting fabrics

#### From fabric 1 cut

30 x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (B1)

#### From fabric 2 cut

30 x 3" x 3" (B1)

#### From fabric 3 cut

9 x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right (B2)

6 x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once top left to bottom right (B2)

30 x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " (B2)

#### From fabric 4 cut

9 x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once from bottom left to top right (B2)

6 x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $5\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once top left to bottom right (B2)

30 x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " (B2)

#### From fabric 5 cut

2 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $62\frac{1}{2}$ " (outer border sides)

2 x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $58\frac{1}{2}$ " (outer border top & bottom)

### **From fabric 6 cut**

30 x 3" x 5½" (B1)

30 x 3" x 3" (B1)

30 x 4½" x 4½" cut in half diagonally twice (B1)

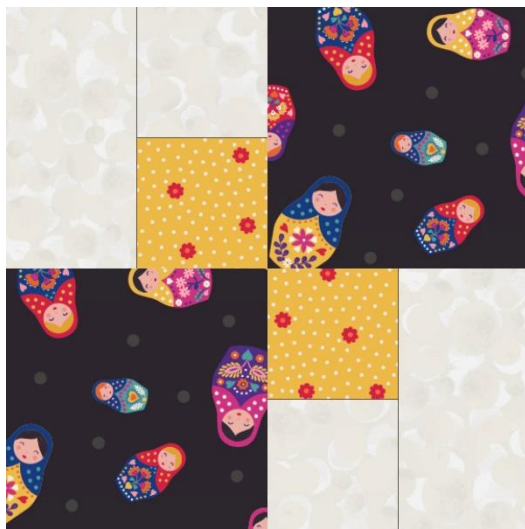
30 x 2¼" x 2¼" cut in half diagonally once (B1)

### **From fabric 7 cut**

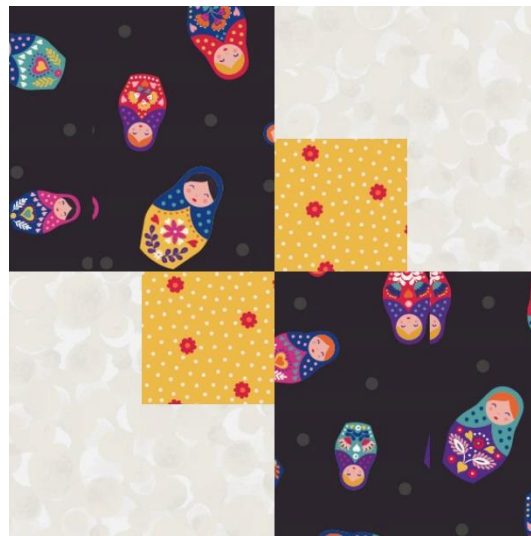
2 x 1½" x 60½" (inner border sides)

2 x 1½" x 52½" (inner borders top & bottom)

### **Making up block 1 and block 1 A**

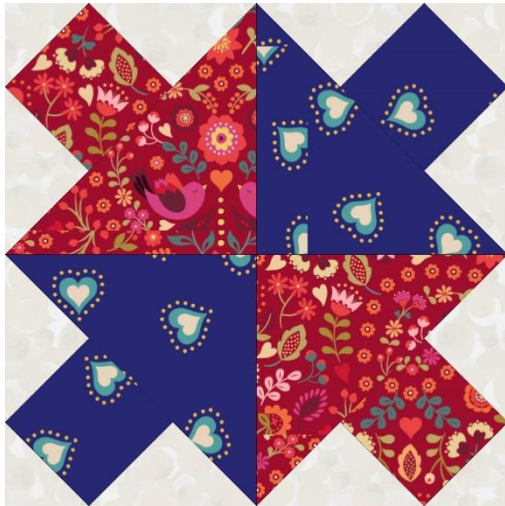

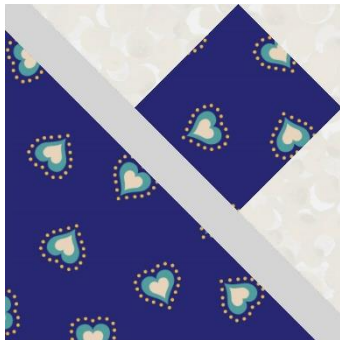
