

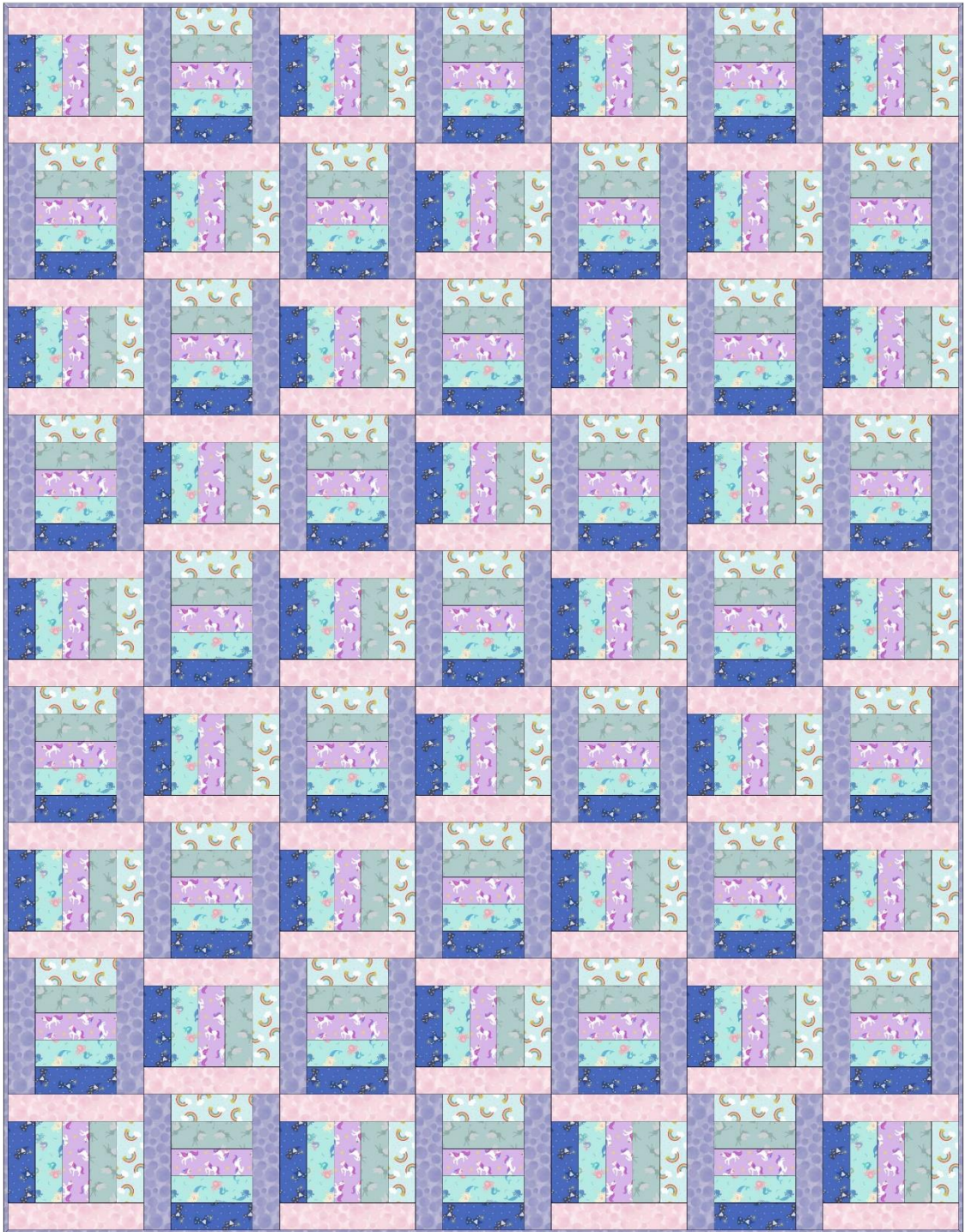

Small Things ... Mystical and Magical Quilt

Quilt Size: 53" x 68" Block Size: 8" x 8"



DESIGN 1 (Main Diagram)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Small Things ... Mystical and Magical Collection)

