Size of quilt 36" x 36" - unfinish block size $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

Requirements

Fabrics from the Teatime collection:

- 1. A423.1 Teatime on cream 1/2 yd 1/2 mtr
- 2. A424.2 China spot on mid blue fat1/4
- 3. A425.2 Little bird roses on china blue fat1/4
- 4. A426.1 Teapots & teacups on cream fat1/4
- 5. A427.3 Teatime floral on darkest blue ½vd ½mtr
- 6. BB40 Bumbleberries Cream ½yd ½mtr
- 7. BB217 Bumbleberries Blue ½yd ½mtr

Wadding and backing 40" x 40"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2½" x 8½" for block 1 2 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 2

From fabric 2 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 3 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 4 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 5 cut

16 x 2½" x 8½" for block 2 2 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 1


From fabric 6 cut

64 x 21/8" x 21/8"


From fabric 7 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " sides for border $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom for border

Sewing blocks



Both blocks are made the same way. Start by making the flying geese blocks. Sewing the long side of the small triangle to each short side of the large triangle.



On block 1 you will have fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 for the flying geese. Lay out the flying geese as in block 1 sew them together and then stitch the strips of fabric 1 to each side of block.

On block 2 you will use fabrics 1, 2, 3 and 4 for the flying geese. Lay out the flying geese as in block 1 sew them together and then stitch the strips of fabric 5 to each side of block.

Making up the top.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows, pressing the seams one way on the first row and then the other way on the next row. This will help when stitching the rows together to complete the centre of top.

Border

Stitch the sides pieces to the top and then the top and bottom.


Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.

Cushion – Size 18" x 18"



Requirements

Fabrics from the Teatime collection:

- 1. A423.1 Teatime on cream fat1/4
- 2. A424.2 China spot on mid blue fat1/4
- 3. A425.2 Little bird roses on china blue fat1/4
- 4. A426.1 Teapots & teacups on cream fat 1/4
- 5. A427.3 Teatime floral on darkest blue fat1/4
- 6. BB40 Bumbleberries Cream fat1/4
- 7. BB217 Bumbleberries Blue fat1/4

Wadding 20" x 20" Backing for cushion ½mtr

18" x 18" cushion pad

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

1 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 2 (2 triangles over)

4 x 21/2" x 81/2" for block 1

From fabric 2 cut

1 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 3 cut

1 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 4 cut

1 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 5 cut

14 x 21/2" x 81/2" for block 2

1 x 5½" x 5½" cut in half diagonally twice for block 1(2 triangles over)

From fabric 6 cut

16 x 21/8" x 21/8"

From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1½" x 16½" sides for border

2 x 1½" x 18½" top & bottom for border

Making up the blocks as in the table top. Only this time you need two of each block. Lay out as in the diagram. Next add the side borders and then the top and bottom. Place onto wadding and quilt.

Completion

Cut two, $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles from backing.

Make a double fold to wrong side along one long edge on each backing rectangle and stitch in place.

Place cushion front right side up on work surface. Lay one backing rectangle right side down on top, aligning raw edges at bottom edge and sides. Add second backing rectangle on top, right side down and aligning raw edges at top edge and sides. Pin in place. Folded edges should overlap by several inches at centre.

Stitch around all four edges. Add line of zigzag stitches within seam allowance on all four edges for additional strength.

Turn right side out and insert a 18" cushion pad.



- 5. A427.2 Teatime floral on china blue ½yd ½mtr
- 6. BB40 Bumbleberries Cream ½yd ½mtr
- 7. BB111 Bumbleberries Indigo ½yd ½mtr

Wadding and backing 40" x 40"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2½" x 8½" for block 1 2 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 2

From fabric 2 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 3 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 4 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 5 cut

16 x 2½" x 8½" for block 2 2 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 1


From fabric 6 cut

64 x 21/8" x 21/8"

From fabric 7 cut


 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " sides for border $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom for border

Sewing blocks



Block 1 Block 2

Both blocks are made the same way. Start by making the flying geese blocks. Sewing the long side of the small triangle to each short side of the large triangle.



On block 1 you will have fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 for the flying geese. Lay out the flying geese as in block 1 sew them together and then stitch the strips of fabric 1 to each side of block.

