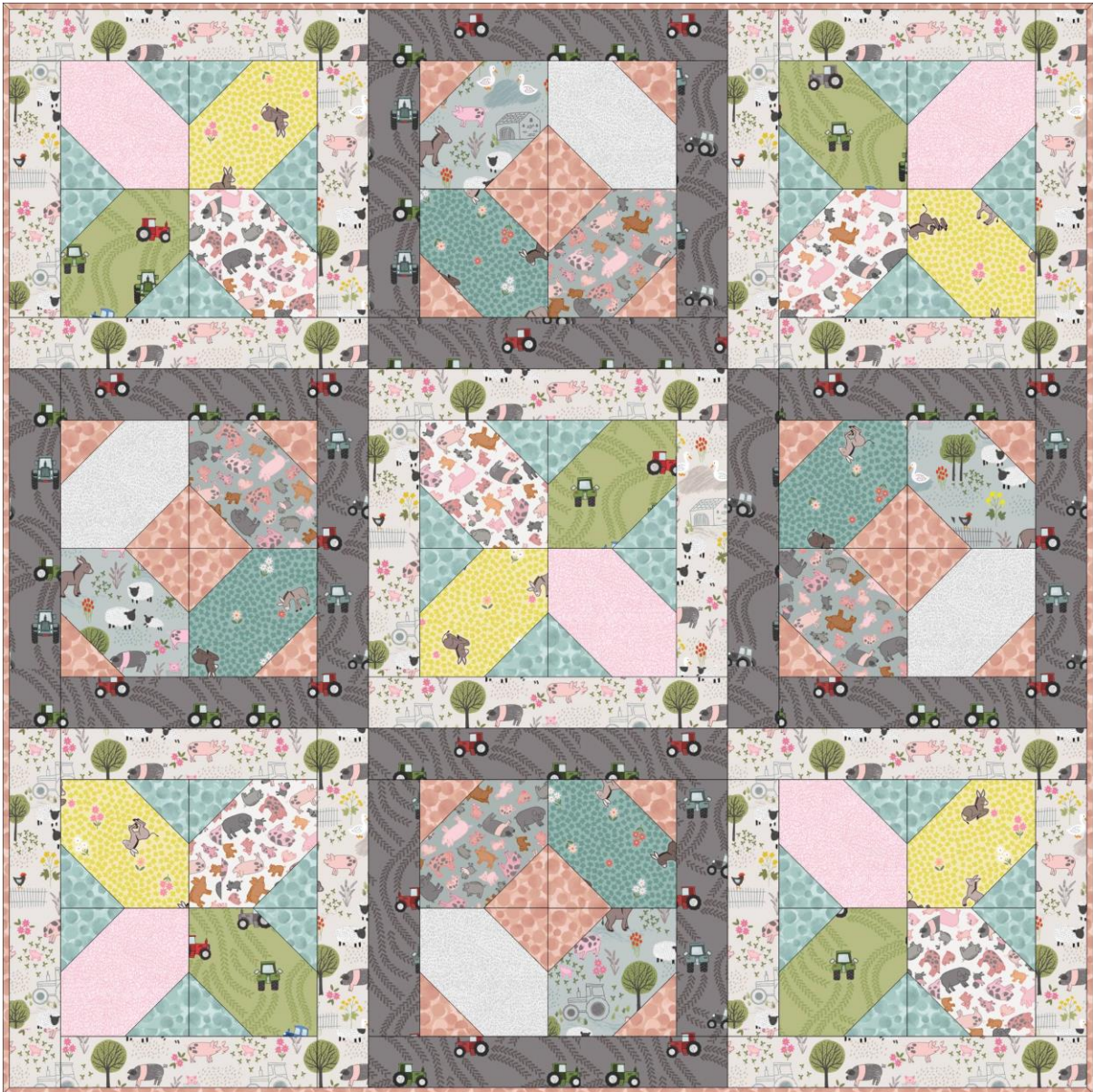

Quilt size 42" x 42" - unfinished block size 14½" x 14½"