- Fabric 1: ½yd - ½mtr - SM6.3 (Unicorns on lavender with gold metallic)
- Fabric 2: ½yd - ½mtr - SM7.3 (Mermaids on light blue with blue metallic)
- Fabric 3: ½yd - ½mtr - SM8.1 (Rainbows on pale blue with gold metallic)
- Fabric 4: ½yd - ½mtr - SM9.3 (Fairies on duck egg with silver metallic)
- Fabric 5: ½yd - ½mtr - SM10.2 (Wizards on mid blue with gold metallic)
- Fabric 6: ¾yd - ¾mtr - BB130 (Candyfloss)
- Fabric 7: 1yd - 1mtr - BB137 (Blackberry juice)

Wadding and backing 57" x 72"

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

CUTTING

From each of the fabrics 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut:

8 x 2" x 42"

From fabric 6 cut:

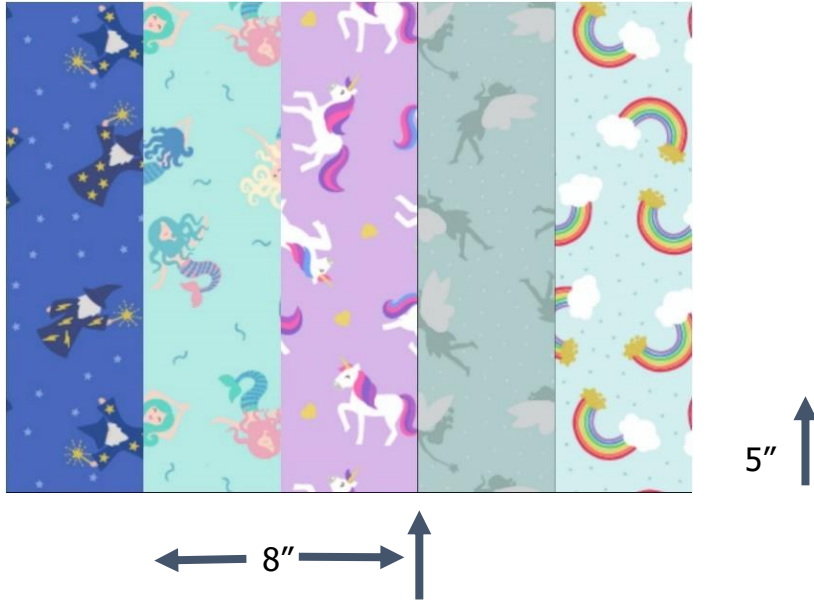
64 x 2" x 8"

From fabric 7 cut:

62 x 2" x 8"

MAKING UP THE BLOCKS

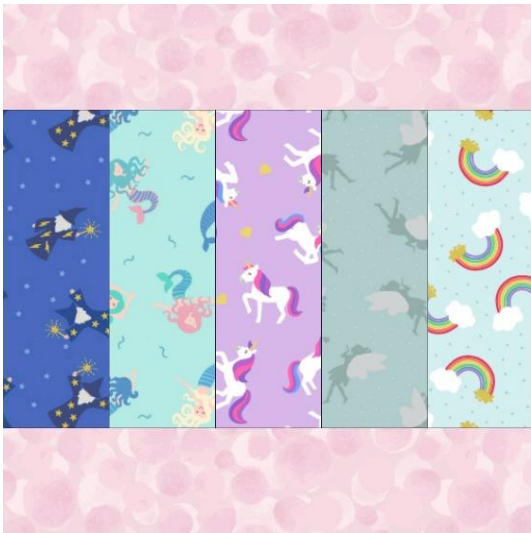
Sew your strips together as in the diagram



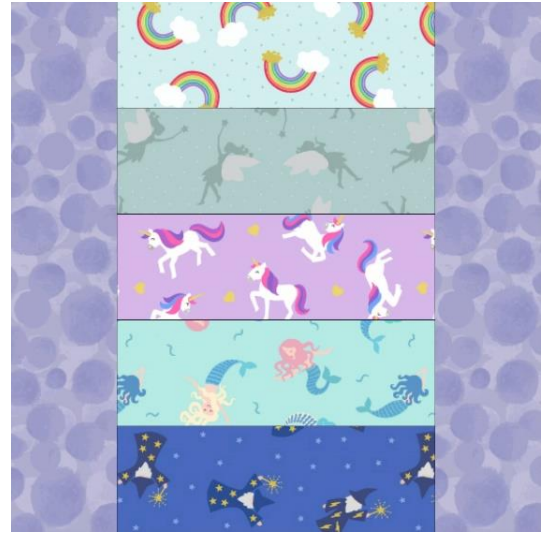
Trim off the edge at one end. Next cut into 5" x 8" rectangles. Cut 63

