Requirements

Fabrics from the **Space Glow** collection

1. A736.2 - Glow planets on space blue $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
2. A737.2 - Glow stars on midnight blue $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. A738.2 - Glow astronauts on blue $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. A739.3 - Glow constellations on dark $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. A740.2 - Glow constellations on dark $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A737.1 - Glow stars on light blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
7. A738.1 - Glow astronauts on grey blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
8. A739.2 - Glow constellations on bright dark blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
9. A740.1 - Glow small things space on grey - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
10. A736.1 - Glow planets on galaxy purple - 1yd - 1m
11. BB94 - Light grey - $1\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 1.80m
12. BB20 - Black - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm

Wadding and backing 66" x 72"

**All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.
You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.**

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1 to 9 you need to cut

2 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice
10 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 10 cut

6 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF



From fabric 11 cut

90 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once
180 x 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 12 cut

6 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Blocks



All the blocks are made in the same way. Look at the main diagram for the placement of fabric for each block.

Stitch the long side of the small triangle to each side of the short sides of the larger triangle to make the Flying Geese's block.

Next sew each of the side's strips to the square. Now stitch the two together to complete the block. You need 90 blocks in total.



Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew the rows together pressing your seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing the rows together. Four rows of the quilt.





Borders

Inner border you need to join your strips

2 x 1½" x 60½" sides. Sew the quilt and press back.

2 x 1½" x 56½" top & bottom. Stitch to the quilt, press

Outer border. Join strips for outer border.

2 x 3½" x 62½" sides. Sew the quilt and press back.

2 x 3½" x 52½" top & bottom. Stitch to the quilt, press back to complete the quilt top.


Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 10 to bind the quilt.

2. A737.3 - Glow stars on dark grey - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
3. A738.1 - Glow astronauts on grey blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
4. A739.1 - Glow constellations on grey blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
5. A740.3 - Glow small things space on black - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
6. A737.1 - Glow stars on light blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
7. A738.2 - Glow astronauts on blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
8. A739.3 - Glow constellations on dark - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
9. A740.2 - Glow small things space on dark blue - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm
10. A736.3 - Glow planets on black - 1yd - 1m
11. BB328 - Glow in the dark - $1\frac{7}{8}$ yd - 1.80m
12. BB94 - Light grey - $\frac{3}{8}$ yd - 40cm

Wadding and backing 66" x 72"

**All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.
You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.**

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1 to 9 you need to cut

2 x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice
10 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 10 cut

6 x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

From fabric 11 cut



90 x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ " cut in half diagonally once
180 x 2" x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 12 cut

6 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF



Blocks



All the blocks are made in the same way. Look at the main diagram for the placement of fabric for each block.

Stitch the long side of the small triangle to each side of the short sides of the larger triangle to make the Flying Geese's block.

Next sew each of the side's strips to the square. Now stitch the two together to complete the block. You need 90 blocks in total.

Complete the quilt center

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew the rows together pressing your seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing the rows together. Four rows of the quilt.





Borders

Inner border you need to join your strips

2 x 1½" x 60½" sides. Sew the quilt and press back.
2 x 1½" x 56½" top & bottom. Stitch to the quilt, press

Outer border. Join strips for outer border.

2 x 3½" x 62½" sides. Sew the quilt and press back.
2 x 3½" x 52½" top & bottom. Stitch to the quilt, press back to complete the quilt top.


Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 10 to bind the quilt.



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