Main Diagram

REQUIREMENTS

Fabrics from the Piggy Tales collection

1. A531.1 - Farmyard on dark cream - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
2. A532.2 - Piggy tails on pink - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A533.1 - Tractor trails on green - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A534.1 - Piggies on cream - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A535.1 - Dinky Donkeys on yellow - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. A531.2 - Farmyard on mid grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. A532.1 - Piggy tails on light grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. A533.3 - Tractor trails on muddy grey - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
9. A534.2 - Piggies on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. A535.3 - Dinky Donkeys on dark duck egg - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. BB250 - Bumbleberries peaceful blue - long $\frac{1}{4}$
12. BB253 - Bumbleberries muted peach - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

Wadding and backing 46" x 46"

Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout. Press all seams as you go

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

10 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

10 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 & 5 cut

5 x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 8 cut

8 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

8 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From each of the fabrics 6, 7, 9 & 10

4 x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 11 cut

40 x 3" x 3" (block 1)

From fabric 12 cut

32 x 3" x 3" (block 2)

Making up the block 1 & 2

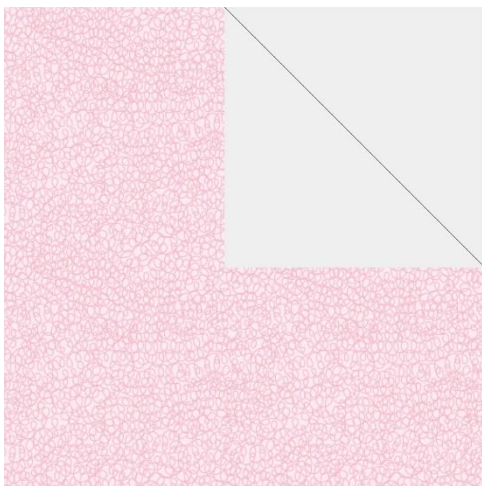


Block 1

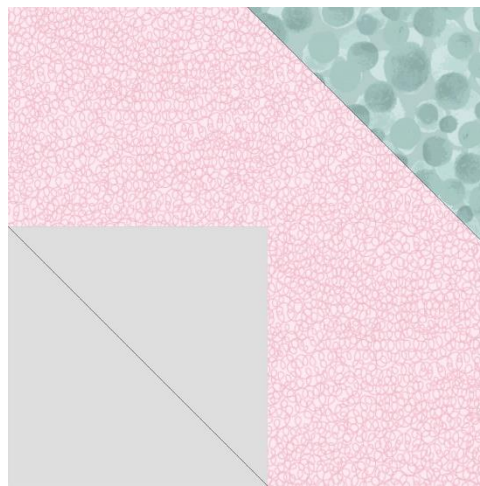


Block 2

Both blocks are made up in the same way. Lay out your fabric pieces for the block 1. On fabric 11 draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of your square. With right side together place onto the larger square as in part 1. Sew on the outer edge side of the pencil line. Trim a ¼" seam from the outer edge stitch line. Press back and then do the same to the opposite side.

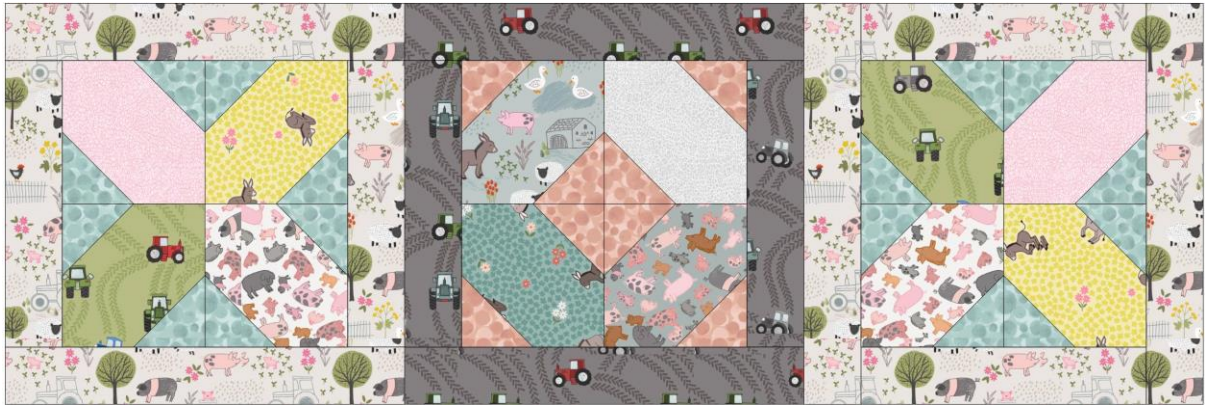
Part 2

Do this to all your squares. Lay your square as in the block diagram. Sew the four together for the centre of block. Add the shorter strips to the block and sew the last two to complete the block. 5 blocks in total.