Sew the strips of fabric 6 to opposite sides of the strip block. 32 in total

Then sew the strips of fabric 7 to opposite sides of the strip block. 31 in total



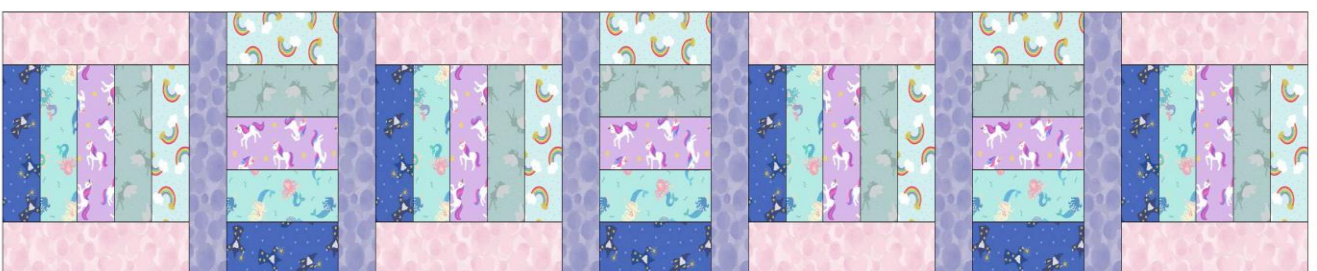

COMPLETE THE QUILT TOP

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram and stitch the rows together



Press the seams for each row in opposite directions to make the finish of the completed quilt top neater

Stitch the rows together to complete the quilt top

QUILTING

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together

Quilt by hand or machine as desired

Trim backing and wadding to size

BINDING

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt

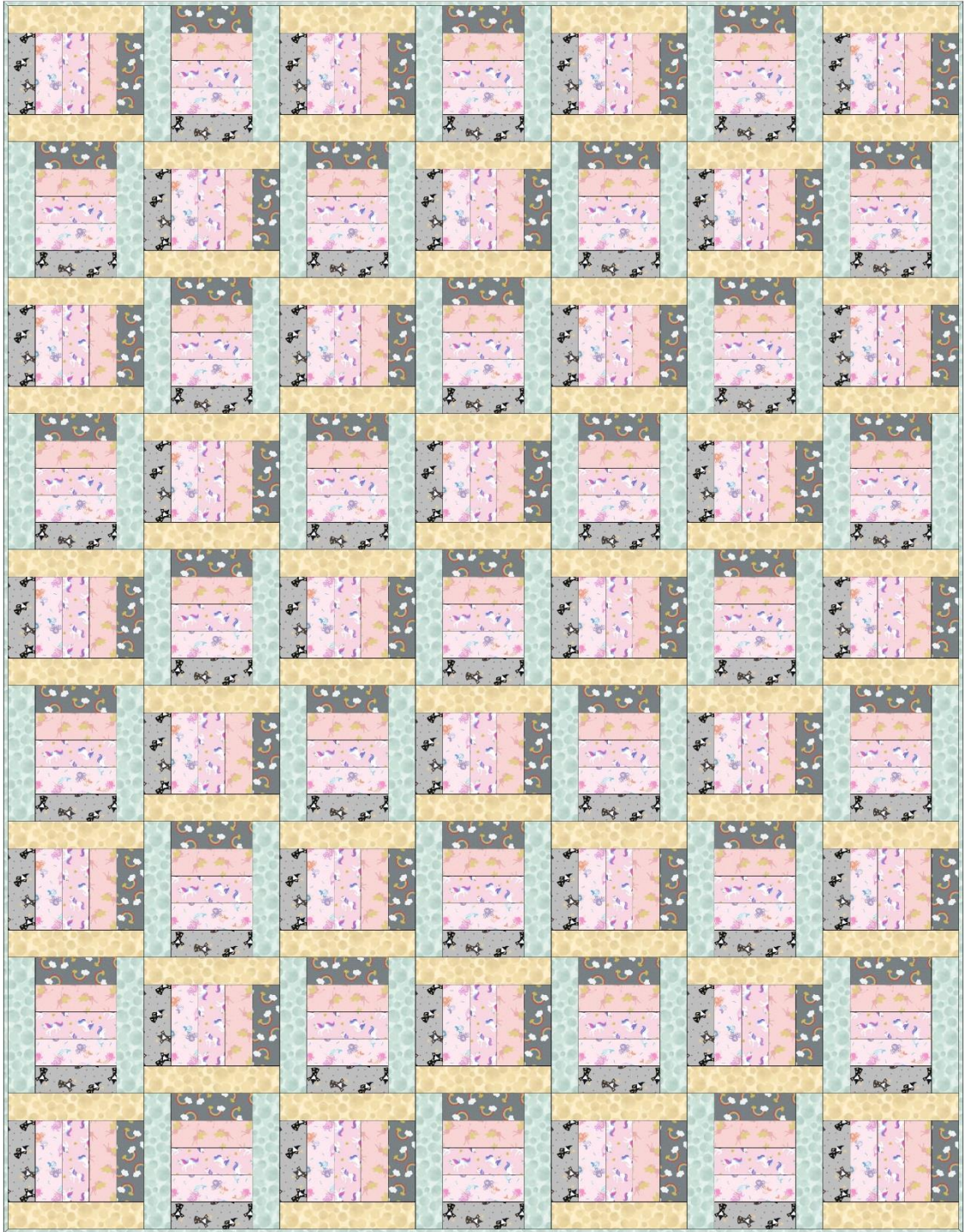
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DESIGN 2 (Main Diagram)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Small Things ... Mystical and Magical Collection)