Making up the top.

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Sew in rows, pressing the seams one way on the first row and then the other way on the next row. This will help when stitching the rows together to complete the centre of top.

Border

Stitch the sides pieces to the top and then the top and bottom.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.

Wadding 20" x 20" Backing for cushion ½mtr

18" x 18" cushion pad

All measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

1 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 2 (2 triangles over)

4 x 21/2" x 81/2" for block 1

From fabric 2 cut

1 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 3 cut

1 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 4 cut

1 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 5 cut

14 x 21/2" x 81/2" for block 2

1 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 1(2 triangles over)

From fabric 6 cut

16 x 21/8" x 21/8"

From fabric 7 cut

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " sides for border

2 x 11/2" x 181/2" top & bottom for border

Making up the blocks as in the table top. Only this time you need two of each block. Lay out as in the diagram. Next add the side borders and then the top and bottom. Place onto wadding and guilt.

Completion

Cut two, 121/2" x 181/2" rectangles from backing.

Make a double fold to wrong side along one long edge on each backing rectangle and stitch in place.

Place cushion front right side up on work surface. Lay one backing rectangle right side down on top, aligning raw edges at bottom edge and sides. Add second backing rectangle on top, right side down and aligning raw edges at top edge and sides. Pin in place. Folded edges should overlap by several inches at centre.

Stitch around all four edges. Add line of zigzag stitches within seam allowance on all four edges for additional strength.

Turn right side out and insert a 18" cushion pad.

- 4. A426.3 Teapots & teacups on mid blue fat1/4
- 5. A427.1 Teatime floral on cream ½yd ½mtr
- 6. BB209 Bumbleberries Sunny Sky Blue ½yd ½mtr
- 7. BB219 Bumbleberries Purple ink ½yd ½mtr

Wadding and backing 40" x 40"

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

16 x 2½" x 8½" for block 1 2 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 2

From fabric 2 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 3 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 4 cut

4 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 5 cut

16 x 2½" x 8½" for block 2 2 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 1

From fabric 6 cut

64 x 21/8" x 21/8"

From fabric 7 cut

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " sides for border $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom for border


Sewing blocks





Block 1 Block 2

Both blocks are made the same way. Start by making the flying geese blocks. Sewing the long side of the small triangle to each short side of the large triangle.



On block 1 you will have fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 for the flying geese. Lay out the flying geese as in block 1 sew them together and then stitch the strips of fabric 1 to each side of block.

Border

Stitch the sides pieces to the top and then the top and bottom.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size.

Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt.

- 6. BB209 Bumbleberries Sunny Sky Blue fat1/4
- 7. BB219 Bumbleberries Purple ink fat1/4

Wadding 20" x 20" Backing for cushion ½mtr

18" x 18" cushion pad

All measurements include 1/4" seam allowances; press each seam as you go.

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut

1 x 5¼" x 5¼" cut in half diagonally twice for block 2 (2 triangles over)

4 x 2½" x 8½" for block 1

From fabric 2 cut

1 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 3 cut

1 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 4 cut

1 x 51/4" x 51/4" cut in half diagonally twice for both blocks

From fabric 5 cut

14 x 21/2" x 81/2" for block 2

 $1 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ " cut in half diagonally twice for block 1(2 triangles over)

From fabric 6 cut

16 x 21/8" x 21/8"

From fabric 7 cut

2 x 1½" x 16½" sides for border

 $2 \times 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ " top & bottom for border

Making up the blocks as in the table top. Only this time you need two of each block. Lay out as in the diagram. Next add the side borders and then the top and bottom. Place onto wadding and guilt.

Completion

Cut two, 121/2" x 181/2" rectangles from backing.

Make a double fold to wrong side along one long edge on each backing rectangle and stitch in place.

Place cushion front right side up on work surface. Lay one backing rectangle right side down on top, aligning raw edges at bottom edge and sides. Add second backing rectangle on top, right side down and aligning raw edges at top edge and sides. Pin in place. Folded edges should overlap by several inches at centre.

Stitch around all four edges. Add line of zigzag stitches within seam allowance on all four edges for additional strength.

Turn right side out and insert a 18" cushion pad.

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
