## Loch Lewis Cushion 1

Designed and made by Sally Ablett

Cushion size 20" x 20" - unfinished block size 12½" x 12½"

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Loch Lewis collection

1. A157.4 - Purple Antlers - long  $\frac{1}{4}$
2. A538.1 - Castles and Highland Cattle on Dark Cream - fat  $\frac{1}{8}$
3. A539.2 - Loch Lewis Red Check - fat  $\frac{1}{8}$
4. A540.1 - Sage Deer Check - fat  $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A541.3 - Thistle on Dark Purple - fat  $\frac{1}{4}$
6. BB258 - Bumbleberries Celtic Green - fat  $\frac{1}{8}$

Wadding 24" x 24"

20" x 20" cushion pad

Backing for cushion -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## Cutting

### From fabric 1 cut

2 x 3" x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

2 x 3" x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom

### From fabric 2 cut

1 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### From fabric 3 cut

1 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

### From fabric 4 cut

2 x 2" x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides (inner border)

2 x 2" x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom (inner border)

### From fabric 5 cut

1 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### From fabric 6 cut

2 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

## Making up the blocks



**Block**

Lay out the fabric pieces for block

Start with the corner pieces.

Stitch the two small squares together and then sew the rectangle to this to make the square. Stitch 4 in total



Sew two of the small triangles together and then stitch the two triangles together to make a square. Stitch 4 in total.

Lay out all your pieces as in the block diagram 1

Sew in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the block.

### Inner border

Stitch fabric 4 to the cushions. Sides press back and then the top and bottom.

### Outer border

Sew the outer border the same as inner border to the cushion.

## **Completion**

Make quilt sandwich with cushion front, 22" wadding and muslin squares.

Quilt as desired.

Cut two, 14½" x 20½" rectangles from backing.

Make a double fold to wrong side along one long edge on each backing rectangle and stitch in place.

Place cushion front right side up on work surface. Lay one backing rectangle right side down on top, aligning raw edges at bottom edge and sides. Add second backing rectangle on top, right side down and aligning raw edges at top edge and sides. Pin in place. Folded edges should overlap by several inches at centre.

Stitch around all four edges. Add line of zigzag stitches within seam allowance on all four edges for additional strength.

Turn right side out and insert a 20" cushion pad.

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Loch Lewis collection

1. A157.5 - Red Antlers - long  $\frac{1}{4}$
2. A538.3 - Castles and Highland Cattle on Mocha - fat  $\frac{1}{8}$
3. A539.1 - Loch Lewis Green Check - fat  $\frac{1}{8}$
4. A540.3 - Dark Blue Deer Check - fat  $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A541.2 - Red thistle on natural - fat  $\frac{1}{4}$
6. BB40 - Bumbleberries Cream - fat  $\frac{1}{8}$

Wadding 24" x 24"

20" x 20" cushion pad

Backing for cushion -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## Cutting

### From fabric 1 cut

2 x 3" x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

2 x 3" x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom

### From fabric 2 cut

1 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### From fabric 3 cut

1 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

### From fabric 4 cut

2 x 2" x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides (inner border)

2 x 2" x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom (inner border)

### From fabric 5 cut

1 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### From fabric 6 cut

2 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

## Making up the blocks



**Block**

Lay out the fabric pieces for block

Start with the corner pieces.

Stitch the two small squares together and then sew the rectangle to this to make the square. Stitch 4 in total

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Loch Lewis collection

1. A157.6 - Loch Blue Antlers - long  $\frac{1}{4}$
2. A538.2 - Castles and Highland Cattle on Light Sage - fat $\frac{1}{8}$
3. A539.3 - Loch Lewis Blue Check - fat $\frac{1}{8}$
4. A540.2 - Purple Deer Check - fat  $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A541.1 - Purple Thistle on Natural - fat  $\frac{1}{4}$
6. BB265 - Bumbleberries Dark Plum - fat $\frac{1}{8}$

Wadding 24" x 24"

20" x 20" cushion pad

Backing for cushion -  $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm

All measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

## Cutting

### From fabric 1 cut

2 x 3" x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides

2 x 3" x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom

### From fabric 2 cut

1 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### From fabric 3 cut

1 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

### From fabric 4 cut

2 x 2" x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sides (inner border)

2 x 2" x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom (inner border)

### From fabric 5 cut

1 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

4 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

### From fabric 6 cut

2 x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice

## Making up the blocks



**Block**

Lay out the fabric pieces for block

Start with the corner pieces.

Stitch the two small squares together and then sew the rectangle to this to make the square. Stitch 4 in total



Sew two of the small triangles together and then stitch the two triangles together to make a square. Stitch 4 in total.