Fabric 1: 1/2yd - 1/2mtr - SM6.2 (Unicorns on pink with gold metallic)

Fabric 2: 1/2yd - 1/2mtr - SM7.2 (Mermaids on pale pink with silver metallic)

Fabric 3: 1/2yd - 1/2mtr - SM8.3 (Rainbows on grey with gold metallic)

Fabric 4: 1/2yd - 1/2mtr - SM9.2 (Fairies on pink with gold metallic)

Fabric 5: 1/2yd - 1/2mtr - SM10.1 (Wizards on grey with gold metallic)

Fabric 6: 3/4yd - 3/4mtr - BB132 (Mellow yellow)

Fabric 7: 1yd - 1mtr - BB131 (Light duck egg)

Wadding and backing 57" x 72"

Use 1/4" seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

CUTTING

From each of the fabrics 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut:

8 x 2" x 42"

From fabric 6 cut:

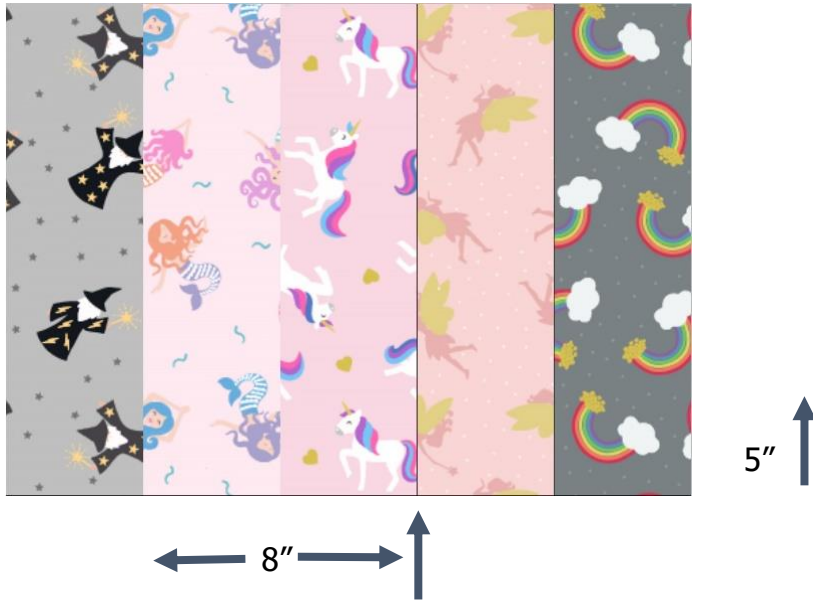
64 x 2" x 8"

From fabric 7 cut:

62 x 2" x 8"

