



Secret Winter Garden Throw 1

Designed and made by Sally Ablett

Size of quilt 48" x 48" - unfinished block size

10½" x 10½"

Requirements

Fabrics from the Secret Winter Garden collection

1. A660.2 - Owl orchard on dark grey with pearl elements - 5/8yd
2. A659.2 - Frosted Garden on mist blue with pearl elements - 5/8yd
3. A656.1 - Secret Garden on frosty grey with pearl elements - 1/2yd
4. A657.3 - Gold metallic keys on dark blue - 1/2yd
5. A658.2 - Snowberries on grey with pearl effect - fat 1/4
6. BB111 - Indigo - 5/8yd
7. BB148 - Cream - 1yd

Wadding and backing 52" x 52"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" H

32 x 2 1/2" x 5 1/4" W

From fabric 2 cut

16 x 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" H

32 x 2 1/2" x 5 1/4" W

From fabric 3 cut

16 x 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"

From fabric 4 cut

7 x 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" cut in half diagonally twice (border)

From fabric 5 cut

4 x 3" x 3" cut in half diagonally once (corners on border)

24 x 25/8" x 25/8" (border)

From fabric 6 cut

32 x 1" x 6 1/2" top & bottom strips

32 x 1" x 5 1/2" side strips

32 x 1" x 2 1/2" in between strips on block

From fabric 7 cut

4 x 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" corners in borders

28 x 3" x 3" cut in half diagonally once (border)



Two of the rows

Making up the block

Both blocks are made up in the same way. It's just the colour way that is different. Lay out the fabric pieces for the block 1. Sew a strip of fabric 6 to each side of the center square, press back. Next stitch the strips to the top & bottom.

Add each of the outer side strips to the block. Now sew the top and bottom strips to the center strip and then stitch to the block. In total 8 of block 1 and 8 of block 2.

Stitching quilt center.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. Press the seam in the opposite way each time as will help when sewing your rows together.

Border

Lay out your fabric pieces for the border. Stitch the two small triangles together. Sew four of each for the start and finished of the border strips. Next stitch a small triangle to each side of the square as in the diagram. You need to sew 24 in total. As in the main diagram lay out the fabric pieces for each border strip. Sew the small triangle to a larger triangle on each row. Keep working along the row until all pieces are stitch. On the top and bottom strip sew a square to each end. Stitch the border sides to the quilt, press back and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt.

Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

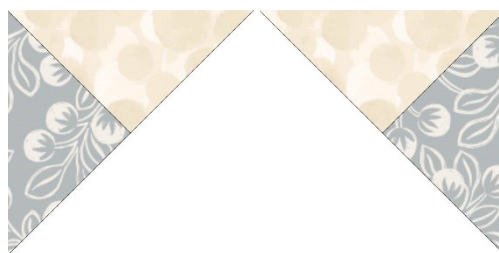
Use your favorite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.

