## Requirements)

Fabrics from the Space Glow collection

1. A736.2 - Glow planets on space blue $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
2. A737.2 - Glow stars on midnight blue $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
3. A738.2-Glow astronauts on blue $3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
4. A739.3-Glow constellations on dark $3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
5. A740.2 - Glow constellations on dark $3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
6. A737.1-Glow stars on light blue $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
7. A738.1-Glow astronauts on grey blue $-3 / 8 \mathrm{syd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
8. A739.2-Glow constellations on bright dark blue $-3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
9. A740.1-Glow small things space on grey $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
10. A736.1-Glow planets on galaxy purple - 1yd -1 m
11. BB94 - Light grey $-17 / 8 y d-1.80 \mathrm{~m}$
12. BB20 - Black $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$

Wadding and backing 66" x 72"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

Cutting
From each of the fabrics 1 to 9 you need to cut
$2 \times 71^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally twice
$10 \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2 "$
From fabric 10 cut
$6 \times 31 / 2 " \times$ WOF
From fabric 11 cut
$90 \times 37 / 8$ " $\times 37 / 8$ " cut in half diagonally once $180 \times 2 " \times 3 ½ "$

From fabric 12 cut
$6 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times$ WOF



All the blocks are made in the same way. Look at the main diagram for the placement of fabric for each block.

Stitch the long side of the small triangle to each side of the short sides of the larger triangle to make the Flying Geese's block.

Next sew each of the side's strips to the square. Now stitch the two together to complete the block. You need 90 blocks in total.

## (Complete the quilt center) $x$

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew the rows together pressing your seams in the opposite way each time as this will help when sewing the rows together. Four rows of the quilt.



## Inner border you need to join your strips

$2 \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 601 / 2$ " sides. Sew the quilt and press back.
$2 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 561 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top \& bottom. Stitch to the quilt, press

## Outer border. Join strips for outer border.

$2 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ sides. Sew the quilt and press back.
$2 \times 31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top \& bottom. Stitch to the quilt, press back to complete the quilt top.

## Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.


Use your favorite method from fabric 10 to bind the quilt.

3. A738.1-Glow astronauts on grey blue $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
4. A739.1-Glow constellations on grey blue $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
5. A740.3-Glow small things space on black $-3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
6. A737.1-Glow stars on light blue $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
7. A738.2-Glow astronauts on blue $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$
8. A739.3-Glow constellations on dark $-3 / 8 y d-40 \mathrm{~cm}$

Wadding and backing 66" x 72"
All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. You need to join your fabric to get the length for the border strips.

From each of the fabrics 1 to 9 you need to cut
$2 \times 71_{4} \times 71^{\prime \prime}$ " cut in half diagonally twice $10 \times 31 / 2^{2} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

From fabric 10 cut
$6 \times 31 / 2{ }^{12} \times$ WOF
From fabric 11 cut
$90 \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once $180 \times 2$ " x $3 ½^{\prime \prime}$

From fabric 12 cut
$6 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF


All the blocks are made in the same way. Look at the main diagram for the placement of fabric for each block.

Stitch the long side of the small triangle to each side of the short sides of the larger triangle to make the Flying Geese's block.

Next sew each of the side's strips to the square. Now stitch the two together to complete the block. You need 90 blocks in total.

## Inner border you need to join your strips

## Outer border. Join strips for outer border.

$2 \times 31 / 2 " \times 62 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ sides. Sew the quilt and press back.
$2 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top \& bottom. Stitch to the quilt, press back to complete the quilt top.


Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.


Use your favorite method from fabric 10 to bind the quilt.


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