MAKING UP THE BLOCKS

Sew your strips together as in the diagram



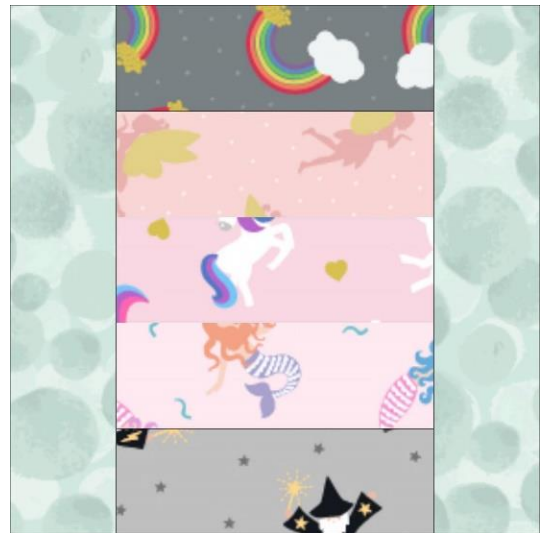
Trim off the edge at one end. Next cut into 5" x 8" rectangles. Cut 63

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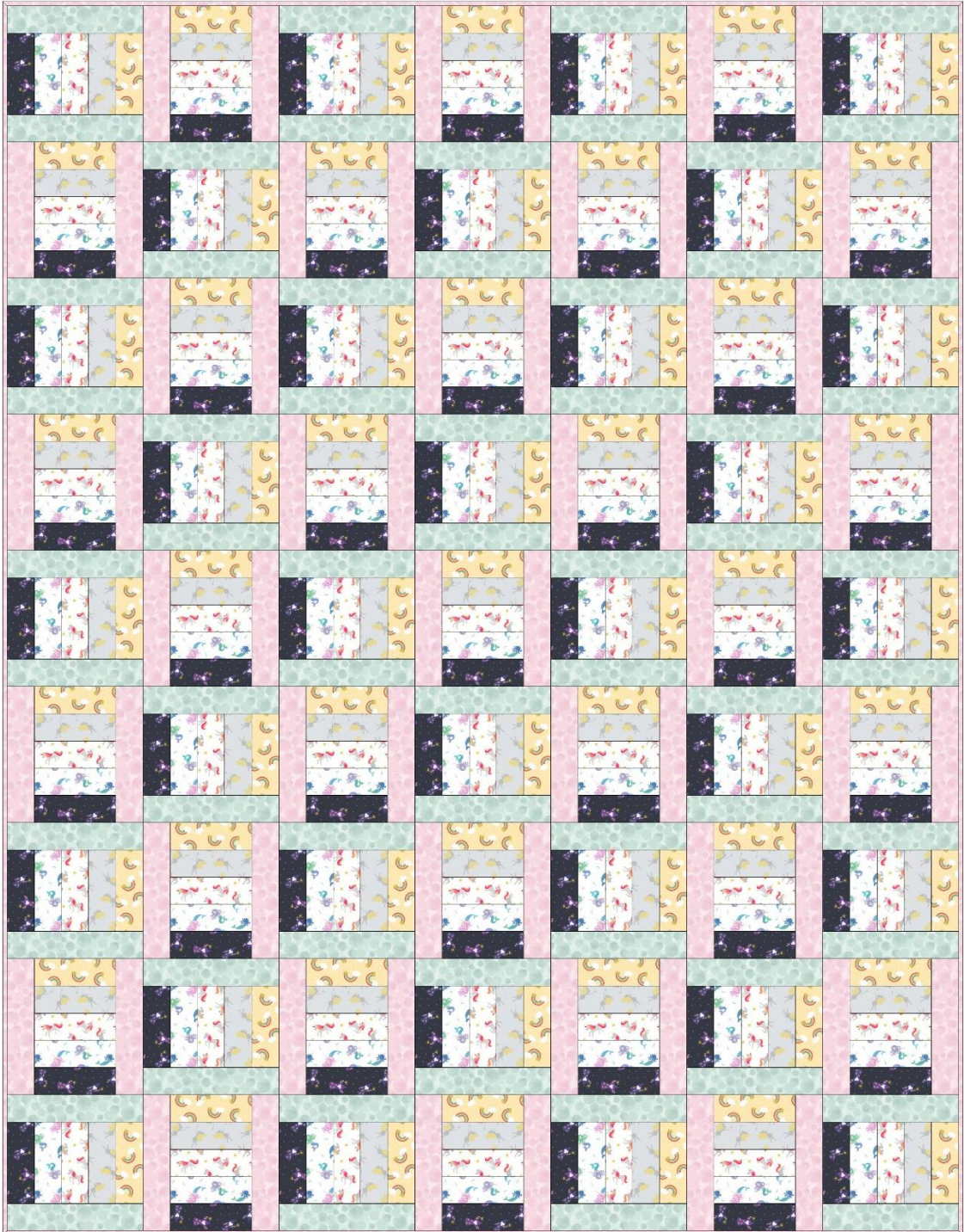
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DESIGN 3 (Main Diagram)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Small Things ... Mystical and Magical Collection)