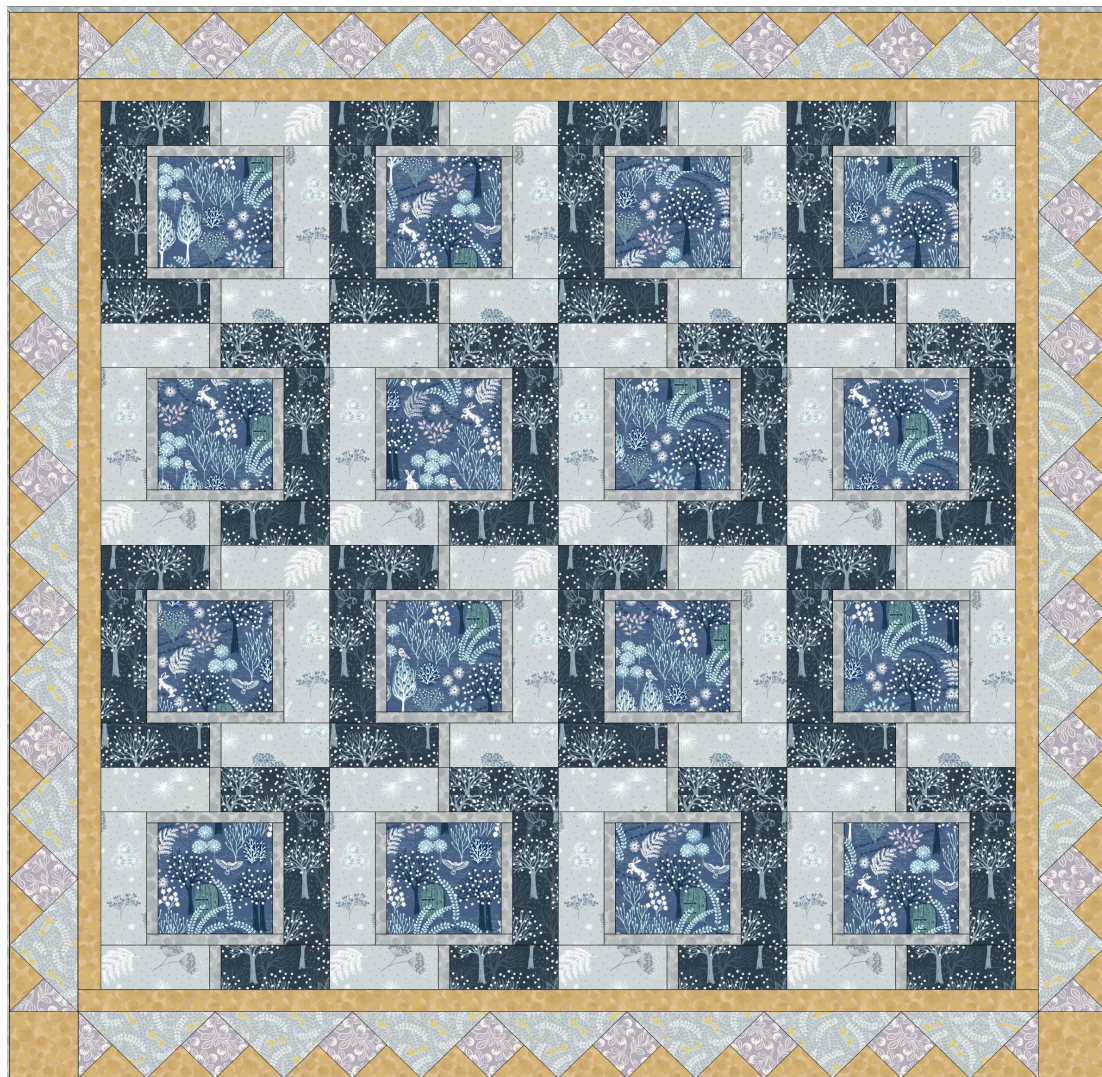

Size of quilt 48" x 48" - unfinished block size
10½" x 10½"

Requirements

Fabrics from the Secret Winter Garden collection

1. A660.3 - Owl orchard on dark blue with pearl elements - 5/8yd
2. A659.1 - Frosted Garden on light grey with pearl elements - 5/8yd
3. A656.2 - Secret Garden on Nordic blue with pearl elements - 1/2yd
4. A657.1 - Gold metallic keys on icy grey - 1/2yd
5. A658.3 - Snowberries on iced lavender with pearl effect - fat1/4
6. BB305 - Light slate - 5/8yd
7. BB151 - Gold - 1yd

Wadding and backing 52" x 52"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" H

32 x 2 1/2" x 5 1/4" W

From fabric 2 cut

16 x 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" H

32 x 2 1/2" x 5 1/4" W

From fabric 3 cut

16 x 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"

From fabric 4 cut

7 x 7 1/4" x 7 1/4" cut in half diagonally twice (border)

From fabric 5 cut

4 x 3" x 3" cut in half diagonally once (corners on border)

24 x 25/8" x 25/8" (border)

From fabric 6 cut

32 x 1" x 6 1/2" top & bottom strips

32 x 1" x 5 1/2" side strips

32 x 1" x 2 1/2" in between strips on block

From fabric 7 cut

4 x 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" corners in borders

28 x 3" x 3" cut in half diagonally once (border)



Two of the rows

Making up the block

Both blocks are made up in the same way. It's just the colour way that is different. Lay out the fabric pieces for the block 1. Sew a strip of fabric 6 to each side of the center square, press back. Next stitch the strips to the top & bottom.