Block 2 is made in the same way as block 1 but you will have 4 blocks in total this time.

Complete the Playmat

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram.



Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the playmat.
You could add more blocks to make this into a quilt

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of the playmat.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 12 to bind the playmat.

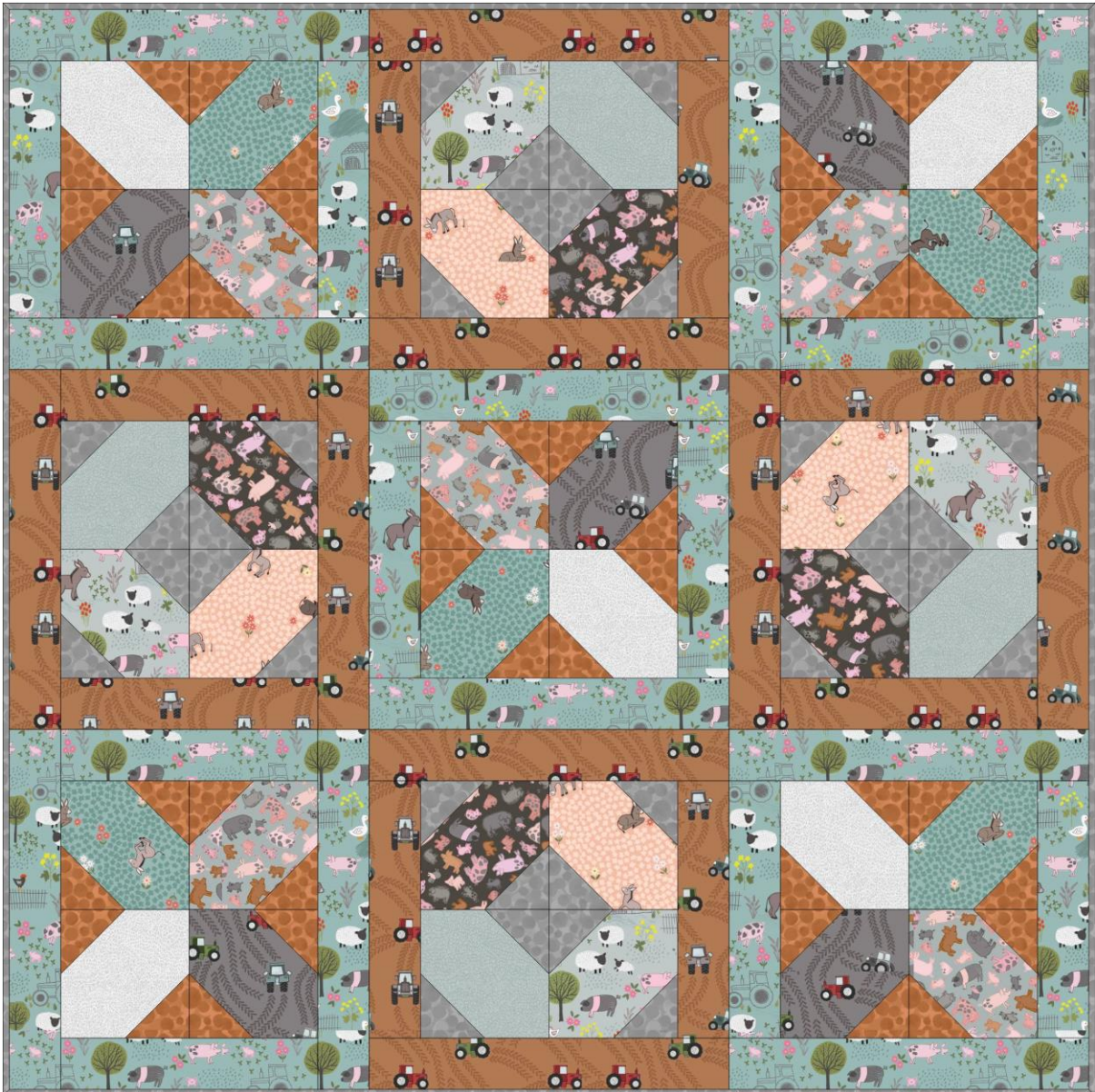

REQUIREMENTS

Fabrics from the Piggy Tales collection

1. A531.3 - Farmyard on duck egg - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd -60 cm
2. A532.1 - Piggy tails on light grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
3. A533.3 - Tractor trails on muddy grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
4. A534.2 - Piggies on grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
5. A535.3 - Dinky Donkeys on dark duck egg - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. A531.2 - Farmyard on mid grey - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
7. A532.3 - Piggy tails on blue - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
8. A533.2 - Tractor trails on rust - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd - 60cm
9. A534.3 - Piggies on dark mud - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
10. A535.2 - Dinky Donkeys on peach - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
11. BB261 - Bumbleberries amber - long $\frac{1}{4}$
12. BB110 - Bumbleberries rock - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd

Wadding and backing 46" x 46"

Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout. Press all seams as you go

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