- Fabric 1: ½yd - ½mtr - SM6.1 (Unicorns on cream with gold metallic)
- Fabric 2: ½yd - ½mtr - SM7.1 (Mermaids on cream with blue metallic)
- Fabric 3: ½yd - ½mtr - SM8.2 (Rainbows on yellow with gold metallic)
- Fabric 4: ½yd - ½mtr - SM9.1 (Fairies on light silver with gold metallic)
- Fabric 5: ½yd - ½mtr - SM10.3 (Wizards on dark grey with gold metallic)
- Fabric 6: ¾yd - ¾mtr - BB131 (Light duck egg)
- Fabric 7: 1yd - 1mtr - BB130 (Candyfloss)

Wadding and backing 57" x 72"

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

CUTTING

From each of the fabrics 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut:

8 x 2" x 42"

From fabric 6 cut:

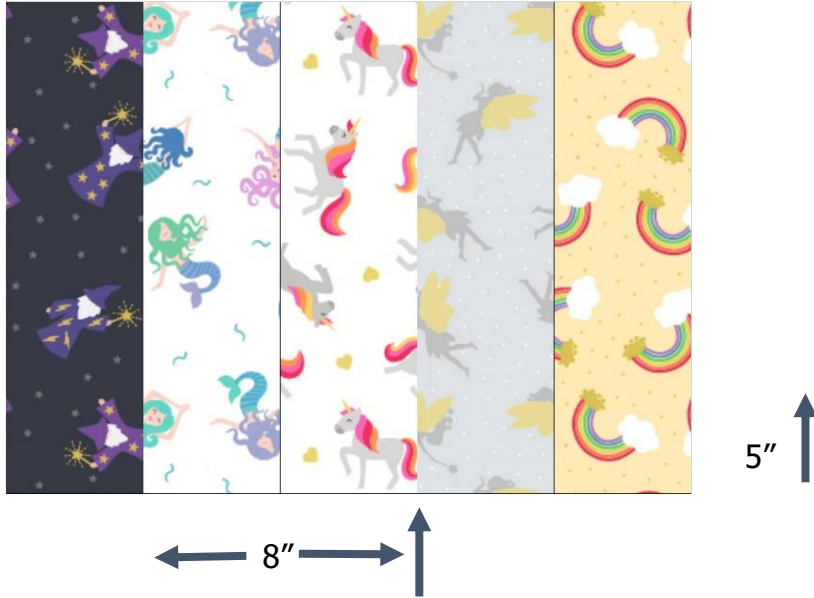
64 x 2" x 8"

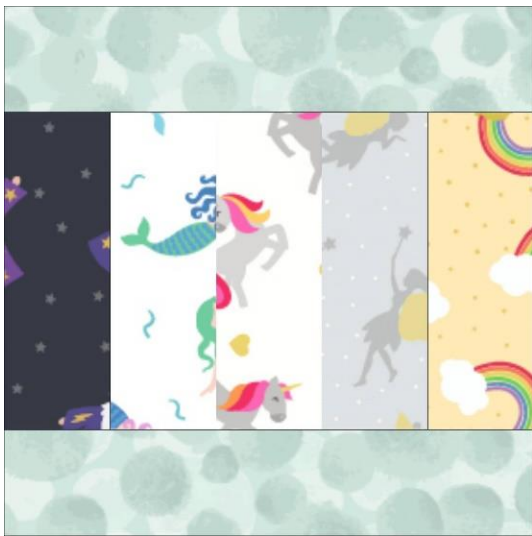