Add each of the outer side strips to the block. Now sew the top and bottom strips to the center strip and then stitch to the block. In total 8 of block 1 and 8 of block 2.

Stitching quilt center.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. Press the seam in the opposite way each time as will help when sewing your rows together.

Border

Lay out your fabric pieces for the border. Stitch the two small triangles together. Sew four of each for the start and finished of the border strips. Next stitch a small triangle to each side of the square as in the diagram. You need to sew 24 in total.

As in the main diagram lay out the fabric pieces for each border strip. Sew the small triangle to a larger triangle on each row. Keep working along the row until all pieces are stitch. On the top and bottom strip sew a square to each end.

Stitch the border sides to the quilt, press back and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt.

Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

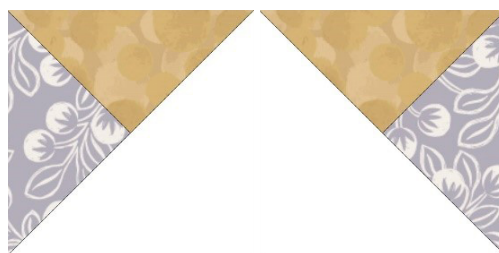
Use your favorite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.

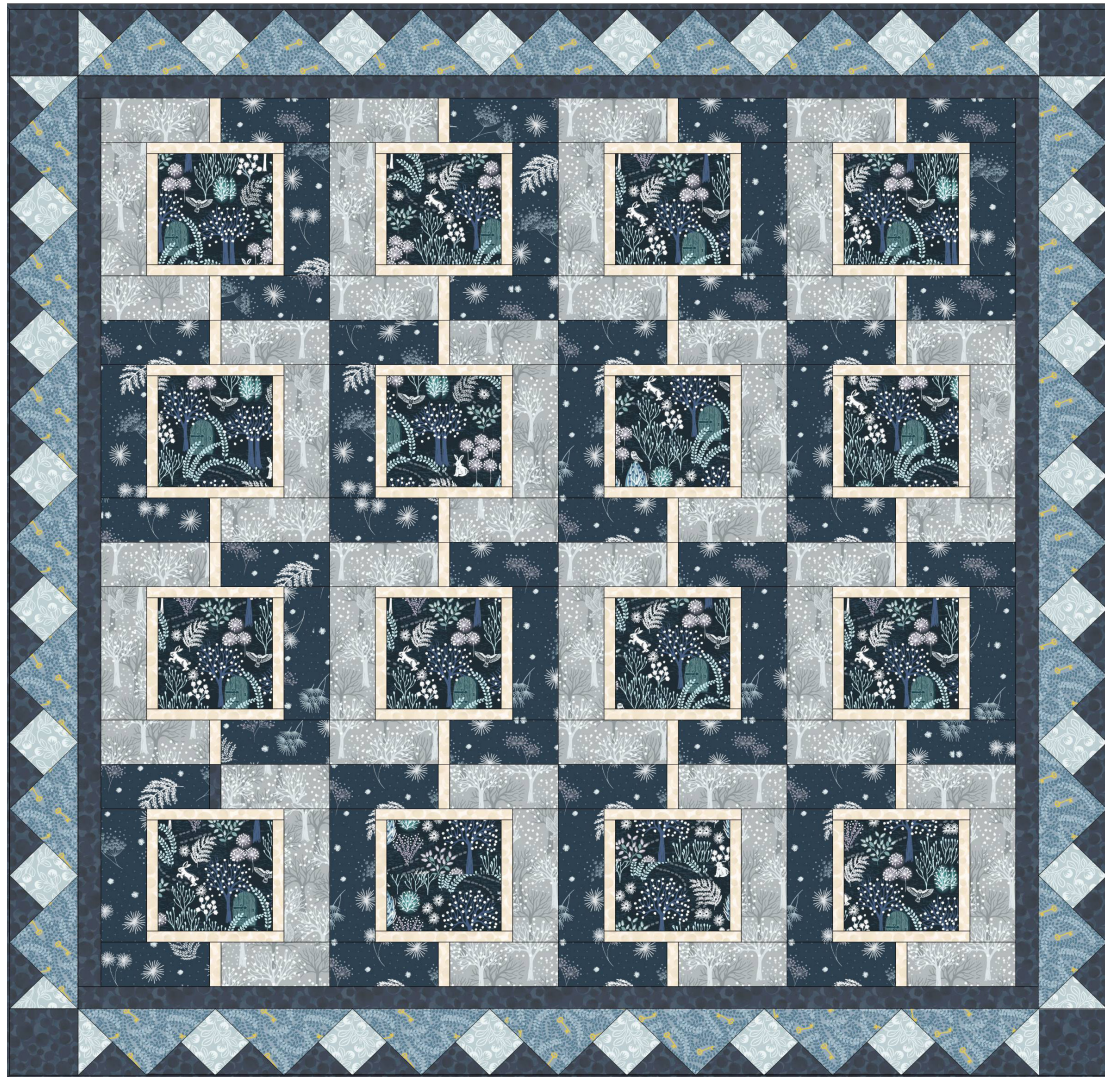

Requirements

Fabrics from the Secret Winter Garden collection

1. A660.1 - Owl orchard on light grey with pearl elements - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd
2. A659.3 - Frosted Garden on dark blue with pearl elements - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd
3. A656.3 - Secret Garden on midnight blue with pearl elements - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
4. A657.2 - Gold metallic keys on morning blue - $\frac{1}{2}$ yd
5. A658.1 - Snowberries on ice blue with pearl effect - fat $\frac{1}{4}$
6. BB148 - Cream - $\frac{5}{8}$ yd
7. BB111 - Indigo - 1yd

Wadding and backing 52" x 52"