10 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

10 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 & 5 cut

5 x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1)

From fabric 8 cut

8 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

8 x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From each of the fabrics 6, 7, 9 & 10

4 x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (block 2)

From fabric 11 cut

40 x 3" x 3" (block 1)

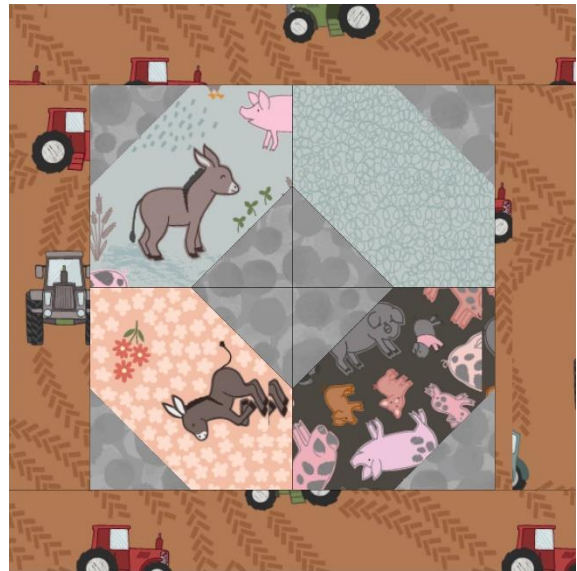
From fabric 12 cut

32 x 3" x 3" (block 2)

Making up the block 1 & 2



Block 1

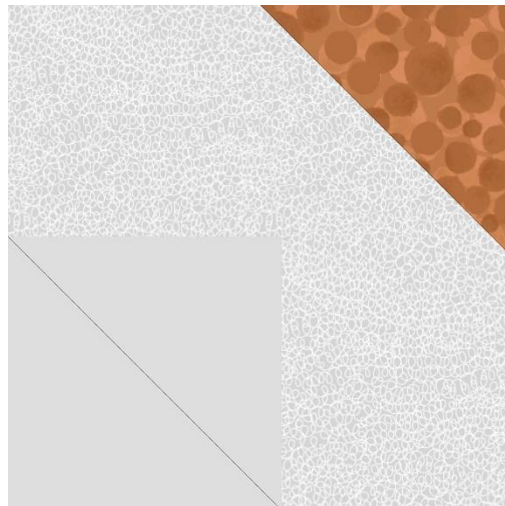


Block 2

Both blocks are made up in the same way. Lay out your fabric pieces for the block 1. On fabric 11 draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of your square. With right side together place onto the larger square as in part 1. Sew on the outer edge side of the pencil line. Trim a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam from the outer edge stitch line. Press back and then do the same to the opposite side.

Part 2

Do this to all your squares. Lay your square as in the block diagram. Sew the four together for the centre of block. Add the shorter strips to the block and sew the last two to complete the block. 5 blocks in total.

Block 2 is made in the same way as block 1 but you will have 4 blocks in total this time.

Complete the Playmat

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram.



Stitch in rows and then sew the rows together to complete the playmat. You could add more blocks to make this into a quilt

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of the playmat.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 12 to bind the playmat.