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2½" x 6½" H

32 x 2½" x 5¼" W

From fabric 2 cut

16 x 2½" x 6½" H

32 x 2½" x 5¼" W

From fabric 3 cut

16 x 5½" x 5½"

From fabric 4 cut

7 x 7¼" x 7¼" cut in half diagonally twice (border)

From fabric 5 cut

4 x 3" x 3" cut in half diagonally once (corners on border)

24 x 25/8" x 25/8" (border)

From fabric 6 cut

32 x 1" x 6½" top & bottom strips

32 x 1" x 5½" side strips

32 x 1" x 2½" in between strips on block

From fabric 7 cut

4 x 3½" x 3½" corners in borders

28 x 3" x 3" cut in half diagonally once (border)



Two of the rows

Making up the block

Both blocks are made up in the same way. It's just the colour way that is different. Lay out the fabric pieces for the block 1. Sew a strip of fabric 6 to each side of the center square, press back. Next stitch the strips to the top & bottom.

Add each of the outer side strips to the block. Now sew the top and bottom strips to the center strip and then stitch to the block.

In total 8 of block 1 and 8 of block 2.

Stitching quilt center.

Lay out the blocks as in the main diagram. Press the seam in the opposite way each time as will help when sewing your rows together.

Border

Lay out your fabric pieces for the border. Stitch the two small triangles together. Sew four of each for the start and finished of the border strips. Next stitch a small triangle to each side of the square as in the diagram. You need to sew 24 in total.

As in the main diagram lay out the fabric pieces for each border strip. Sew the small triangle to a larger triangle on each row. Keep working along the row until all pieces are stitch. On the top and bottom strip sew a square to each end.

Stitch the border sides to the quilt, press back and then the top and bottom to complete the quilt.

Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.
